

Edifying Word: *Unfailing faith, not incapacitated*

The command "fear not" preceded most every great move of God throughout the Bible. That same powerful command must also become an important part of every new venture as well as every routine. The weight it carries empowers us to obey the prompting and direction of the Holy Spirit immediately. Moreover, it allows your faith to manifest as a present, active force in your life making the impossible the inevitable. Jesus Christ prophesied that greater works will be accomplished because of the gifts and ministry of the Holy Spirit in the last days (John 14:12). Therefore, you can advance without even flinching.

Authority in the earth has been conferred to you as God's son or daughter. The truth of the matter is that your position in Christ has gained full recognition and acceptance as an heir of God and a joint heir with Jesus Christ. Because victory is a part of your inheritance, it shall never pass away. Always remember, that it pleased God to make you a part of his family, so he is always mindful of his covenant with you to keep you from falling.

There is a way to find out if you are abiding under God's wings and covered with his feathers. If you feel any heat in the battle, the enemy is too close to you and has detected your position, and you are too far away from the Lord. Never prepare for an emergency during an emergency. Equip yourself daily with Psalm 91 that images God's covenant love and his obligation to you. It crowns him as your Defense, your hedge of protection and preservation. He anticipates drawing nigh to all those who place their trust in him.

Isaiah 43:2 declares God is your stronghold in the day of trouble. God promises, "When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you: when you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon you." In other words, there is absolutely no situation or circumstance that can hem you in.

When you fellowship with the Lord, you will intimately become better acquainted with your triumphant position in Christ. Unity in the Spirit removes all differences so that you can wholeheartedly agree with God alone. Isaiah 40:31 reflects this image,

"But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings as an eagle, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint." The Hebrew definition for "wait" is an act of binding together to achieve oneness. You have a bond that keeps you undetected from the onslaughts of the enemy. You are therefore hidden in Christ when you maintain complete union. (Psalm 91:4) You are then free of any encumbrance, so can gracefully climb to the prepared high places.

You can soar to new heights as you discover your prearranged plan that is threefold: beneficial, tailor-made, and perfect. (Romans 12:1-2) God has a plan for you that is much higher than all your best thoughts and ways. (Isaiah 55:8-9) Yes, far beyond all principalities, powers, rulers of this world, and spiritual wickedness in high places. (Ephesians 6:11-13). Under the Almighty's capable care, the sun shall not smite you by day, nor the moon by night. You can remain confident that the Lord will preserve your soul, guarding you from evil so only a spectator you will be. (Psalm 121: 6-7).

A seamless connection is woven, so the enemy cannot detect where God begins and where you end. With God, you experience perfect synchronization which is authentically established through the awesome work of the Holy Spirit giving you victory every time. What stills the avenger is that he can not discern any differences between you and God, because of the power of the resurrection you are generating. He is frustrated not knowing if he is talking to you or God. As he goes back and forth looking for a port of entry, he only finds total defeat.

Through the law of faith, the Holy Spirit within makes an arrest. Deliverance from the enemy is supernatural. Zechariah 4:6, confirms this. It declares, "...Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit says the Lord of hosts." And again in II Corinthians 10:3-5, "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds;) casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."

Deuteronomy 33:27 gives you this blessed hope, "The eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before you; and shall say, Destroy

them." Because "the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save, neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear" (Isaiah 59:1), you can rely on God's unprecedented surveillance to thrust himself in front of you as your bodyguard at all times when you call on Him in truth. Without fail, God is disposed to show you favor. Another definition for "dispose" means to marshal which demonstrates God's readiness. Psalm 46:1 says, God as a very present help in trouble, which proves his preparedness for both war and emergencies.

God diligently scans the whole earth looking for a perfect heart of faith to continuously cover and defend. He will not allow your foot to be moved because he stands guard as a Watchman 24 hours a day-7 days a week. Psalm 121:3 verifies the frailty of the watchman if it isn't God. "...Except the Lord watch the city, the watchman wakes but in vain." (Psalm 127:1) The strength of God's commitment is so great that he never even takes a wink but is fully alert to watch over his Word to perform it. Psalm 121:3-4 confirms that he neither sleeps nor slumbers.

The Word also declares, "a thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand, but it shall not come nigh thee". (Psalm 91:7) Why? Because you have personally known his impenetrable name: The Rock, Refuge, Fortress, Deliverer, High Tower, and Shield. (Psalm 144:1-2) The enemy may try to wrestle with you but no matter how unwillingly he is, the devil must submit under your God-given authority. At the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that Jesus is Lord. With the collapse of the enemy's champion, you find a safe haven of rest under the shadow of the Almighty. You will then see for yourself, that "The name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe". (Proverbs 18:10).

There is absolutely no one who can successfully contend with God and win. The Word ensures your victory and the enemy's defeat every time. Hebrews 2:9,14,15 says, "But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. ...that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; and deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."

You can plainly see that satan is fighting a losing battle. He knowingly endeavors to maintain conflict out of mere desperation and presumption. That's why he has to work overtime to employ the spirit of fear in an attempt to extinguish life. But the power of Jesus Christ's resurrection reveals the truth of God's love in I John 3:8. "...For this purpose the Son of God was manifested that he might destroy the works of the devil". Luke 10:19 confirms you are Jesus' choice to assume his role of authority over satan in every area, "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you." You have been empowered to cast out fear permanently, whether faced with a planned attack or sudden surprise.

Let's look closer at how fear can create a stronghold that seems indestructible. Fear does not work alone, but rallies camaraderie with other evil spirits in attempt to paralyze you. Isaiah 54:14 exposes the three culprits that try to incapacitate you: 1) oppression; 2) fear; and 3) terror.

Deceitfully, oppression works to distress and defraud through injury and unjust gain. However, the best of oppression is not qualified to contend with even the finger of God. In Isaiah 51:13, the Lord asks this question, "Where is the fury of the oppressor?" So let your testimony be this, "if God be for us, who can be against us?" Romans 8:31.

Fear then couples with oppression to cause a sense of dread, torment, and bondage . It aims to immobilize its subject. Fear tries to enter to displace your faith, so satan can rule in the earth instead of God. Fear must be intolerable in your life for God is not the author. "For God has not given us the spirit of fear: but of power, and of love, and a sound mind". (II Timothy 1:7)

Terror then teams up with oppression and fear to bring about total ruin, desolation, and destruction. But Psalm 9 declares that "destructions are come to a perpetual end". In other words, terror can only be an end that can never begin again. Its power has been stripped because of the finished work on Calvary. Now you have the anointing of the Holy Spirit available to remove the burden and destroy the yoke to transform ashes into beauty.

The diabolical trio's ultimate goal is to reposition you from enlarging your territory in the earth. If they can successfully penetrate your heart, then your life and possessions will be lost, stolen, and destroyed. (John 10:10) Your head will hang in doubt and you will lack assurance if you give place to a fear-based lifestyle. A fearful, unbelieving heart always pries open the floodgates to insecurity, ultimately failure. Instead serve the Lord your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart for the abundance of all things, absolutely nothing missing and nothing broken, except fear, oppression, and terror.

(Deuteronomy 28:47) The tormenting outlaws plot together to overtake you, but the Word confirms that "they shall not come near thee." Isaiah 54:15 warrants "whosoever shall gather together against you shall fall for your sake". With that kind of judgment, every plot will be foiled before the attack can be executed because Isaiah 54:17 says, "No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn..." So authority rests with you and I to make every battle plan of the enemy fail, because we overcame him (the devil and his cohorts: oppression, fear, terror, etc.) by the blood of the Lamb and by the Word of our testimony. (Revelation 12:11)

When you become more assured of God's love, you will fully understand the extent he will go to save you to the uttermost. I John 4:18 says, "Perfect love casts out fear." So no famine, nakedness, peril, or sword. Nothing present, and nothing in the future. No height or depth. No angels or principalities, nor any other creation can compound its resources to destroy your everlasting covenant of deliverance, protection, and preservation with the Most High.

You can rest in knowing your faith can not falter even under trial, because God's love for you cannot be overthrown. Meditating on that will increase your capacity to receive full deliverance whenever you need it. You can know for yourself that God will keep you as the apple of His eye.

Songs of deliverance, like Hiding Place, surround you with God's presence and nothing can separate you from his undying commitment to save deliver, protect, preserve, prosper, heal and make you whole.

One of the reasons Jesus came into the world was to destroy the works of the devil. The other reason he came is that you might have life more abundantly. (John 10:10) You can not have a blessed life if you are harassed by even one threat launched from the enemy. So put the devil in his place under your feet. Bind those spirits from ruling in your life, family, home, workplace, community, city and nation. Always remember, there is no distance in the Spirit. Whatever authority you realize, without question, shall be manifested without delay. That is the result of unfailing faith.

Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 8:29, 31,35-39**

Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. **Deuteronomy 31:6**

Eyewitness Account: *Divine Covering*

To stand as watchman has increasingly more significance to my own life and ministry. After the following events, I now understand the priority of standing guard over my own heart, home, workplace, family, partners, city, and nation. Yes, standing guard: making sure that nothing gets in that should be kept out and nothing gets out that should be kept in.

In the midst of some personal challenges a friend simply said, Remember Psalm 91. I pondered on this insightful truth that created an imagery of being fully covered by the One who is the incomparable Defender and a Mighty Warrior. By the end of the week, my Refuge birthed an indelible song in my heart, entitled "Hiding Place". He perfectly fit that song in my spirit that inspired confidence in Him alone. I didn't understand all that it was creating in heaven and earth, but I continued to sing it everyday for over two weeks. Only after 9-11, I saw this psalm as one of the acceptable sacrifices to God that spared our City from ruin. I believe there other untold accounts.

Within the past several years another prayer warrior enlightened me about the ruling spirits over Cleveland, so I began binding the spirits of murder and suicide, having a view of the Terminal Tower as I journeyed to work.

The Lord brought to mind a prophecy delivered in the 1980's by a renown ministry: It declared that Cleveland will no longer be known as the mistake on the lake. In 2000, the Lord quickened in my spirit that Cleveland will be known as the New International Bible Belt, paralleling the effects to the light of New Jerusalem in the book of Revelation.

So the morning of September 10, 2001 I didn't think it unusual to ask the Lord for Cleveland for our inheritance as Psalm 2:8 suggests. After retiring that evening, the Lord gave me a clear vision of mounted horses with angels holding lit torches and I heard these words, "the city is safe". Puzzled and not knowing what was to befall our nation the following morning, I innocently said okay in my heart and drifted off to a restless sleep.

When I found out what had transpired on 9-11, all four planes had fallen. There are documented accounts that the fourth plan

that succumbed in Pennsylvania was in Cleveland's airspace, flew over the Cleveland Airport but turned around. There were moves to evacuate the downtown area and people were called not to report to scheduled meetings in that area.

I know our City was hedged by wall to wall protection that could not be penetrated by destruction's forces. While divine protection averted danger for Cleveland, it was in no way automatic. God's faithfulness to be the watchmen over His Word caused it not come back empty. Just like there were not any breaches between those angels in the vision, God's faithfulness is also without breach. Engage God's help as you employ Psalm 91 in your daily prayer and meditation time. His sweet presence will surround you with his protective forces and keep you in tact no matter what fear, oppression, or terror you may face. You're empowered to defeat the enemy.
