The Holy Spirits helps us mirror change, now we can go from glory to glory no matter how challenging or uncomfortable. 1) The knower is the precision-directing inner man. It is commonly known as the conscience. 2) The transporter is the body. It has been built to last at least 120 years. As infrastructure, it requires oxygen, water supply, nutrition, supplements, detoxification, fitness, and rest. 3) The reproducer is your subconscious mind. It has the power to scan and replicate what you imagine. 4) The thinker is your mind. It analyzes, discerns, makes judgments, mediates. It remembers the past and imagines the future. 5) The feeler is your emotions. It makes appealing and/or arousing expressions. It stimulates as a motor to display either thoughtprovoking responses or quick reactions. 6) The chooser is your will. It selects not necessarily what you want, like, need, or even what is best, but what you have. 7) The perceiver is your attitude. Thoughts and feelings jointly demonstrated create your viewpoint, not what's right or wrong, true or false, good or bad. When you have a good attitude the thoughts and feelings are in harmony; the two collide when you display a bad attitude. 8) The believer is your heart. The center of your core beliefs and convictions that ignites the impossible realm to makes things possible. 9) The carver is your mouth. It is the informant of the heart; it cuts out what the heart shapes. It can talk expectation or experience. 10) The craver is your appetite. It is never satisfied but hungers and thirsts for attention, recognition, validation, power, and to be served. It can be compared to the skinless flesh that has a continuous drive for comfort. In an uncontrolled state, it manifests excessive behaviors. 11) The enforcer is your instincts. It fights for survival as well as reproduction of its own kind. It imposes its own rules to correct anything it deems disorderly. It has unadvertised rules that tries to impose on others for the purpose of overpowering them. 12) The arranger is your disposition. It can change a whole environment by setting a tangible tone or mood through scenes, sounds, or smells for others to receive an intended message.
