You will also possess public-mapping skills to create masterpieces. Galatians 5th chapter lists an additional nine fruit: love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, and temperance. 10) As a fastener, stability produces unshakable commitment. 11) As a restorer, identity produces holistic empowerment. 12) As an encourager, satisfactory produces inexhaustible resilience. 13) As a persuader, certainty produces unwavering confidence. 14) As an includer, sensitivity produces selfless compassion. 15) As a fueler, spontaneity produces a gracious supplier. 16) As an expander, flexibility produces un-abandoned challenges. 17) As a responder, humility produces immediate compliance. 18) As an authorizer, mastery produces skillful dominion.
