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"For thou hast broken the yoke of his burden, the rod of oppression, as in the day of Midian," Isaiah 9:4

## **THE OPPRESSOR IS REPOSITIONED BY THE HAND OF GOD**

The stratagem of oppression is to exercise dominion against you. It works with fear and terror to prevent you from receiving handfuls on purpose from God, others, and even yourself. It tries to present itself as a mass weapon of destruction, when it is only a mole hill before the Lord, not even a mountain. It wants you to think incapacitation when in reality you have been created boundless. \* When God breathed life into Adam, he was the epitome of triumph: expressing God's dominion. Anything you do not have dominion over will eventually have dominion over you. Moreover, Jesus resuscitated humankind through his death, burial and resurrection; now we can breathe again. Imagine this portrait: enlarge your borders, stretch forth the curtain, spare not, lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes for you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left. Let your seed inherit the world, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited. "The Lord redeemeth the soul of his servants; and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate." i.e., uninhabited and barren. Psalm 61:10 says, "Trust not in oppression." Why? Because oppression has failed. Acts 10:38 confirms its downfall. "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him." Isaiah 51st chapter says, "Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the Lord: look unto the rock when ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged; Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him. For the Lord shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the Lord, joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody. Therefore the redeemed of the Lord shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy and sorrow and mourning shall flee away. I, even I am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldst be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass: and forgetest the Lord thy maker that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? And where is the fury of the oppressor? The captive exile hasteneth that he may be loosed, and that he should not die in the pit, nor that his bread should fail. [Stop looking for the fury because it has been dislocated. Expect God's deliverance. If you weren't going to be successful in this time, you would have been born in another time, in another place.] But I am the Lord thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The Lord of hosts [Sabaoth] is his name. And I have put words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth." You have a recourse: God's word + God's defense over your mouth = God's creation: the planting of heaven on earth. That's how the days of heaven will be multiplied upon the earth. God-directed words in your mouth overturns ruin. The power of life and death are in the tongue: what you love, you eat. Give God breathing room to work on your behalf.
