## DESTINY ARRIVES BY CHOICE, NOT BY CHANCE

Abraham changed his destiny when he stopped taking chances and allowed God to choose the best for him. Abraham had to see his life transformed—what he imagined was really real. He had to be persuaded of what he heard although impossible. He had to embrace God's future blessing, instead of just settling for the present circumstance as it had been. Although he was unsure of where he would end up, he was willing to follow the Lord because he trusted God, not the road. Although Abram was his name for seventy-five years, he received a new name—one that catapulted him into his future—right then—with the heir to the promise. Instead of being called Abram, i.e., exalted father, he gave God breathing room to choose his new name Abraham, i.e., a father of many nations. He only had to conceive one son to be a father. But he had to have the right wife to conceive the promised heir. Romans 4:17 in The Amplified says, "As it is written, I have made\* you the father of many nations. [He was appointed our father] in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed." \*Present perfect tense expresses the verb as a completed action, altering destiny.

## SAY WHAT GOD SAYS, HIS AUTHORIZATION GIVES YOU THE SAY-SO

Romans 4:21 in The Amplified, "Fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mighty to keep His Word and to do what He had promised", Abraham *said* what God *said*. "For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and the immortal spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart," Hebrews 4:12, The Amplified. "By faith we understand that the worlds [during the successive ages] were framed (fashioned, put in order, and equipped for their intended purpose) by the Word of God, so that what we see was not made out of things which are visible," Hebrews 11:3, The Amplified. Manifestation resides in the spirit world first. When you voice what you desire, you usher it into the natural world. Psalm 19:7-9 gives us an affirmation model. For our words to be acceptable to God, they must image his perfect law which restores the whole person; God's sure testimony which makes even the simple, wise; God's accurate principles which rejoices the heart; and God's pure commandments which enlightens our eyes so we have clarity. When we work God's Word into our heart, life will be sweeter than the day before. That is fully satisfied knowing that you have influence with God.

## WORDS THAT MANUEVER YOUR LIFE INTO A NEW DIMENSION

From the Amplified, Psalm 103:5 promises, "Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]. Isaiah 40:29-31 declares "He gives power to the faint and weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound]. Even youths shall faint and be weary, and [selected] young men shall feebly stumble and fall exhausted: But those who wait [bind together with God] for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power: they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles mount up to the sun]: they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired." This is an example of being strong in the Lord. Because it is a command, it is within your capability to perform. Doing things on your own and in your own way create limitations; it is based on what is possible for you. When the Lord is an active force in your life, you move into the impossibility realm, where there are heaven-born possibilities.

"A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit," Proverbs 15:4. Make a habit of voicing the Word of God. As God's inheritance, you usher in the Garden of Eden lifestyle, which demonstrates God's favor on a prepared place. However, when your words are repeatedly contrary to God's blessing, it makes it difficult for the Holy Spirit to guide you into all truth and that truth remain. Not only will you forfeit your blessing, it authorizes satan's access to kill, steal, and destroy; the enemy stays focused on biting.
