ANTICIPATE RECEIVING AT THE SAME LEVEL AS JESUS CHRIST

That which was meant for Jesus Christ's inheritance is graciously shared with you and I. Romans 8:16-17 makes the following confirmation from the Living Bible: "For his Holy Spirit speaks to us deep in our hearts, and tells us that we really are God's children. And since we are his children, we will share his treasures—for all God gives to his Son Jesus is now ours too. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering." That is indeed the graciousness of the kingdom of God's rule where we can receive on the same level as Jesus Christ. Revelation 5:12 declares the inheritance that belongs to Jesus. "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing." What Jesus receives as an inheritance in Revelation 5:12 parallels what each believer has been designated to receive from God. I studied at least seven scripture texts that have the same Greek words as the Revelation scripture; they all are evidence of what we as joint heirs receive is exactly the same as what Jesus receives. 1) **Power of the Miraculous**, *dynamis*, (*dū'-nā-mēs*) means the power for performing miracles. "Now glory be to God who by his mighty **power** at work within us is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of—infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts or hopes. May he be given glory forever and ever through endless ages because of his master plan of salvation for the Church through Jesus Christ." Ephesians 3:20-21, The Living Bible. 2) **Riches in Glory**, *ploutos*, *plū'-tos* means abundance of external possessions "and it is he who will supply all your needs from his **riches** in glory, because of what Christ Jesus has done for us. Now unto God our Father be glory forever and ever," Philippians 4:19, The Living Bible. 3) **Wisdom from Heaven**, *Sophia*, *so-fē-ä* supreme intelligence, such as belongs to God "But the **wisdom** that comes from heaven is first of all pure and full of quiet gentleness. Then it is peace-loving and courteous. It allows discussion and is willing to yield to others; it is full of mercy and good deeds. It is wholehearted and straightforward and sincere. And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of goodness", James 3:17-18, The Living Bible. 4) **Strength of the Kingdom**, *ischys*, *ē-skhi's* means ability, force, and might "it says, that you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your **strength**, and all your mind. And you must love your neighbor just as much as you love yourself.", Luke 10:27, The Living Bible. 5) **Honor of the Conqueror**, *timē*, *tē-mā'* means honor which belongs to one, [Jesus Christ] "Thou madest him a little lower than the angels [Elohim]; thou crownest him with glory and **honor**, and didst set him over all the words of thy hands." 6) **Glory of the King of kings**, *doxa*, *do'-ksä* means the kingly majesty of the Messiah "I brought glory to you here on earth by doing everything you told me to. And now Father reveal my glory as I stand in your presence, the glory we shared before the world began. My plea is not for the world but for those you have given me because they belong to you; and you have given them back to me with everything else of yours, and so they are my **glory**!" John 17:4,5, 10 The Living Bible. 7) **The Blessing of Abba Father**—*eulogia*, *yü-lo-gē-ä* means an invocation of blessing, benediction or consecration. "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree: that the **blessing** of Abraham [inheritance by promise] might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith." Galatians 3:13-14. This is a complete package. You don't want the power without the riches; or riches without wisdom; or wisdom without strength; or strength without honor; or honor without glory; or glory without the blessing. For the days of heaven to be multiplied upon the earth, you need it all. May you always experience God's will on earth as it is in heaven. When you refuse the fullness of God, your inheritance will also be fragmented. Favor brings more to your life than you suppose.

ABSOLUTELY NOTHING WITHHELD FROM YOU

Romans 8:32 draws a perfect image of God's generosity for you and I to trace—it illustrates just how far the Lord went to give you everything he has. "He who did not withhold or spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely and graciously give us all [other] things?" The Amplified. God already gave you all heaven could afford—Jesus Christ—, why would he withhold anything else on earth from you?

Thought for Transformation

"For your shame ye shall have the double, and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion; therefore in their land they shall receive the double; everlasting joy shall be unto them," Isaiah 61:7.
