PREPARING THE CHOSEN VESSEL FOR OVERFLOW

Fill. When we offer a vacancy to God to fill, he freely expresses his will through us. Offer yourself like Mary did, "Be it unto me, according to thy Word." Then God contains heaven's best treasure, Jesus Christ within you. **Heal.** Mary was breachproof, so she was able to contain the promise without aborting it because of insecurity. A GRAND BABY ANNOUNCEMENT FITTING FOR THE KING OF KINGS

Luke 2:8–20, New Living Translation gives the following account of Jesus' birth being announced to the shepherds. Is the vision of what God desires to birth through us so magnificent that he removes all the "no-frills thinking" to announce what he was birthing in the earth? "That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, but the angel reassured them. Don't be afraid! he said. I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! And you will recognize him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger. Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying, Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased. When the angels had returned to heaven, the shepherds said to each other, Let's go to Bethlehem! Let's see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about. They hurried to the village and found Mary and Joseph. And there was the baby, lying in the manger. After seeing him, the shepherds told everyone what had happened and what the angel had said to them about this child. All who heard the shepherds' story were astonished, but Mary kept all these things in her heart and thought about them often. The shepherds went back to their flocks, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them."

EXTRAVANGANT SHOWER GIFTS, BUT NEVER WASTEFUL TO GOD'S PLAN

Matthew 2:9-11, New Living Translation gives an account of wise men following the star that led them to the place where Jesus was born. "After this interview the wise men went their way. And the star they had seen in the east guided them to Bethlehem. It went ahead of them and stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were filled with joy! They entered the house and saw the child with his mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasure chests and gave him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh." Provision can come from around the world from the most distinguished people who are willing to serve God's purpose in the earth. God always provides on a big scale for what he orders. Answers.com remarked about the value of the gifts. "That's absurd to think three wealthy sages would travel across the desert for weeks to bring a treasure worth a trinket. A small chest of gold (pure gold) appx. 1/2 cu. ft' or less than 8" square would weigh over 50 pounds. There's no way to be sure how large the gift was but a small chest would have been an appropriate gift for a messiah.
