AN ABUNDANCE MENTALITY GIVES GOD BREATHING ROOM TO WORK

When you remove the boundaries in your mind, you also remove the boundaries in your life. No limits. Yes, your life measureless. Consider this premise: You were created with an infinite capacity to receive. However, if you are given something that is too big for you, instead of raising it to its highest potential, you would reduce it to your size because there would not be enough breathing room for it to expand. Please know we are fearfully and wonderfully made by our Creator. The God, so big that his hand spans the earth; yet he can become so small that he can dwell in your heart. As we become to know this expansive God as he really is, our heart enlarges to receive him at that measure by faith. You and I were made in the image and in the likeness of the Trinity: the Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. With this in mind, we accept that seeds of greatness have already been sown, and in many cases already proven. Make sure not to dig them up just because you don't see any fruit yet. Let them experience their maturation point. You can count the number of seeds in an apple, but you can't count the number of apples in a seed. Make sufficient room for God's more than enough.

REDEFINING YOUR ENVIRONMENT'S CAPACITY TO SUPPLY FOR YOU

Without a shadow of doubt, I strongly believe when God created the earth there was more than enough resources to expand, extend, and enlarge our territory globally. In fact, it was documented that the presence of gold was discovered right outside of the Garden of Eden, so that life on the outside of the garden could be just as pleasant as it was on the inside. Genesis 2:11-12, AMP, "The first [river head] is named Pishon: it is the one flowing around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold. The gold of that land is of high quality..." Using the garden as the perfect pattern, reproduction of an exact replica was not just possible, but provable. Don't allow any other source to refute God's handiwork. If you do, then you will always believe there is something missing, lacking, or broken. *Acres of Diamonds* is about a man—craving riches—sold his property to set off on a journey to find wealth and riches but ended up impoverished; the party who he sold his property to discovered a rich diamond mine on that land. What you may be looking for may just be under your feet. This may give new meaning to Psalm 112:3 "Wealth and riches shall be in his house; and his righteousness endureth forever." Discover what God has brought to you; it's closer than you imagine.

RECOGNIZE YOUR OWN ABILITY TO INFLUENCE YOUR ENVIRONMENT

We have been created with not just an inquiring, but an acquiring mind, i.e., the capability to receive volumes of deposits. Every time you or someone you know have had to make room—for whatever the reason—you or s/he probably began trying to figure out how all that stuff accumulated within a short period of time. Make room for your capability to influence increase in your environment. The 5-fold assignment is in Genesis 1:28. After God blessed Adam and Eve, he commanded them to: 1) be fruitful; 2) multiply; 3) replenish; 4) subdue; and 5) have dominion. Man is the greatest real estate on earth: what you do with what you have will determine your ultimate value. But to enlarge your territory, you must also be committed to never lose any ground you have gained. The word replenish in Hebrew means not to just fill, but to fence so you won't have any lack of gain. Proverbs 10:22 in the NIV reads "The blessing of the Lord brings wealth, and he adds no trouble to it." The identical verse in Clarke's Commentary on the Bible is interpreted as: "Whatever we receive in the way of providence, has God's blessing in it, and will do us good. Cares, troubles, and difficulties come with all property not acquired in this way; but God's blessing gives simple enjoyment, and levies no tax upon the comfort." The only part of the Bible that will work for you is the part you believe.

EXPECT AN INDELIBLE FUTURE AND A FORGETTABLE PAST

Since God is moving in as your husband, he needs a whole lot of room to spread out. "Sing, barren woman, who has never had a baby. Fill the air with song, you who never experienced childbirth! You're ending up with far more children than all those childbearing women." God says so! Clear lots of ground for your tents! Make your tents large. Spread out! Think big! Use plenty of rope, drive the tent pegs deep. You're going to need lots of elbow room for your growing family. You're going to resettle abandoned cities. Don't be afraid—you are not going to be embarrassed. Don't hold back—you're not going to come up short. You'll forget all about the humiliations of your youth and the indignities of being a widow will fade from memory. For your Maker is your bridegroom, his name, God-of-the-Angel Armies. Your redeemer is the Holy One of Israel." Isaiah 54:1-4, The Message.
