GOD SATURATES THE EARTH FROM HEAVEN

This is God's vision regarding his supply. "...All my springs (my sources of life and joy) are in you [city of God]." Psalm 87:7, The Amplified. This is what the saturation point in heaven looks like. "Then He showed me the river whose waters give life, sparkling like crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb through the middle of the boardway of the city: also, on either side of the river was the tree of life with its twelve varieties of fruit, yielding each month its fresh crop; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing and the restoration of the nations. There shall no longer exist there anything that is accursed (detestable, foul, offensive, impure, hateful, or horrible). But the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it. And His servants that worship Him (pay divine honors to Him and do Him holy service), Revelation 22:1-3, The Amplified. Because God's will is for earth to mirror heaven, the following is representative of God's overflowing supply in the earth. "You visit the earth and saturate it with water: You greatly enrich it: the river of God is full of water: You provide them with grain when You have so prepared the earth. You water the fields' furrows abundantly. You settle the ridges of it: You make the soil soft with showers, blessing the sprouting of its vegetation. You crown the year with Your bounty and goodness, and the tracks of Your (chariot wheels) drip with fatness. The [luxuriant] pastures in the uncultivated country drip [with moisture], and the hills gird themselves with joy. The meadows are clothed with flocks, the valleys also are covered with grain; they shout for joy and sing together. [NO MORE DROUGHT]"

A SPIRIT-DIRECTED VICTORY CAMPAIGN

Picture this: one path with two purposes. The Red Sea stood at attention so the children of Israel could cross on dry land; it then bowed down to serve God's purpose, drowning Pharaoh and his army because they planned to bring God's people back into captivity. "According as their deeds deserve, so will He repay wrath to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; on the foreign islands and coastlands He will make compensation. So [as the result of the Messiah's intervention] they shall [reverently fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun,] when the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him and put him to flight [for He will come like a rushing stream which the breath of the Lord drives]." Isaiah 59:18-19, The Amplified. "But God led his own people forth like sheep and guided them [with a shepherd's care] like a flock in the wilderness. And he led them on safely and in confident trust, so that they feared not; but the sea overwhelmed their enemies." Psalm 78:52-53, The Amplified.

FROM RECOGNITION TO REALIZATION OF MIRACLE WATER

God's work may not be immediately recognized by the unbelieving heart. But your faith in God can help you to sniff out what others' miss. "For there is hope for a tree if it is cut down that it will sprout again and that the tender shoots of it will not cease...though its roots grow old in the earth and its stock dies in the ground, yet through the scent [and breathing] of water [the stump of the tree] will bud and bring forth boughs like a young plant", Job 14:7-9, The Amplified. Because the unbelieving heart must see it to believe it, it often waits for a gusher which may prove to be a missed opportunity. Habakkuk 2:14 in The Amplified. gives us an image of what to anticipate when a worldwide event is in motion. "But the time is coming when the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea." Whether it is a scent of water or a gusher, both have God's signature on his work: there will be no dry places. Best of all: God wants you in the know.

IF GOD CAN GET IT IN YOU, HE CAN GET IT TO YOU

The supernatural and spiritual flow you reproduce is created by the flow of the Spirit and the Word collectively. Everything cannot stay the same. Nothing dry inside. Nothing dry outside. "And the Lord shall guide you continually and satisfy you in drought and in dry places and make strong your bonds. And you shall be like a watered garden and like a spring of water whose waters fail not. And your ancient ruins shall be rebuilt; you shall raise up the foundations of [buildings that have laid waste for] many generations; and you shall be called Repairer of the Breach, Restorer of Streets to Dwell In." Isaiah 58:11-12, The Amplified. After your thirst has been quenched, then you will be in position to reproduce for your generation and for the sake of succession. Isaiah 44:3, The Amplified promises this: "For I will pour water upon him who is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground. I will pour My Spirit upon your offspring, and My blessing upon your descendants." Drenched!
