LIFE ON EARTH PATTERNED AFTER HEAVEN'S MODEL

Unified by: "He planned for the maturity of the times and the climax of the ages to unify all things and head them up and consummate them in Christ, [both] things in heaven and things on the earth," Ephesians 1:10. **Created by:** "In the beginning God (prepared, formed, fashioned, and) created the heavens and the earth," Genesis 1:1, The Amp.. **Owned by:** "The heavens are the Lord's heavens, but the earth has He given to the children of men," Psalm 115:16, The Amp. **Regulated by:** "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatever you bind (declare to be improper and unlawful) on earth must be what is already bound in heaven; and whatever you loose (declare lawful) on earth must be what is already loosed in heaven," Matthew 16:19, The Amp. **Harmonized by:** "Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about whatever (anything and everything) they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven," Matthew 18:19, The Amp. **Possessed by:** "...The dominion (kingdom, sovereignty, rule) of the world has now come into the possession and become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ (the Messiah) and He shall reign forever and ever (for the eternities of the eternities)," Revelation 11:15, The Amp. One prototype can't change, but it changes things to match it.

Philippians 4:19 is a scripture text commonly quoted. It says, "But my God shall supply [completely filled] all of your need [necessary, want, lack, use, demand, insolvency, poverty, hardship] according [as it should be, reserved for you within your overflowing covenant with God] to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." YOU HAVE BEEN MADE INACCESSIBLE TO THE ENEMY'S DOMINION

Jesus carried himself in such a way that satan could never penetrate his stance even in his humanity; the devil could not identify anything in Jesus to use against him. Jesus always maintained the union with God. That was not the case with Esau. Hebrews 12:16 says, "Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright." Esau was named a fornicator [idolater] after he breached unity with God to serve just one minute man-made meal. He not only despised his birthright, but denounced it as well. Unbelief is no light thing to God; it is infidelity. There can be no intimacy when there is a breach of loyalty. Distrust of God's promises and his faithfulness to deliver caused him not to recognize the value of what he possessed. He revolted against God. Disobedience taking him in the opposite direction made him unable to merge operations with God, which repositioned him in harmony with satan. I Samuel 15:23 says, "For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the Lord, he hath also rejected thee from being king." Verbatim, "witchcraft" is intercourse with the devil in Noah Webster's 1828 version of the American Dictionary of the English Language. When oneness is opposed with God, you automatically invite exchange with God's enemy knowing or unknowing. You join forces. You and I must be determined not to have any areas that we "agree to disagree" with God. Refrain from giving satan something to work with; the devil can't be busy unless you or I employ him. He does not work for God. Remember, he was fired from his heavenly position. As a man, Jesus conquered satan on earth. Unity always preserves heaven's ruling; abiding in that state of marriage keeps you in dominion and the devil defeated.

Thought for Transformation

Abraham decreed who God was to him which bridged heaven with earth. The Word abided in him; and he abided in the Word. Abraham received his cues from King Melchizedek as he received his blessing from him. Melchizedek said, "Blessed (favored with blessings, made blissful, joyful) be Abram by God Most High, Possessor and Maker of heaven and earth. And blessed be God Most High, who has given your foes into your hand!" Later when Abraham was faced with temptation he already had God's way of escape which was heaven endorsed. He replied to the king of Sodom that he only recognized God as his source of wealth. He tithed to God through Melchizedek, which demonstrated his honor by not wanting anything God didn't give him. He said to the king of Sodom, "I have lifted up my hand and sworn to the Lord, God Most High, the Possessor of heaven and earth. That I would not take a thread or a shoelace or anything that is yours, lest you should say, I have made Abram rich." His acknowledgement maintained his union with God. The great patriarch of faith, Rufus Mosley said, "the most important thing is to maintain the union." Abraham consummated his relationship with God by not neglecting divine communion, covenant, commitment or choice.
