MYSTERIES FROM THE MOUNTAIN OF THE LORD BRINGS HEAVEN TO EARTH

Isaiah foretells of the kingdom of God's secrets. "... There's a day coming when the mountain of God's house will be the mountain—solid, towering over all mountains. All nations will river toward it, people from all over set out for it. They'll say, "Come, let's climb God's mountain, go to the house of the God of Jacob. He'll show us the way he works so we can live the way we're made," Isaiah 2:1-2, The Message. Embracing revealed knowledge, Jesus sought God. "And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him," Matthew 17:1-3. "And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead," Matthew 17:9. Isaiah casts a vision of the glorious altitude for us. "They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the Lord, and their offspring with them. And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the Lord," Isaiah 65: 22-25. Psalm 143:8 creates an atmosphere to receive from above. "Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust; cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee." Covenant secrets are shown as we honor God.

IN CONCERT WITH GOD TO REMOVE THE MOUNTAIN BY THE ROOTS

Mountain-moving faith follows a proven sequence. "And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith," Mark 11:22-23. After you receive your answer by faith, continue thanking Jesus as if it has already materialized; that's how you magnify the Lord, and not the mountain. We receive at the same measure the miraculous power of God's Spirit and Word is working in us; unbelief is removed and faith is fueled by God's love. In response to you taking dominion, God overthrows the mountain's foundation first, doing the exceeding, abundantly, above all you can imagine. "He putteth forth his hand upon the rock; he overturneth the mountains by the roots. He cutteth out rivers among the rocks; and his eye seeth every precious thing," Job 28:9-10. Remain unshakable even if the mountain doesn't seem to budge. It is uprooted!

GOD MAKES THE MOUNTAIN A MOLEHILL SO YOU CAN COMPLETE THE DREAM

In Zechariah 4:6-7, an angel proclaimed the work was going to be completed; just don't despise small beginnings. "...This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts. Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it," In Greek, God's *grace is sufficient* is: divine influence upon the heart that's reflected in our life raises the barrier. Philippians 1:6, TLB revives your passion to work. "And I am sure that God who began the good work within you will keep right on helping you grow in his grace until his task within you is finally finished on that day when Jesus Christ returns."
