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## THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD IS A TARGET FOR ENEMY DESTRUCTION

What is Satan's main target? Consider, the knowledge of God is what he is really after; he desires God to lose credibility by attempting to create confusion in the minds and hearts of believers to get them to enter into unbelief. Satan twisted the truth in his encounter with Adam and Eve by simply questioning God's knowledge that turned into doubt; that doubt started a controversy of who God is, who they were and who Satan was. If he is able to succeed, then he will either kill, steal or destroy the knowledge of God; consequently it will lack. God's knowledge does not lack because he does not or will not increase it; it is because the thirst for it in the earth diminished creating a deficiency. This confirms what happens in our life if the knowledge of God is found wanting. Hosea 4:6 says, "My people perish because of the lack of knowledge." II Corinthians 10:5 in the Amplified says, "Inasmuch as we refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true knowledge of God; and we lead every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ the Messiah, the Anointed One. Being in readiness to punish every insubordinate for his disobedience; when your own submission and obedience as a church] are fully secured and complete." In other words, any thought that tries to overpower the knowledge of God must be deflated immediately. What Mary, the mother of Jesus, did was confirm God's plan so asked for clarification. Once she received it, she removed all potential conflict so it would be impossible to abort the seed. In fact, she journeyed to her cousin's house—Elizabeth—to seal the impossibility's fate as possible.

## PROVE TO THE ENEMY WHAT IS HEDGED—WHAT'S INACCESSIBLE TO HIM

You can attempt to fake knowing the Lord personally, but you cannot fake having his power. The seven sons of Sceva were impostors of the anointing to cast out devils. The evil spirit knowing his own authority knew the seven did not have the power to back up their command because they did not have a sound relationship to support it. To illustrate the levels of knowing, one of the evil spirits confessed, "Jesus I know, Paul I know about, but who are you?" Acts 19:15. The evil spirit acknowledged there was a difference. The word "know" in Greek indicated he had no choice but to submit to Jesus; regarding Paul, he was well acquainted with the presence and power of God in his life so complied with his command. But with the seven sons of Sceva, he knew they had nothing to make him leave; because of that he leaped on them, created terror, stripped them naked and wounded them. Now don't be afraid, but be equipped with the name of Jesus you know for yourself.

## HOW DOES GOD IMPART HIS KNOWLEDGE

Job 33:14-18, The Living Bible gives a step-by-step play of how God imparts his knowledge to man. "For God speaks again and again, in dreams, in visions of the night when deep sleep falls on men as they lie in beds. He opens their ears in times like that, and gives them wisdom and instruction, causing them to change their minds, and keeping them from pride, and warning them of the penalties of sin, and keeping them from falling into some trap." It illustrates how God does not give up trying to impart his knowledge in the earth; he fully understands man cannot depend on himself. God is not trying to withhold his knowledge; if he did he would impede absolute trust in our relationship with him. God gave Joseph a dream so he would know Mary's pregnancy was heaven-born. Matt. 1:20

## HIDDEN FOR YOU, NOT HIDDEN FROM YOU

God is not trying to hide his knowledge from you but for you. It remains inaccessible to enemy forces, so it is sheltered along with you, although you don't see it is there. Psalm 91:1 promises, "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty." In the secret place, God covers you as well as the necessary intelligence to keep you secure, like a "safe house". God gave Joseph and Mary directions to avoid the potential danger of slaughter. Matt. 2:20

## BOTH HIDDEN AND REVEALED THINGS TAKEN CARE OF

"God, our God, will take care of the hidden things but the revealed things are our business. It's up to us and our children to attend to all the terms in this Revelation." Deuteronomy 29:29, The Message. The seen and unseen things are to be fully taken care of without any slack. Although we are held accountable for revelation, always give God the right of way to manifest his will behind the scenes.
