THE REALITY OF JUST-IN-TIME FAITH IS A HEAVEN-BORN POSSIBILITY

God works both decently and orderly. Psalm 74:12, "For God is my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth." In Hebrew, *working* is defined as systematically and habitually. In sequence, the Lord's operations exhibits: order; balance; wholeness, fullness; then overflow. However, when something is missing, lacking, or broken, the Lord works with your faith to confirm his word; in the end, miraculous signs will manifest. Expect heaven to accommodate your request. Business and industry adopt a just-in-time process that sanctions supplies to be only available as needed. This same practice was used when they ran out of wine at the Cana wedding in John 2:1-10. Referencing Hebrew 11:13 below, you will see how Mary postured her faith to receive her miracle. She was not seeking wine, but literally accessing heaven's storehouse. "Set your heart on the kingdom and his goodness, and all these things will come to you as a matter of course." Matthew 6:33, (Phillips)

1. VISUALIZATION BRINGS TANGIBILITY TO WHAT YOU CAN'T VISUALLY SEE

"...having seen [the promises] afar off..." Mary did not have water or vessel. She didn't see any grapes, a vine, a winepress, or it even being delivered. She only imagined heaven's premium brand tasting better than anything on earth being served to the guests the remaining seven days of the wedding. Envisioning your miracle gives you an indelible picture to receive. "And then GOD answered: "Write this. Write what you see. Write it out in big block letters so that it can be read on the run. This vision-message is a witness pointing to what's coming. It aches for the coming—it can hardly wait! And it doesn't lie. If it seems slow in coming, wait. It's on its way. It will come right on time. Habakkuk 2:2-3, The Message.

2. PERSUASION IS PROOF YOU POSSESS THE UNSEEN MIRACLE RIGHT NOW

In Hebrews 11:13 "...persuaded of [the promises]..." No matter what Mary heard or saw naturally, the reality of her faith never wavered once. Psalm 57:7, "My heart is fixed, O God my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise." Your heart must be predetermined and non-negotiable with unbelief, doubt, or fear, not entertaining the five senses when you are believing to receive your miracle. "For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* no word from God shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment." Luke 1:37, The Amplified.

3. ACCOMMODATION GIVES YOUR EXPECTATION A TANGIBLE HABITATION

Hebrews 11:13 "... and embraced [the promises]..." Mary understood Jesus' reply, *it is not my time*. However, her faith broke through with *the wait is over*, processing wine, accelerating time, cramming every void. She enlarged her territory by further engaging nearby servants, ensuring there were ample couriers for the on-the-spot delivery. She didn't try to determine how it was going to happen. She only knew there had to be enough assistance to serve the wine to guests until the wedding was over. No worker was laid off due to the pending shortage. When an appeal is made, it rests your case with a Yes and Amen to your desire. "...But the people who do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits," Daniel 11:32.

4. EXPRESSION HELD FIRM MOVES HEAVEN TO ANSWER IN YOUR FAVOR

Hebrews 11:13, "...and confessed [the promises]..." The only statement Mary made after she mentioned to Jesus the wine running out was her command to the servants, 'Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.' She sealed her miracle by not running off at the mouth so the completion could not be altered, delayed, or stopped. Unlike the travelers in Hebrews 11:13-16; they were influenced by and contained the right picture; however they talked themselves right out of the promise. They reversed their destination with their patented, contrary speech customs: what they envisioned, their persuasion, and accommodations made were all over-powered simply by voice activation. In reality, your mouth is the informant of your heart; it is an expert witness of its innermost motives. "How forcible are right words!..." Job 6:25.

Thought for Transformation

New wine deposited into new bottles keeps the substance adaptable. However, new wine poured into old bottles can be lost due to the inelasticity of the vessel. Never choose to be an obstruction against your own breakthrough.

Accelerated Transformation

Jesus' ministry accommodates instant change. Since he transformed water into wine miraculously, just think of the heaven-born possibilities he can do in your life. When you choose to live in the realm of impossibilities, all things are possible. Just believe! New wine drawn from the incomparable Holy Spirit changes your DNA supernaturally.

Transformation vs Intoxication

Please know I'm not condoning alcoholic beverages. Allow me to show the distinction. Intoxication is a temporary inconvenience that may leave you with a hangover; while transformation is the permanent change for overcomers. Intoxication may cause you to stagger back and forth. A lack of clarity brings with it little progress also. With transformation, you ascend when you remain in union with heaven's life-changing current. Not directionally-challenged anymore, you now move unimpaired with your divine destiny onward and upward.
