SEAMLESS CONNECTIVITY: NOT MUSH, NOR MASHED, BUT MESHD

“And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.” Mark 12:30-31,33. While there is clearly two commandments stated, there are three main components: God, others, and you. The demonstration of the highest kind of love, *agape* i.e., the Greek word for the God-kind of love, is fit jointly together when we learn how to receive God’s love from him personally and then serve the Lord as a channel to release his love to others. First of all, we can’t love the Lord until he shows us how to love him. Secondly, we must remain under the Holy Spirit’s personal tutelage so we can learn to love ourselves according to heaven’s model. Now, I am not condoning self-centeredness in anyway. Just take for instance, if you are sick or broke due to your own negligence, it will be impossible to assist others because in that state you won’t even be able to help yourself. Such sacrifices are suicidal. The lack of stewardship does not exempt you from receiving your miracle mercies for complete health and/or wealth restoration. Working in you, then through you.

RECEIVE THE ROYAL TREATMENT

Look in the Word of God so you can mirror royalty. Jesus commanded us to don’t worry about what you should eat or wear. He desires us to understand our personal value as his highest form of creation [mankind]. As our self-image improves, we are repositioned to receive the utmost care God prepared for all his heirs. If a greater love is not expressed inwardly, then outwardly it will be also lackluster. If we are only left to our own interpretation, our love will never become perfected, just crystallized as just good enough. This is how things will work out. If you deplete yourself, you will deplete your neighbor. Left in a depleted state, you might as well forget about loving your enemies. There definitely won’t be enough room to include them within the circle: the justification being, well they barred me. This disposition will keep them excluded even from your prayers. Enemies may never befriend you, but the word gives us this promise, when a man’s way please the Lord, even his enemies will be at peace with him. In other words, the enemy will do everything in his power not to leave you with something missing, lacking, or broken. Always give God the right of way to mature his love within you— to remove the lack to receive and release God’s flawless love.

LEARNING TO TRUST GOD’S LOVE

Recite I John 4:16, 21 aloud daily to help build up your personal trust in God’s unconditional love. “And we have known and believed the love the God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God and God in him. And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also”. Whether or not you have ever experienced God’s in whole or in part, by confessing you have, the glory of the Lord will put all the broken, missing, and lacking together. Begin to call those things that be not, as though they were. Consistency in your intake of the living Word demonstrates your faith in God to fulfill all his promises you cherish..

THE MEASURE OF THE GREATEST LOVE OF ALL

Agape love is God’s best measurement for our life. It originates from God himself. God is love, not just has love to share. It remains the end-time qualifier as the will of God unfolds. *Agape* is the exclusive custom of the kingdom of God; everyone receives royal treatment. God *agapes* us. Jesus *agapes* us. The Holy Spirit grieves when the opportunity to prove the Father’s *agape* is lost. We *agape* the Lord. We *agape* ourselves. We *agape* our neighbors. We *agape* our enemies. Satan is the only one you have permission to passionately hate. This is what God spoke to my heart about that, “Love me more than you hate Satan”. I then replied, “Lord, show me how”. When we are perfectly impressed by the greatest love of all, then we can perfectly express the greatest love of all, *agape*.
