RULE UNDER GOD’S MANTLE WITH HIS HONOR AND MAJESTY

God wants you have clarity about how he fearfully and wonderfully made you. “What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of [earthborn] man that You care for him? Yet You have made him but a little lower than God [or heavenly beings], and You have crowned him with glory and honor. You made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet,” Psalm 8:4-6, The Amplified. God is clothed with honor and majesty. “Bless the Lord, O my soul, O Lord my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with *honour* and *majesty*. Who coverest thyself with light as a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain,” Psalm 104:1. God’s honor and majesty is your mantle. “His glory is great in thy salvation: *honour* and *majesty* hast thou laid upon him. For thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance,” Psalm 21:5-6. God’s *honour* laid on you makes you ascend into heavenly places by your choice. God’s *majesty* laid on you makes enemies descend as your footstool by force.

WRAP GOD’S DEFENSE AROUND PROMISED AND PRESENT ASSETS

Bragging on God, King Solomon sent the following message to King Hiram in I Kings 5:4, “But now the Lord my God hath given me rest on every side, so that there is neither adversary nor evil occurrent.” The Living Bible spells out his success as having no foreign enemies or internal rebellions. Solomon strategically secured a strong defense around his territory so he did not even experience a threat because the enemy feared defeat. Oh what peace we often forfeit when oppression is trusted instead of God’s impenetrable defense. Engaging your angels as an army along the blood, the Word, and the name of Jesus secures your inheritance so no enemy can breach security. Daily protective lines must be drawn around all assets to prevent satan from killing, stealing, or destroying.

GOD’S COVENANT PREQUALIFIES HIS CREDENTIALS TO COVER YOU

God raising you up to sit in heavenly places is not generated by self-promotion nor is it a reward for something you perform; it is where God always wanted you to be. “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you an expected end,” Jeremiah 29:11. In other words, you are not an afterthought. Nor does God get amnesia about taking care of you; he prequalified himself so what he started he will also complete. Psalm 111:5 in The Amplified illustrates God as being covenant-minded, i.e., he covers every fragile or broken area with supernatural strength for you. “He has given food and provision to those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him; He will remember His covenant forever and imprint it [on his mind].” Isaiah 55:8-9 promises, “My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.” Never disqualify yourself from receiving from God’s grace; it abounds more than sin can ever to take you up to the highest place. Empower the blood of Jesus to cleanse you from all sin so you won’t feel grounded anymore. Although others may have deserted you, even your own parents, God will never leave you as an orphan no matter how old you get. God will take you up as your everlasting Father, a title he never relinquishes to another or shuns his responsibility.

TRANSFORM YOUR PERCEPTION: THINGS ARE WORKING OUT FOR YOU

The phrase, “above all else” is a priority. So seeking first the kingdom of God (divine influence) and his righteousness (divine image) is what you should embrace. The Message puts Matthew 6:28-33 this way, “Instead of looking at the fashions, walk out into the fields and look at the wildflowers. They never primp or shop, but have you ever seen any color and design like it? The ten best-dressed men and women in the country look shabby alongside them. If God gives such attention to the appearance of wildflowers—most of which are never ever seen—don’t you think he’ll attend to you, take pride in you, do his best for you? What I’m trying to do here is to get you to relax, to not be so preoccupied with getting, so you can respond to God’s giving. People who don’t know God and the way he works fuss over these things, but you know both God and how he works. Steep your life in God-reality, God-initiative, God provisions. Don’t worry about missing out. You’ll find all your everyday human concerns will be met.” Why? Because when you reign, things come to you. Your honor and majesty causes others to recognize your needs and humbly bow to serve the royal edict.
