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THE HONOR AND MAJESTY BESTOWED UPON JESUS CHRIST

Philippians 2:8-11, (Amp) is a clear representation of Jesus' honor and majesty—the repossession of the power and authority that was temporarily lost. "And after He had appeared in human form, He abased and humbled Himself [still further] and carried His obedience to the extreme of death, even the death of the cross! Therefore [because He stooped so low] God has highly exalted Him and has freely bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, That in (at) the name of Jesus every knee should (must) bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth. And every tongue frankly and openly confess and acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." The following two scriptures are a word picture of all Jesus Christ conquered; there is nothing left outside of his rule. Revelation 11:15, (Amp), "... The dominion (kingdom, sovereignty, rule) of the world has now come into the possession and become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ (the Messiah), and He shall reign forever and ever (for the eternities of the eternities)!" And Revelation 12:10, (Amp), Then I heard a strong (loud) voice in heaven, saying, Now it has come—the salvation and the power and the kingdom (the dominion, the reign) of our God, and the power (the sovereignty, the authority) of His Christ (the Messiah); for the accuser of our brethren, he who keeps bringing before our God charges against them day and night, has been cast out!" Jesus can't lose the Victor's crown. Triumph remains irreversible. 'You win some, you lose some' is over now! Jesus redeemed everything concerning you forever!

"All these kings and their lands Joshua conquered in one campaign, because the LORD,

the God of Israel, fought for Israel." Joshua 10:42, New International Version

THE HONOR AND MAJESTY BESTOWED ON YOU

Jesus' cross in the Garden of Gethsemane moved us from a life of hard labor to enjoy a life of favor with the restoration of our dominion that was established in the Garden of Eden. Paraphrasing Matthew 6:21-34, Jesus shares what the kingdom of God's reign looks like in you vs those outside of it. I give you my inheritance. My labor, your favor. Your body is more important than just to wear clothes—you are the house I desire to live in so you can thrive, not just survive. Temporal things won't dominate you anymore. Activate faith to look within to draw out the kingdom of God. You won't have to look around and worry or look back and fret about what you eat, drink or wear. You will see I personally received you to glory to live on top of the world. The habitation of God's heart in you perpetually pumps the rhythm of heaven's dominion on earth. As you give God permission to be your heart's only treasure, your continual honor of Him and majesty for Him repositions you; you move forward "in time, place, and occasion." Above all else, always require the kingdom of God.

CREATED WITH POWER AND AUTHORITY TO BE MORE THAN A CONQUERER

Psalm 8:4-9, NIV confirms we were created with power and authority. "What is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them? You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet: all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild, the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas. Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!" 2 Corinthians 10:5-6, (Phillips) encourages you to courageously arise as more than a conqueror through Christ. Stop waiting to be rescued like a damsel in distress. "We are not merely human agents but God-appointed ministers. The truth is that, although of course we lead normal human lives, the battle we are fighting is on the spiritual level. The very weapons we use are not those of human warfare but powerful in God's warfare for the destruction of the enemy's strongholds. Our battle is to bring down every deceptive fantasy and every imposing defense that men erect against the true knowledge of God. We even fight to capture every thought until it acknowledges the authority of Christ. Once we are sure of your obedience we shall not shrink from dealing with those who refuse to obey." You will become fatigued relying on your own strength. Release God's power and authority within to enforce the enemy's defeat.

Thought for Transformation

How engaging is Holy Spirit in prayer. I heard him repeatedly chant the word "subjugate." Webster's 1828 defines it as: to subdue and bring under the yoke of power or dominion; to conquer by force and compel to submit to the government or absolute control of another. Jesus did not come to take sides with satan but to take over. He manifested the honor of the majesty of the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom Ups and Downs

Because of Jesus, we receive both honor and majesty. Your honor shows you can't be dethroned. It is God's admiration for you. In heaven, it is your exalted rank in Christ. Your majesty shows that no foe can be enthroned king over you. It is God's distinction on you. On earth, it signifies your greatness and dignity that demands reverence from defeated satan. These ups and downs actually grant you sustained triumph.

Mantle Carries God's Reign

Psalm 104:1 reveals what God wears. "...O Lord my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honor and majesty." In Psalm 21:5 King David applauds God for covering his current reign as well as future kings. "His glory is great in thy salvation: honor and majesty hast thou laid upon him." Never get dressed in the dark.
