THE LAYING FORTH OF WORDS BEFORE THE KING

Logos is much like I Samuel 17:32-37—a laying forth of words, i.e., illustrating both process and power. David presented his supernatural disposition before King Saul for examination, promoting God's favor no matter the challenger. The word of his testimony—as more than a conqueror—kept the right perceptive in battle. "And David said to Saul, Let no man's heart fail because of him; thy servant will go and fight with this Philistine. And Saul said to David, Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him: for thou art but a youth, and he a man of war from his youth. And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock: And I went out after him, and smote him, and delivered it out of his mouth: and when he arose against me, I caught him by his beard, and smote him, and slew him. Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God. David said moreover, The LORD that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine. And Saul said unto David, Go, and the LORD be with thee."

THE POURING FORTH OF WORDS BEFORE THE ENEMY

Rhema is much like I Samuel 17:45-47—a pouring forth of words, inundating all enemy forces. Through David, Holy Spirit—like a flood—lifted up his standard of victory for Goliath's execution. In this case, God was given the right of way to command the battle. David did not accept the challenge to fight, he pronounced the enemies' extinction by God. "Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied. This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcases of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel. And all this assembly shall know that the LORD saveth not with sword and spear: for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give you into our hands."
