

## **The Tsunami Blessing: Inside and Out, Part 17**

**If the adversary attempts to accuse you before God, remember this is identical to satan assaulting the Lord. Jesus Christ takes any charge against you very personal because He already died for you as you so you can freely live for Him as He wills in this world as an overcomer. You see, from heaven's point of view, Jesus was wounded for your transgressions, bruised for your iniquities, the chastisement of your peace was upon Him, and by His stripes you were healed.**

**Now allow Holy Spirit to intercede for you to prepare your winning position. Go get what was lost, stolen, withheld or defrauded back. All those cases that you may think have been closed, thrown out, overlooked, denied, delayed, misjudged and such like are really awaiting your appearance before God in the courts of heaven. Until you show up, your adversary has the upper hand, a default judgment. If you won't go, your verdict is automatically no; however, when you go, the ruling is absolutely YES! Allow the healing virtue of God to resuscitate your faith to fight with whatever you have left, so God can restore what you lost with a 7-fold interest.**

This scripture reference shows God rendering justice to Hannah. While Hannah receives healing, deliverance, and breakthrough, the enemies of God get their just reward. Every wrong is made right in the courts of heaven. God operates on this premise: you are always innocent until proven guilty. God never just hands you over to satan; only after the enemy presents evidence in his favor can there ever be a breach. Legally, satan gains entrance into any unprotected area by default because you made no court appearance. God never verbally agrees with satan because the enemy is condemned forever. Nor does God verbally agree with you when there is something between you and Him; that is why the blood of Jesus must remain the only answer to clear any and every accusation against you. The charge(s) can be something you or your ancestors have done or failed to do that caused the breach all the way back to Adam. Don't worry! Any case against you can be fully rescinded so you can be fully restored.

**2** This was Hannah's prayer:

"How I rejoice in the Lord!  
How he has blessed me!

Now I have an answer for my enemies,  
For the Lord has solved my problem.  
How I rejoice!

<sup>2</sup>No one is as holy as the Lord!  
There is no other God,  
Nor any Rock like our God.

<sup>3</sup>Quit acting so proud and arrogant!  
The Lord knows what you have done,  
And he will judge your deeds.

<sup>4</sup>Those who were mighty are mighty no more!  
Those who were weak are now strong.

<sup>5</sup>Those who were well are now starving;  
Those who were starving are fed.  
The barren woman now has seven children;  
She with many children has no more!

He judges throughout the earth.  
He gives mighty strength to his king,  
And gives great glory to his anointed one."

**God is the only Judge: Jesus gives an example of an earthly judge rendering a verdict that gives a widow vindication. This judge doesn't want to be bothered with her in the first place and only gives her justice because she is getting on his nerves. How much more will your Heavenly Daddy who is the Judge, help you more than you know you even need His help? He will come speedily to help you in the time of trouble. First of all, God favors you because you are His own inheritance. Secondly, God will give you favor with and/or over your enemies. Thirdly, keep your faith fresh in God's system of recovery, so heaven can come to earth to bring you full restitution, no matter how long and no matter how wrong. Never stop believing until you recover all.**

Luke 18:1-8 The Voice (VOICE)

**18** He told them a parable, urging them to keep praying and never grow discouraged. The parable went like this:

**Jesus:** <sup>2</sup> There was a judge living in a certain city. He showed no respect for God or humanity. <sup>3</sup> In that same city there was a widow. Again and again she kept coming to him seeking justice: "Clear my name from my adversary's false accusations!" <sup>4</sup> He paid no attention to her request for a while, but then he said to himself, "I don't care about what God thinks of me, much less what any mere human thinks. <sup>5</sup> But this widow is driving me crazy. She's never going to quit coming to see me unless I hear her case and provide her legal protection."

<sup>6</sup> Did you catch what this self-assured judge said? <sup>7</sup> *If he can be moved to act justly, won't God bring justice for His chosen people when they cry to Him day and night? Will He be slow to bring them justice?* <sup>8</sup> Mark My words: God will intervene fast with vindication. But here's the question: when the Son of Man comes, will He find anyone who still has faith?

**No one qualifies to be judge for yourself or any other party. You stay connected to your mediator of the new covenant who is Jesus alone. In this seamless connection, you release the ruling of heaven on earth as directed. 1 Timothy 2:5 (KJV) <sup>5</sup> For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Therefore you pronounce you have overcome satan by the Blood of the Lamb and the word of your testimony, which declares the decree, "whom the Son makes free is free indeed."**

2 Corinthians 5:19 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

<sup>19</sup> It was God [personally present] in Christ, reconciling *and* restoring the world to favor with Himself, not counting up *and* holding against [men] their trespasses [but cancelling them], and committing to us the message of reconciliation (of the restoration to favor).

1. Holy Spirit has already supplied with you more than enough capacity to forgive the offense no matter the frequency, even if it all happens during the course of one day, as well as, no matter how fierce the offence.

2. Holy Spirit has already supplied you with more than enough compassion to give it away to the alleged more than they realize they need it.

3. As you release them from any obligation, you will receive your own breakthrough. Without your willingness to release them, you will not be positioned to get the most important thing you need from God, i.e., His mercy.

**Holy Spirit is equipped to help you to maintain a winning position in the courts of heaven. Holy Spirit is already empowered to remind you of everything Jesus commanded, to guide you into all truth, and to show you things to come. Jesus explains that with His ascension, He is sending a qualified ambassador from heaven who will remain in you and never separate Himself from you.**

John 16:7 (AMPC) - Holy Spirit is your Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengtheners, Standby)

John 16:7-11 Living Bible (TLB)

<sup>7</sup> But the fact of the matter is that it is best for you that I go away, for if I don't, the Comforter won't come. If I do, he will—for I will send him to you.

<sup>8</sup> "And when he has come he will convince the world of its sin, and of the availability of God's goodness, and of deliverance from judgment.<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>9</sup> The world's sin is unbelief in me; <sup>10</sup> there is righteousness available because I go to the Father and you shall see me no more; <sup>11</sup> there is deliverance from judgment because the prince of this world has already been judged.

1. Holy Spirit convinces the world of its sin, **The world's sin is unbelief in me;**

2. Holy Spirit convinces of the availability of God's goodness, **there is righteousness available because I go to the Father and you shall see me no more;**

3. Holy Spirit convinces of deliverance from judgment.<sup>[a]</sup> **there is deliverance from judgment because the prince of this world has already been judged.**

**Jesus explains the chain of authority so you clearly understand how to live free from condemnation. God committed judgment to Jesus. Jesus' loyalty to God keeps Him committed to only judging just like God wills in every situation. Jesus is your Advocate with God.**

John 5:22-30 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>22</sup> For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

**23** That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

**24** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

**25** Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

**26** For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;

**27** And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

**28** Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

**29** And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

**30** I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

1 John 2:1-3 King James Version (KJV)

**2** My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

**2** And he is the propitiation [comfort] for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

**3** And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

Don't look at the devil's demotion as you having honor. Rather, look at your promotion as a son of God with eyes of humility. Introduce others to Christ so their names are also written in heaven. Make disciples all over the world so they can do what Jesus did and even do the greater works of God.

Remove the enemy's influence so the goodness of God can be showcased, speedily. Never forget that satan has already been condemned; he carries

an irrevocable damnation that is endless. Since he is already sentenced, don't let him get away with your goods. Go get your retribution so you leave the devil empty-handed, all the substance of his house.

**17** And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

**18** And he said unto them, I beheld satan as lightning fall from heaven.

**19** Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

**20** Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
