What if you could supernaturally birth in one moment in time what it naturally and normally takes 30 years to reproduce? That is God's super on your natural that flushes out all unbelief. What dissolves all doubt are the Word of God who commands it and the Spirit of God who gathers it along with your expectation that ushers in heaven-born possibilities. Let your faith before God be the importunity that overthrows any impossibility. Be careful to remove any energy leak so your faith won't lose momentum in receiving the promise as a finished work of God. Go for the masterpiece, not just a piece of work!

1) Processed by Ignition: Jesus is the Author and Finisher of our faith. Enlargement is in expecting. Jesus is saying, "I am the supply that meets your every demand right now."

Luke 4:16-30 The Voice (VOICE)

¹⁶ He eventually came to His hometown, Nazareth, and did there what He had done elsewhere *in Galilee*—entered the synagogue and stood up to read *from the Hebrew Scriptures*.

¹⁷ The *synagogue attendant* gave Him the scroll of the prophet Isaiah, and Jesus unrolled it to the place where Isaiah had written these words:

¹⁸ The Spirit of the Lord the Eternal One is on Me.

Why? Because the Eternal designated Me

to be His representative to the poor, to preach good news to them. He sent Me to tell those who are held captive that they can now be set free, and to tell the blind that they can now see.

He sent Me to liberate those held down by oppression.

¹⁹ *In short, the Spirit is upon Me* to proclaim that now is the time; this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One's grace.^[a]

²⁰ Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant. Then He sat down, *as a teacher would do*, and all in the synagogue focused their attention on Jesus, *waiting for Him to speak*.²¹ He told them that these words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in their hearing.

²² At first everyone was deeply impressed with the gracious words that poured from Jesus' lips [rhema]. Everyone spoke well of Him and was amazed that He could say these things.

Everyone: Wait. This is only the son of Joseph, right?

Jesus: ²³ You're about to quote the old proverb to Me, "Doctor, heal yourself!" Then you're going to ask Me to prove Myself to you by doing the same miracles I did in Capernaum. ²⁴ But face the truth: hometowns always reject their homegrown prophets.

²⁵ Think back to the prophet Elijah. There were many needy Jewish widows in *his homeland*, Israel, when a terrible famine persisted there for three and a half years. ²⁶ Yet the only widow God sent Elijah to help was *an outsider* from Zarephath in Sidon. ^[b]

²⁷ It was the same with the prophet Elisha. There were many Jewish lepers in his homeland, but the only one he healed—Naaman—*was an outsider* from Syria. ^[c]

²⁸ The people in the synagogue became furious when He said these things.

²⁹ They seized Jesus, took Him to the edge of town, and pushed Him right to the edge of the cliff on which the city was built. They would have pushed Him off and killed Him, ³⁰ but He passed through the crowd and went on His way.

The wait is over! Rejection vs. Reception. Strong to do exploits

Romans 8:22-25 The Message (MSG)

²²⁻²⁵ All around us we observe a pregnant creation. The difficult times of pain throughout the world are simply birth pangs. But it's not only around us; it's *within* us. The Spirit of God is arousing us within. We're also feeling the birth pangs. These sterile and barren bodies of ours are yearning for full deliverance. That is why waiting does not diminish us, any more than waiting [expecting] diminishes a pregnant mother. We are enlarged in the waiting [expecting]. We, of course, don't see what is enlarging us. But the longer we wait [expect], the larger we become [multiple births], and the more joyful our expectancy.

It's the binding together with God that gives us new strength to birth the supernatural as Is. 40:31 declares.

³⁰(Some) Young men shall fail, and shall travail, and (other) young men shall fall down in their sickness.

³¹But they that hope in the Lord, shall change strength, they shall take feathers as eagles; they shall run, and shall not travail; they shall go, and shall not fail. (But they who hope in the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall grow wings like eagles; they shall run, and shall not labour, *or struggle*; they shall go, and shall not faint.)

**Eagle Facts & Parables of Mentoring

IMPRINTING - BONDING WITH WHAT MOVES

Did you know that eagles must LEARN to fly and hunt and are taught by OBSERVING their parents? These skills are not instinctive like some of God's creatures. However, eagles are born with a different instinct called imprinting. Konrad Lorenz first discovered imprinting when he observed ducks and geese hatching out of their eggs. He noticed they would bond with the first moving object they saw, regardless of whether this was their parent. From that first moment of imprinting, they follow their moving parent (or adopted parent) until raised. (It is interesting that Paul said, "Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ." 1 Cor. 11:1)

The concept of imprinting is fascinating. Bird shelters that rescue eagle eggs, must hand feed them with an eagle puppet so that the eagles do not think they are human and end up resisting their own kind when it is time to mate. In Konrad's imprinting studies, he saw one egg hatch near a rolling ping pong ball. When the duck grew old enough, it tried to mate with anything that was round and rolling. One group of ducklings imprinted on his moving boots. In the morning when he would go outside to put on his boots, instead of being in their nest, the ducks were curled up and sleeping on his boots. They followed Konrad - everywhere his boots took him.

2) Processed by Imposition

After the angel describes the process of Holy Spirit impregnating the incorruptible seed, the Word of God, Mary demonstrated her faith before God. She was so convinced that she had been chosen one to birth God's offspring that she simply agreed and yielded her womb to receive the supernatural download from heaven.

Luke 1:26-38 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

26 Now in the sixth month [after that], the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee named Nazareth,

27 To a girl never having been married *and* a ^[a]virgin engaged to be married to a man whose name was Joseph, a descendant of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.

28 And he came to her and said, Hail, O favored one ^[b]endued with grace! The Lord is with you! ^[c]*Blessed (favored of God) are you before all other women!*

29 But *when she saw him*, she was greatly troubled *and* disturbed *and* confused at what he said and kept revolving in her mind what such a greeting might mean.

30 And the angel said to her, Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found grace ^[d]free, spontaneous, absolute favor and loving-kindness) with God.

31 And listen! You will become pregnant and will give birth to a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus.

32 He will be great (eminent) and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His forefather David,

33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob throughout the ages; and of His reign there will be no end.

34 And Mary said to the angel, How can this be, since I have no [intimacy with any man as a] husband?

35 Then the angel said to her, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a shining cloud]; and so the holy (pure, sinless) Thing (Offspring) which shall be born *of you* will be called the Son of God.

36 And listen! Your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is now the sixth month with her who was called barren.

37 For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* no word from God shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment.

38 Then Mary said, Behold, I am the handmaiden of the Lord; let it be done to me according to what you have said. And the angel left her.

Numbers 24:17 Expanded Bible (EXB) **17**I see someone ·who will come someday [*but not now*], ·someone who will come, but not soon [*I see him, but not near*]. A star will come from Jacob; a ·ruler [*scepter*] will rise from Israel [*Saul, then David and his descendants, including the Messiah*]. He will crush the heads of the Moabites and smash the skulls of the sons of Sheth [*identity uncertain*].

Mary's heart remained completely opened for God to change all her plans that were in progress to accommodate His imposition.

¹⁹ Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth [Hebrew = imposition, i.e, God-size dream is the much too much blessings which could be also a burden because it is so much bigger than us] us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

3) Processed by Innovation

Mary's vision increased so her capacity to receive also increased. The blessing shall flow as far as the curse is found. Mary placed a demand on heaven's supply to cram the void!

Mary's in an Incubation Period of receiving Jesus' message the Wait is Over, Expect to Receive Now. Romans 10:17.

John 2:1-11 King James Version (KJV)

2 And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

² And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.

Mary's Invocation is not a casual conversation, question, suggestion, or recommendation. It is an expectation to receive her demand.

³ And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.

Jesus' Interjection – Mary's Faith on Trial

⁴ Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.

Mary's Interpretation – At 30 years old, Jesus has matured and ready for ministry. Now let's do it again! Let's birth the supernatural again. I've have already received the best wine heaven had to offer; I'm sure that heaven has not run out of its supply.

Mary's Faith was so stirred that she makes accommodations to receive the miracle. Now she is the new wineskin again and Jesus is the new wine again. All she needed was the supernatural supply to fill the containers for the guests for the entire 7-day wedding feast.

⁵ His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

Jesus' Instruction – proves what He declared in Luke 4th chapter; now is the time to be heaven drenched.

⁶ And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

⁷ Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

⁸ And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.

Divine Intervention – as the servants were a credible witness of the glory of God. As the Word proceeded out of Jesus' mouth, the water turned into wine. The evidence is that the servants knew that the wine came from heaven and the water came from earth.

⁹ When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was:

Host's Inspection – he test-tasted the water now turned into wine; only the palate of a connoisseur could ever discern the maturity a 30 year old fine wine.

(but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

¹⁰ And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

Jesus hearing from heaven to deliver the finished work and Mary knowing that her real-time faith could not be denied access receives the delivery of the best wine just-in-time.

¹¹ This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

Mary approached Jesus as a covenant friend exercising importunity because she was certain she would not be denied. She invoked the blessing of abundance, grace, love, fertility, happiness, success, and divine protection that prohibited the curse of lack, debt, poverty.

Luke 11:6-9 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him?

⁷ And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee.

⁸ I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. [The passionate persistence of a child]

⁹ And I say unto you, Ask [counting on it], and it shall be given you; seek [going after it], and ye shall find; knock [not leaving without it], and it shall be opened unto you. [I'm not coming home empty-handed]

4) Processed of Intoxication

Assuming Joseph has passed away, Mary being taken care of by God as her husband. New wine in old wineskin will burst; all contents will

be lost. New wine in new wineskins will be contained because it is flexible. [God is now the One who is adaptable; He causes the expansion.]

Isaiah 54 makes room for God to live in the earth as husband. He doesn't want to live in cramped quarters. Mary comprehends her right as the redeemed; i.e., to be released from the stigma of being abandoned. Mary speaks up to ensure that the weapon of lack could not answer for her. She clings on to her covenant of peace: nothing missing; nothing broken in her life, no matter where she is.

Isaiah 54 Living Bible (TLB)

54 Sing, O childless woman! Break out into loud and joyful song, Jerusalem, ^[a] for she who was abandoned has more blessings* now than she whose husband stayed! ² Enlarge your house; build on additions; spread out your home! ³ For you will soon be bursting at the seams! And your descendants will possess the cities left behind during the exile and rule the nations that took their lands [multiple births].

⁴ Fear not; you will no longer live in shame. The shame of your youth and the sorrows of widowhood will be remembered no more, ⁵ for your Creator will be your "husband." The Lord Almighty is his name; he is your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, the God of all the earth. ⁶ For the Lord has called you back from your grief—a young wife abandoned by her husband. ⁷ For a brief moment I abandoned you. But with great compassion I will take you back.

⁸ In a moment of anger I turned my face a little while; but with everlasting [intoxicating] love I will have pity on you, says the Lord, your Redeemer.

⁹ Just as in the time of Noah I swore that I would never again permit the waters of a flood to cover the earth and destroy its life, so now I swear that I will never again pour out my anger on you. ¹⁰ For the mountains may depart and the hills disappear, but my kindness shall not leave you. My promise of peace for you will never be broken, says the Lord who has mercy upon you.

¹¹ O my afflicted people, tempest-tossed and troubled, I will rebuild you on a foundation of sapphires and make the walls of your houses from precious

jewels. ¹² I will make your towers of sparkling agate and your gates and walls of shining gems. ¹³ And all your citizens shall be taught by me, and their prosperity shall be great. ¹⁴ You will live under a government that is just and fair. Your enemies will stay far away; you will live in peace. Terror shall not come near. ¹⁵ If any nation comes to fight you, it will not be sent by me to punish you. Therefore, it will be routed, for I am on your side. [b] ¹⁶ I have created the smith who blows the coals beneath the forge and makes the weapons of destruction. And I have created the armies that destroy. ¹⁷ But in that coming day, no weapon turned against you shall succeed, and you will have justice against every courtroom lie. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord. This is the blessing I have given you, says the Lord.

5) Processed by Impartation: Cure for unbelief. Because it is a choice let it die as sin, so you can live unto the righteousness of faith. If you remain unwilling, it will poison the promise; and what you once desired will be put to death as well.

Hebrews 4:1-11 The Message (MSG)

When the Promises Are Mixed with Faith

4 ¹⁻³ For as long, then, as that promise of resting in him pulls us on to God's goal for us, we need to be careful that we're not disqualified. We received the same promises as those people in the wilderness, but the promises didn't do them a bit of good because they didn't receive the promises with faith. If we believe, though, we'll experience that state of resting. But not if we don't have faith. Remember that God said,

Exasperated, I vowed,

"They'll never get where they're going,
never be able to sit down and rest."

³⁻⁷ God made that vow, even though he'd finished *his* part before the foundation of the world. Somewhere it's written, "God rested the seventh day, having completed his work," but in this other text he says, "They'll

never be able to sit down and rest.” So this promise has not yet been fulfilled. Those earlier ones never did get to the place of rest because they were disobedient.[Disconnects you from God and connects you to satan] God keeps renewing the promise and setting the date as *today*, just as he did in David’s psalm, centuries later than the original invitation:

Today, please listen,
don’t turn a deaf ear . . .

Psalm 95:7-8 Living Bible (TLB)

⁷for he is our God. We are his sheep, and he is our Shepherd. Oh, that you would hear him calling you today and come to him!

⁸Don’t harden your hearts as Israel did in the wilderness^[a] at Meribah and Massah.

8-11 And so this is still a live promise. It wasn’t canceled at the time of Joshua; otherwise, God wouldn’t keep renewing the appointment for “today.” The promise of “arrival” and “rest” is still there for God’s people. God himself is at rest. And at the end of the journey we’ll surely rest with God. So let’s keep at it and eventually arrive at the place of rest, not drop out through some sort of disobedience.

Jesus lives in Mary to manifest His presence in her

²⁴ Now after this his wife Elizabeth became pregnant, and for five months she secluded herself completely, saying, ²⁵ “This is how the Lord has dealt with me in the days when He looked with favor on *me*, to take away my ^[a]disgrace among men.”

Luke 1:39-56 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Mary Visits Elizabeth

³⁹ Now at this time Mary arose and hurried to the hill country, to a city of Judah (Judea), ⁴⁰ and she entered the house of Zacharias and greeted Elizabeth. ⁴¹ When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, her baby leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit *and* empowered by Him. ⁴² And she exclaimed loudly, "Blessed [worthy to be praised] are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb! ⁴³ And how has it *happened* to me, that the mother of my Lord would come to me? ⁴⁴ For behold, when the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. ⁴⁵ And blessed [spiritually fortunate and favored by God] is she who believed *and* confidently trusted that there would be a fulfillment of the things that were spoken to her [by the angel sent] from the Lord." [Barrenness is considered a curse, stigma]

⁴⁶ And Mary said,

"My soul magnifies *and* exalts the Lord,

And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

"For He has looked [with loving care] on the humble state of His maidservant;

For behold, from now on all generations will count me blessed *and* happy *and* favored by God!

"For He who is mighty has done great things for me;

And holy is His name [to be worshiped in His purity, majesty, and glory].

"AND HIS MERCY IS UPON GENERATION AFTER GENERATION

TOWARD THOSE WHO [stand in great awe of God and] FEAR HIM.

"He has done mighty deeds with His [powerful] arm;

He has scattered *those who were* proud in the thoughts of their heart.

⁵⁶ And Mary stayed with Elizabeth for about three months, and then returned to her home.

Live through Jesus to manifest His power to us so others can see Jesus and experience His love first-hand.

⁹ In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him [when Mary received the miracle wine, she was living through Jesus].

¹⁰ Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation [satisfaction] for our sins.

Carry the Babies Full-Term, Refuse Abortion, Stillborn, Miscarriage

Romans 7:4-6 The Message (MSG)

⁴⁻⁶ So, my friends, this is something like what has taken place with you. When Christ died he took that entire rule-dominated way of life down with him and left it in the tomb, leaving you free to "marry" a resurrection life and bear "offspring" of faith for God. For as long as we lived that old way of life, doing whatever we felt we could get away with, sin was calling most of the shots as the old law code hemmed us in. And this made us all the more rebellious. In the end, all we had to show for it was miscarriages and stillbirths. But now that we're no longer shackled to that domineering mate

of sin, and out from under all those oppressive regulations and fine print, we're free to live a new life in the freedom of God.

The anointing makes the indwelling of Jesus tangible.

6)Processed by Impregnation

I recall the Lord inquiring from me "How long are you going to be pregnant?" In my irritation, I didn't answer because I was shocked that He would even ask such a question, knowing my plight. This is how I replied: "I'm always going to be pregnant. You are my babies' Daddy" Imagine multiple births.

Inexhaustible Fertility: not only endless, but also excess
