Psalm 80:7-19, NIV is a direct appeal to God for healing, deliverance, and breakthrough. God’s favor is being recalled when what they don’t desire is taking dominion. Unbelief, disobedience, and sin against the Lord are the root cause. Not only do they desire change around them, but also change within. “Restore us, God Almighty; make Your face shine on us, that we may be saved. You transplanted a vine from Egypt; You drove out the nations and planted it. You cleared the ground for it, and it took root and filled the land. The mountains were covered with its shade, the mighty cedars with its branches. Its branches reached as far as the Sea, its shoots as far as the River. Why have You broken down its walls so that all who pass by pick its grapes? Boars from the forest ravage it, and insects from the fields feed on it. Return to us, God Almighty! Look down from heaven and see! Watch over this vine, the root Your right hand has planted, the son You have raised up for Yourself. Your vine is cut down, it is burned with fire; at Your rebuke Your people perish. Let Your hand rest on the man at Your right hand, the son of man You have raised up for Yourself. Then we will not turn away from You; revive us, and we will call on Your name. Restore us, LORD God Almighty; make Your face shine on us, that we may be saved.” Be transformed!

ACTIVATE GOD’S VOICE AND VOW TO OVERTHROW ALL CROP FAILURES

Desire to experience the kind of restoration that only God can reproduce? Allow His Voice into every area of your life. “At that, GOD went into action to get His land back. He took pity on His people. GOD answered and spoke to His people, ‘Look, listen—I’m sending a gift: Grain and wine and olive oil. The fast is over—eat your fill! I won’t expose you any longer to contempt among the pagans. I’ll head off the final enemy coming out of the north and dump them in a wasteland. Half of them will end up in the Dead Sea, the other half in the Mediterranean. There they’ll rot, a stench to high heaven. The bigger the enemy, the stronger the stench!’ Fear not, Earth! Be glad and celebrate! GOD has done great things. Fear not, wild animals! The fields and meadows are greening up. The trees are bearing fruit again: a bumper crop of fig trees and vines! Children of Zion, celebrate! Be glad in your GOD. He’s giving you a teacher to train you how to live right—Teaching, like rain out of heaven, showers of words to refresh and nourish your soul, just as He used to do. And plenty of food for your body—silos full of grain, casks of wine and barrels of olive oil. ‘I’ll make up for the years of the locust, the great locust devastation—Locusts savage, locusts deadly, fierce locusts, locusts of doom, That great locust invasion I sent your way. You’ll eat your fill of good food. You’ll be full of praises to your GOD, The God who has set you back on your heels in wonder. Never again will my people be despised. You’ll know without question that I’m in the thick of life with Israel, That I’m your GOD, yes, *your* GOD, the one and only real God. Never again will my people be despised.’ Joel 2:18-27, MSG. His Voice also makes provision for His Vow. “But also on that Judgment Day I will restore David’s house that has fallen to pieces. I’ll repair the holes in the roof, replace the broken windows, fix it up like new. David’s people will be strong again and seize what’s left of enemy Edom, plus everyone else under my sovereign judgment.’ GOD’s Decree. He will do this. ‘Yes indeed, it won’t be long now.’ GOD’s Decree. ‘Things are going to happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won’t be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings! Blessings like wine pouring off the mountains and hills. I’ll make everything right again for my people Israel. They’ll rebuild their ruined cities. They’ll plant vineyards and drink good wine. They’ll work their gardens and eat fresh vegetables. And I’ll plant *them*, plant them on their own land. They’ll never again be uprooted from the land I’ve given them.’ GOD, your God, says so,” Amos 9:11-15, The MSG. Never prejudice heaven on earth.

RESOLUTE FAITH TAPS INTO THE SUPERNATURAL SUPPLY EVERY TIME

If you can conceive it on the inside and birth it on the outside, you can do it over and over again. Mary already birthed Jesus; stretching her faith, she became the wineskin who received Jesus, the new wine. She already reproduced the best heaven had to offer. Just do it again! She appeals to Jesus about the lack of wine because she is certain heaven has not run out of its supernatural supply. “And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there: And both Jesus was called, and His disciples, to the marriage. And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto Him, They have no wine. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? Mine hour is not yet come. His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever He saith unto you, do it. And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece. Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. And He saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it. When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now. This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth His glory; and His disciples believed on Him,” John 2:1-11, KJV. Fervent faith reproduces what it takes fermentation to complete in 30 years.

Thought for Transformation

The moment you agree with the Spirit and the Word who never differ, that is the beginning of supernatural agricultural success. Gabriel imparts to Mary how Holy Spirit will impregnate her womb in Luke 1:35, AMPC. “When the angel said to her, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a shining cloud]; and so the holy (pure, sinless) Thing (Offspring) which shall be born of you will be called the Son of God.” Mary’s response: she received the Word at the same level God released His Word. She agreed with the Word from heaven in Luke 1:37, AMPC. “For with God nothing is ever impossible and no word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfillment.”

Transformation Together

Jesus’ transforming message: “You must catch the troubling foxes, those sly little foxes that hinder our relationship. For they raid our budding vineyard of love to ruin what I’ve planted within you. Will you catch them and remove them for me? We will do it together,” SoS 2:15, TPT. Intimacy with God restores the fullness of the blessing. “Thus says the Lord: As the juice [of the grape] is found in the cluster, and one says, Do not destroy it, for there is a blessing in it, so will I do for My servants’ sake, that I may not destroy them all. And I will bring forth an offspring from Jacob, and from Judah an inheritor of My mountains; My chosen and elect will inherit it, and My servants will dwell there. And [the plain of] Sharon shall be a pasture and fold for flocks, and the Valley of Achor a place for herds to lie down, for My people who seek Me, inquire of Me, and require Me [by right of their necessity and by right of My invitation],” Isaiah 65:8-10, AMPC.
