John 12:23-25 The Message (MSG)

²²⁻²³ Philip went and told Andrew. Andrew and Philip together told Jesus.

Jesus answered, "Time's up. The time has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

²⁴⁻²⁵ "Listen carefully: Unless a grain of wheat is buried in the ground, dead to the world, it is never any more than a grain of wheat. But if it is buried, it sprouts and reproduces itself many times over. In the same way, anyone who holds on to life just as it is destroys that life. But if you let it go, reckless in your love, you'll have it forever, real and eternal.

Live through Jesus Christ

1 John 4:8-10 The Passion Translation (TPT)

⁸The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for God is love.^[a] ⁹The light of God's love shined within us^[b] when he sent his matchless^[c] Son into the world so that we might live through him.^[d] ¹⁰This is love:^[e] He loved us *long before we loved him*. It was his love, not ours. He proved it by sending his Son to be the pleasing sacrificial offering to take away our sins.^[f]

Co-Buried with Him, Co-Raised with Him

Romans 6:3-5 The Passion Translation (TPT)

³Or have you forgotten that all of us who were immersed into union with Jesus, the Anointed One, were immersed into union with his death?

⁴Sharing in his death by our baptism means that we were co-buried and entombed with him, so that when the Father's glory raised Christ from the dead, we were also raised with him. We have been co-resurrected with him so that we could be empowered to walk in the freshness of new life. ⁵For since we are permanently grafted into him^[a] to experience a death like his, then we are permanently grafted into him to experience a resurrection like his and the new life that it imparts.

⁵Even when we were dead and doomed in our many sins, he united us into the very life of Christ and saved us by his wonderful grace! ⁶He raised us up with Christ the exalted One, *and we ascended with him into the glorious perfection and authority* of the heavenly realm, for we are now co-seated^[a] as one with Christ!

⁷Throughout the coming ages^[b] we will be the visible display of the infinite, limitless riches of his grace and kindness, which was showered upon us in Jesus Christ.

¹⁴Since all his "children" have flesh and blood, so Jesus became human to fully identify with us. He did this, so that he could experience death and annihilate the effects of the intimidating accuser who holds against us the power^[a] [dominion] of death. ¹⁵By embracing death Jesus sets free those who live their entire lives in bondage^[b] [slavery] to the tormenting dread of death.

⁵I am calling up memories of your sincere *and* unqualified faith (the ^[a]leaning of your entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness), [a faith] that first lived permanently in [the heart of] your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am [fully] persuaded, [dwells] in you also.

⁶That is why I would remind you to stir up (rekindle the embers of, fan the flame of, and keep burning) the [gracious] gift of God, [the inner fire] that is in you by means of the laying on of my hands ^[b]with those of the elders at your ordination].

for so long to deal with God that they've lost touch not only with God but with reality itself. They can't think straight anymore. Feeling no pain, they let themselves go in sexual obsession, addicted to every sort of perversion.

²⁰⁻²⁴ But that's no life for you. You learned Christ! My assumption is that you have paid careful attention to him, been well instructed in the truth precisely as we have it in Jesus. Since, then, we do not have the excuse of ignorance, everything—and I do mean everything—connected with that old way of life has to go. It's rotten through and through. Get rid of it! And then take on an entirely new way of life—a God-fashioned life, a life renewed from the inside and working itself into your conduct as God accurately reproduces his character in you.

Cease to Exist to Sin, Live unto Righteousness

Ephesians 4:23-25 The Passion Translation (TPT)

²³ Now it's time to be made new by every revelation that's been given to you.^[a] ²⁴ And to be transformed as you embrace the glorious Christ-within as your new life and live in union with him! For God has re-created you all over again in his perfect righteousness, and you now belong to him in the realm of true holiness. ²⁵ So discard every form of dishonesty and lying *so that you will be known as one* who always speaks the truth, for we all belong to one another.

Clarity of Reproduction

John 3:1-7 Living Bible (TLB)

¹⁻² After dark one night a Jewish religious leader named Nicodemus, a member of the sect of the Pharisees, came for an interview with Jesus. "Sir," he said, "we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miracles are proof enough of this."

³ Jesus replied, "With all the earnestness I possess I tell you this: Unless you are born again, you can never get into the Kingdom of God."

⁴ "Born again!" exclaimed Nicodemus. "What do you mean? How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?"

⁵ Jesus replied, “What I am telling you so earnestly is this: Unless one is born of water and the Spirit,^[a] he cannot enter the Kingdom of God. ⁶ Men can only reproduce human life, but the Holy Spirit gives new life from heaven; ⁷ so don’t be surprised at my statement that you must be born again!

- a. [John 3:5](#) *Unless one is born of water and the Spirit*, or “Physical birth is not enough. You must be born spiritually.” This alternate paraphrase interprets “born of water” as meaning the normal process observed during every human birth. Some think this means water baptism.

2 Corinthians 5:14-18 The Passion Translation (TPT)

¹⁴ For it is Christ’s love that fuels our passion and motivates us,^[a] because we are absolutely convinced that he has given his life for all of us. This means all died with him, ¹⁵ so that those who live^[b] should no longer live self-absorbed lives but lives that are poured out for him—the one who died for us and now lives again. ¹⁶ So then, from now on, we have a new perspective that refuses to evaluate people merely by their outward appearances. For that’s how we once viewed the Anointed One, but no longer do we see him with limited human insight.^[c]

¹⁷ Now, if anyone is enfolded into Christ, he has become an entirely new creation. All that is related to the old order has vanished.^[d] Behold, everything is fresh and new.^[e] ¹⁸ And God has made all things new,^[f] and reconciled^[g] us to himself, and given us the ministry of reconciling others to God.

1 John 1:1-3 The Voice (VOICE)

1 We want to tell you about the One who was from the beginning. We have seen Him with our own eyes, heard Him with our own ears, and touched Him with our own hands. This One is *the manifestation of the life-giving Voice*, ² and He showed us real life, *eternal life*. We have seen it *all, and we can’t keep what we witnessed quiet*—we have to share it with you. *We are inviting you to experience eternal life through the One who was with the Father and came down to us.* ³ What we saw and heard we pass on to you so that you, too, will be connected with us intimately *and become family*. Our

family is united by our connection with the Father and His Son Jesus, the Anointed One;

Moving from the kingdom of this world system

Matthew 6:25-33 The Passion Translation (TPT)

²⁵ “This is why I tell you to never be worried about your life, for all that you need will be provided, such as food, water, clothing—everything your body needs. Isn’t there more to your life than a meal? Isn’t your body more than clothing?

²⁶ “Look at all the birds—do you think they worry about their existence? They don’t plant or reap or store up food, yet your heavenly Father provides them each with food. Aren’t you much more valuable to your Father than they? ²⁷ So, which one of you by worrying could add anything to your life?^[a]

²⁸ “And why would you worry about your clothing? Look at all the beautiful flowers of the field. They don’t work or toil, ²⁹ and yet not even Solomon in all his splendor was robed in beauty more than one of these! ³⁰ So if God has clothed the meadow with hay, which is here for such a short time and then dried up and burned, won’t he provide for you the clothes you need—even though you live with such little faith?

³³ “So above all, constantly chase after the realm of God’s kingdom^[c] and the righteousness that proceeds from him. Then all these less important things will be given to you abundantly.^[d]

Move with Heaven’s Magnitude

John 14:1-3 Expanded Bible (EXB) Jesus Comforts His Followers

Jesus said, “Don’t let your hearts be troubled. ·Trust [Believe] in God, and ·trust [believe] in me [or You trust/believe in God, trust/believe also in

me]. ²There are many ·rooms [places to live] in my Father's house [^cheaven, metaphorically portrayed as a great palace]; I would not tell you this if it were not true. I am going there to prepare a place for you. ³·After [¹And if] I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me so that you may be where I am.

Move with Heaven's Accumulation

Isaiah 54:1-6 The Message (MSG)

¹⁻⁶“Sing, barren woman, who has never had a baby.

Fill the air with song, you who've never experienced childbirth!

You're ending up with far more children

than all those childbearing women.” GOD says so!

“Clear lots of ground for your tents!

Make your tents large. Spread out! Think big!

Use plenty of rope,

drive the tent pegs deep.

You're going to need lots of elbow room

for your growing family.

You're going to take over whole nations;

you're going to resettle abandoned cities.

Don't be afraid—you're not going to be embarrassed.

Don't hold back—you're not going to come up short.

Amos 9:11-15 The Message (MSG)

¹¹⁻¹² "But also on that Judgment Day I will restore David's house that has fallen to pieces. I'll repair the holes in the roof, replace the broken windows, fix it up like new. David's people will be strong again and seize what's left of enemy Edom, plus everyone else under my sovereign judgment." God's Decree. He will do this.

¹³⁻¹⁵ "Yes indeed, it won't be long now." God's Decree.
