RULE IN THE MIDST OF YOUR ENEMIES

Jesus is celebrated as the Conqueror in Revelation 1:18 (KJV) "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death." Hebrews 2:14-15 (TPT) confirms Jesus made you triumphant even over the power of death as well as the fear of death. "Since all His children have flesh and blood, so Jesus became human to fully identify with us. He did this, so that He could experience death and annihilate the effects of the intimidating accuser who holds against us the power of death. By embracing death Jesus sets free those who live their entire lives in bondage to the tormenting dread of death." Proverbs 18:21 (KJV) clarifies that your command is in your mouth, so understand the power you already carry around. "Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof." Satan cannot have any power unless you give him yours. Everything good comes from God. Everything evil was perverted from being good by Satan. Determine to exercise the authority and power that invokes the blessing of the Lord and prohibits the curse of the law. Live on the lookout to reverse the curse to restore the blessing of the Lord that makes rich and adds no sorrow with it.

COMING OUT OF A FAILURE TO THRIVE TO REIGN SUCCESSFULLY

A failure to thrive means living dwarfed, i.e., low luminosity exists. Use Psalm 43:3,4 (KJV) to petition God. "O send out Thy light and Thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto Thy holy hill, and to Thy tabernacles. Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise Thee, O God my God." Receive Isaiah 60:1-3; 19-22 (KJV) as God's provision. "Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising. The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory. Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the LORD shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended. Thy people also shall be all righteous: they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of My planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified. A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the LORD will hasten it in His time. Deuteronomy 1:10-11 (AMPC) is your promise from God. "The Lord your God has multiplied you, and behold, you are this day as the stars of the heavens for multitude. May the Lord, the God of your fathers, make you a thousand times as many as you are and bless you as He has promised you!" Fathered by God, kings have been multiplied in your genes as your offspring. Let birthing and attracting royalty to God's light in you be your new normal thing.

THE SUCCESSION OF KINGS CAN ONLY BE TRIUMPHANT

Jesus' Triumph: John 16:33 (AMPC) "I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace *and* confidence. In the world you have tribulation *and* trials *and* distress *and* frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.]" **David's Triumph:** 1 Chronicles 22:17-19 (KJV) "David also commanded all the princes of Israel to help Solomon his son, saying, Is not the LORD your God with you? and hath He not given you rest on every side? for He hath given the inhabitants of the land into mine hand; and the land is subdued before the LORD, and before His people. Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD." **Korah's sons Triumph:** Psalm 44:1-8 (KJV) "We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, what work Thou didst in their days, in the times of old. How Thou didst drive out the heathen with Thy hand, and plantedst them; how Thou didst afflict the people, and cast them out. For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but Thy right hand, and Thine arm, and the light of Thy countenance, because Thou hadst a favour unto them. Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob. Through Thee will we push down our enemies: through Thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us. For I will not trust in my bow, neither shall my sword save me. But Thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us. In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever. Selah." Now you are building on the past triumphs. God's honor raises you up to be seated with Christ while His majesty subdues the enemy under your feet." **David is interceding for future kings which includes Jesus and you.** Psalm 21:5-7 (KJV) "His glory is great in Thy salvation: honour and majesty hast Thou laid upon him. For Thou hast made him most blessed for ever: Thou hast made him exceeding glad with Thy countenance. For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved."

Thought for Transformation

As the Head, Jesus' anointing flows to the Church, the feet, i.e., "de"- "feat."

"The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, And what is the exceeding greatness of His power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power, Which He wrought in Christ when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: and hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all," Eph. 1:18-23 (KJV). "And God, the source of shalom, will soon crush the Adversary under your feet. The grace of our Lord Yeshua be with you," Rom. 16:20 (CJB).
