God's vowed promises are backed by His name because of His endless covenant with you. Throughout the Old Testament, you will discover His multi-faceted nature on display. Distinct names have been directly associated with our all-encompassing covenant in every area, at all times.

Throughout the New Testament, every name formerly referenced to God has been fulfilled in just one name, Jesus Christ. His name reaches the highest heavens, the depths of the lowest hell, as well as to the earth's circumference.

However, every invocation of The Blessing requires an invitation from you alone. When you voice activate The Blessing that equals your authority to officially sign His name. As a joint heir with Jesus, your benefits of salvation include God's: aid, prosperity; welfare; help; victory; and deliverance.
