**Feeler** – emotions, make appealing and/or arousing expressions, passionate, sensation; animated; stimulates responses and reactions, agitates, momentum

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 The Passion Translation (TPT)

<sup>4</sup>Love is *large and* incredibly patient.<sup>[a]</sup> Love is gentle and consistently kind to all. It refuses to be jealous<sup>[b]</sup> *when blessing comes to someone else*. Love does not brag about one's achievements nor inflate its own importance. <sup>5</sup>Love does not traffic in shame and disrespect, nor selfishly seek its own honor. <sup>2</sup>And Samuel said, How can I go? if Saul hear it, he will kill me. And the LORD said, Take an heifer with thee, and say, I am come to sacrifice to the LORD.

<sup>3</sup>And call Jesse to the sacrifice, and I will shew thee what thou shalt do: and thou shalt anoint unto me him whom I name unto thee.

<sup>4</sup>And Samuel did that which the LORD spake, and came to Bethlehem. And the elders of the town trembled at his coming, and said, Comest thou peaceably?

<sup>5</sup>And he said, Peaceably: I am come to sacrifice unto the LORD: sanctify yourselves, and come with me to the sacrifice. And he sanctified Jesse and his sons, and called them to the sacrifice.

<sup>6</sup>And it came to pass, when they were come, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD's anointed is before him.

<sup>7</sup>But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

<sup>8</sup>Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

<sup>9</sup>Then Jesse made Shammah to pass by. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

<sup>10</sup>Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these.

<sup>11</sup>And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And

Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

<sup>12</sup>And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he.

<sup>13</sup>Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

<sup>14</sup>But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

### **Commitment to Love**

Mark 12:30-33 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>30</sup>And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

<sup>31</sup>And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

<sup>32</sup>And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he:

<sup>33</sup>And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

<sup>4</sup>Love endures long *and* is patient and kind; love never is envious *nor* boils over with jealousy, is not boastful *or* vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily.

<sup>5</sup>It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) *and* does not act unbecomingly. Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights *or* its own way, *for* it is not self-seeking; it is not

touchy *or* fretful *or* resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong].

<sup>6</sup>It does not rejoice at injustice *and* unrighteousness, but rejoices when right *and* truth prevail.

<sup>7</sup>Love bears up under anything *and* everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything [without weakening].

<sup>8</sup>Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end]. As for prophecy (<sup>[a]</sup>the gift of interpreting the divine will and purpose), it will be fulfilled *and* pass away; as for tongues, they will be destroyed *and* cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away [it will lose its value and be superseded by truth].

## **Covenant Fulfillment Requires Partnership**

2 Samuel 23:1-5 The Voice (VOICE)

**23** Here are the last words of David, son of Jesse: the words of the one raised up, the anointed one of Jacob's True God, the sweet songwriter of Israel.

<sup>2</sup>**David:** The Spirit of the Eternal speaks through me;  
His voice emerges from my mouth.

<sup>3</sup> The God of Israel has talked to me;  
and the Rock of Israel said,  
"One who rules people with justice  
and who leads them in the fear of God

<sup>4</sup> Is like the morning light,  
the sun rising on a cloudless morning,  
and the shining grasslands brought up from rain."

<sup>5</sup> Isn't this how God has raised up my house?  
Because He has made a perpetual covenant with me,  
well-ordered and secure,  
Won't He make all things to grow *and prosper*,  
save me, and give me all I desire?

Hebrews 10:16-23 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

<sup>16</sup>This is the agreement (testament, covenant) that I will set up *and* conclude with them after those days, says the Lord: I will imprint My laws upon their hearts, and I will inscribe them on their minds (on their inmost thoughts and understanding),

<sup>17</sup>He then goes on to say, And their sins and their lawbreaking I will remember no more.<sup>(A)</sup>

<sup>18</sup>Now where there is absolute remission (forgiveness and cancellation of the penalty) of these [sins and lawbreaking], there is no longer any offering made to atone for sin.

<sup>19</sup>Therefore, brethren, since we have full freedom *and* confidence to enter into the [Holy of] Holies [by the power and virtue] in the blood of Jesus,

<sup>20</sup>By this fresh (new) and living way which He initiated *and* dedicated *and* opened for us through the separating curtain (veil of the Holy of Holies), that is, through His flesh,

<sup>21</sup>And since we have [such] a great *and* wonderful *and* noble Priest [Who rules] over the house of God,

<sup>22</sup>Let us all come forward *and* draw near with true (honest and sincere) hearts in unqualified assurance *and* absolute conviction engendered by faith (by <sup>[a]</sup>that leaning of the entire human personality on God in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness), having our hearts sprinkled *and* purified from a guilty (evil) conscience and our bodies cleansed with pure water.

<sup>23</sup>So let us seize *and* hold fast *and* retain without wavering the <sup>[b]</sup>hope we cherish *and* confess *and* our acknowledgement of it, for He Who promised is reliable (sure) *and* faithful to His word.

## **Characteristics of the Heart**

Unbelieving-Believer: Skeptical about seeing what they believe

Unbelieving-Unbeliever: must always see it to believe it

Believing-Believer: only sees the future brighter, never having any proof of the finished work. Capture God's vision until it is indelible.

Receiving-Believer: Confidently receives the end of its faith now, so patiently endures until manifestation comes

<sup>28</sup>And he came to her and said, Hail, O favored one [<sup>[b]</sup>endued with grace]! The Lord is with you! <sup>[c]</sup>*Blessed (favored of God) are you before all other women!*

<sup>29</sup>But *when she saw him*, she was greatly troubled *and* disturbed *and* confused at what he said and kept revolving in her mind what such a greeting might mean.

<sup>30</sup>And the angel said to her, Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found grace (<sup>[d]</sup>free, spontaneous, absolute favor and loving-kindness) with God.

<sup>31</sup>And listen! You will become pregnant and will give birth to a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus.

<sup>32</sup>He will be great (eminent) and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His forefather David,

<sup>33</sup>And He will reign over the house of Jacob throughout the ages; and of His reign there will be no end.<sup>(A)</sup>

<sup>34</sup>And Mary said to the angel, How can this be, since I have no [intimacy with any man as a] husband?

<sup>35</sup>Then the angel said to her, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a shining cloud]; and so the holy (pure, sinless) Thing (Offspring) which shall be born *of you* will be called the Son of God.<sup>(B)</sup>

<sup>36</sup>And listen! Your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is now the sixth month with her who was called barren.

<sup>37</sup>For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* no word from God shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment.

<sup>38</sup>Then Mary said, Behold, I am the handmaiden of the Lord; let it be done to me according to what you have said. And the angel left her.
