The sure way to give an eyewitness account of the glory of God is by being intimately acquainted with Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Trinity. He will take you from one level of glory to the next level of glory. Imagine this! He endues you with the mind of Christ. Hosting the empowerment of His grace, you will not only see signs of improvement, but also endowed with beauty and elegance that show the noticeable difference. Chosen as God's credible witness, the Jesus in you will whet the appetite of others to experience their own union with Christ.

The Triumph of Grace over Sin

So what do we do, then? Do we persist in sin so that God's kindness and grace will increase? ²What a terrible thought! We have died to sin once and for all, as a dead man passes away from this life. So how could we live under sin's rule a moment longer? ³Or have you forgotten that all of us who were

immersed into union with Jesus, the Anointed One, were immersed into union with his death?

⁴Sharing in his death by our baptism means that we were co-buried and entombed with him, so that when the Father's glory raised Christ from the dead, we were also raised with him. We have been co-resurrected with him so that we could be empowered to walk in the freshness of new life. ⁵For since we are permanently grafted into him^[a] to experience a death like his, then we are permanently grafted into him to experience a resurrection like his and the new life that it imparts.

Conquering

1 John 5:1-15 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Overcoming the World

Everyone who believes [with a deep, abiding trust in the fact] that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed) is born of God [that is, reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, and set apart for His purpose], and everyone who loves the Father also loves atthe *child* born of Him. ²By this we know [without any doubt] that we love the children of God: [expressing that love] when we love God and obey His commandments. ³For the [true] love of God is this: that we *habitually* keep His commandments *and* remain focused on His precepts. And His commandments *and* His precepts are not difficult [to obey]. ⁴For the veryone born of God is victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God].

⁵Who is the one who is victorious *and* overcomes the world? It is the one who believes *and* recognizes the fact that Jesus is the Son of God. ⁶This is He who came through water and blood [His baptism and death], Jesus Christ—not by the water only, but by the water and the blood. It is the [Holy] Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. [He is the essence and origin of truth itself.] ⁷For there are three witnesses: ⁸the Spirit and the water and the blood; and these three are in agreement [their testimony is perfectly consistent]. ⁹If we accept [as we do] the testimony of men [that is, if we are willing to take the sworn statements of fallible humans as evidence], the testimony of God is greater [far more authoritative]; for this is the testimony of God, that He has testified regarding His Son. ¹⁰The one who believes in the Son of God [who adheres to, trusts in, and relies confidently on Him as Savior] has the testimony within himself [because he can speak authoritatively about Christ from his own personal experience]. The one who does not believe God [in this way] has made Him [out to be] a liar, because he has not believed in the evidence that God has given regarding His Son. ¹¹And the testimony is this: God has given us eternal life [we already possess it], and this life is in His Son [resulting in our spiritual completeness, and eternal companionship with Him]. ¹²He who has the Son [by accepting Him as Lord and Savior] has the life [that is eternal]; he who does not have the Son of God [by personal faith] does not have the life.

This Is Written That You May Know

¹³These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God [which represents all that Jesus Christ is and does], so that you will know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that you [already] have eternal life. ¹⁴This is the [remarkable degree of] confidence which we [as believers are entitled to] have before Him: that ^[]if we ask anything according to His will, [that is, consistent with His plan and purpose] He hears us. ¹⁵And if we know [for a fact, as indeed we do] that He hears *and* listens to us in whatever we ask, we [also] know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted to us] the requests which we have asked from Him.

- a. <u>1 John 5:1</u> This could refer either to other born-again believers or to Jesus.
- b. <u>1 John 5:4</u> Lit everything that is. John uses the Greek neuter to underscore the fact that everyone who has been born again, regardless of gender or age, is victorious over the world.
- c. <u>1 John 5:14</u> Confident, abiding faith combined with God's power can produce amazing results, if the request is in harmony with God's will. God is fully capable of doing that which man regards as impossible (Mark 14:36; James 4:3).

a. John 19:34 This becomes a picture of the cleansing by blood and the water of the Holy Spirit. However, water and blood both come forth when a baby is born. Christ gave birth on the cross to "sons." He is the everlasting Father (Isa. 9:6), and you must have children to be a Father. We are all born again by the wounded side of Jesus Christ. He not only died for his bride, but he also gave birth to her at the cross.

¹⁴Since we, God's children, are human beings—made of flesh and blood—he became flesh and blood too by being born in human form; for only as a human being could he die and in dying break the power of the devil who had the power of death. ¹⁵Only in that way could he deliver those who through fear of death have been living all their lives as slaves to constant dread.

¹¹In Him also you were circumcised with a circumcision not made with hands, but in a [spiritual] circumcision [performed by] Christ by stripping off the body of the flesh (the whole corrupt, carnal nature with its passions and lusts).

¹²[Thus ^[b]you were circumcised when] you were buried with Him in [your] baptism, in which you were also raised with Him [^[c]to a new life] through [your] faith in the working of God [^[d]as displayed] when He raised Him up from the dead.

¹³And you who were dead in trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your flesh (your sensuality, your sinful carnal nature), [God] brought to life together with [Christ], having [freely] forgiven us all our transgressions,

¹⁴Having cancelled *and* blotted out *and* wiped away the handwriting of the note (bond) with its legal decrees *and* demands which was in force *and* stood against us (hostile to us). This [note with its regulations, decrees, and demands] He set aside *and* cleared ^[e]completely out of our way by nailing it to [His] cross.

¹⁵[God] disarmed the principalities and powers that were ranged against us and made a bold display *and* public example of them, in triumphing over them in Him *and* in it [the cross].

Consciousness and Cognizance of God

¹⁵But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

¹⁶For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? but we have the mind of Christ.

Carrier of the Anointing

¹⁹Now you understand that I have imparted to you all my authority to trample over his kingdom. You will trample upon every demon before you and overcome every power^[a] satan possesses. Absolutely nothing will be able to harm you as you walk in this authority. ²⁰However, your real source of joy isn't merely that these spirits submit to your authority, but that your names are written in the journals of heaven and that you belong to God's kingdom. This is the true source of your authority."

²¹Then Jesus, overflowing with the Holy Spirit's anointing of joy, exclaimed, "Father, thank you, for you are Lord Supreme over heaven and earth! You have hidden the great revelation of this authority from those who are proud, those wise in their own eyes, and you have shared it with these who humbled themselves. Yes, Father. This is what pleases your heart and the very way you've chosen to extend your kingdom: to give to those who become like trusting children. ²² "Father, you have entrusted me with all that you are and all that you have. No one fully knows the Son except the Father. And no one fully knows the Father except the Son. But the Son is able to introduce and reveal the Father to anyone he chooses."

²³When Jesus was alone with the Twelve, he said to them, "You are very privileged to see and hear all these things. ²⁴Many kings and prophets of old longed to see these days of miracles that you've been favored to see. They would have given everything to hear the revelation you've been favored to hear. Yet they didn't get to see as much as a glimpse or hear even a whisper."

For we were co-crucified with him to dismantle the stronghold of sin within us,^[c] so that we would not continue to live one moment longer submitted to sin's power.^[d] ⁷Obviously, a dead person is incapable of sinning. ⁸And if we were cocrucified with the Anointed One, we know that we will also share in the fullness of his life. ⁹And we know that since the Anointed One has been raised from the dead to die no more, his resurrection life has vanquished death and its power over him is finished. ¹⁰For by his sacrifice he died to sin's power once and for all,^[1] but he now lives continuously for the Father's pleasure. ¹¹So let it be the same way with you! Since you are now joined with him, you must continually view yourselves as dead and unresponsive to sin's appeal while living daily for God's pleasure in union with Jesus, the Anointed One.

Sin's Reign Is Over

¹²Sin is a dethroned monarch; so you must no longer give it an opportunity to rule over your life, controlling how you live and compelling you to obey its desires and cravings. ¹³So then, refuse to answer its call to surrender your body as a tool for wickedness. Instead, passionately answer God's call to keep yielding your body to him as one who has now experienced resurrection life! You live now for his pleasure, ready to be used for his noble purpose.^{III} ¹⁴Remember this: sin will not conquer you, for God already has! You are not governed by law but governed by the reign of the grace of God.

Grace Frees Us to Serve God

¹⁵What are we to do, then? Should we sin to our hearts' content since there's no law to condemn us anymore? What a terrible thought! ¹⁶Don't you realize that grace frees you to choose your own master? But choose carefully, for you surrender yourself to become a servant—bound to the one you choose to obey. If you choose to love sin, it will become your master, and it will own you and reward you with death. But if you choose to love and obey God, he will lead you into perfect righteousness.

¹⁷And God is pleased with you,^[1] for in the past you were servants of sin, but now your obedience is heart deep, and your life is being molded by truth through the teaching you are devoted to.^[1] ¹⁸And now you celebrate your freedom from your former master—sin. You've left its bondage, and now God's perfect righteousness holds power over you as his loving servants.

- b. Romans 6:6 The Aramaic can be translated "our old son of Adam."
- c. Romans 6:6 Or "body of sin would no longer have dominion over us."
- d. <u>Romans 6:6</u> Or "that the body of sin might be annulled" (put out of business). To beg God for victory over sin is a refusal to understand that we have already died to sin. Our joyful task is to believe the good news, rather than to seek to "crucify ourselves." Sin is not suppressed by the cross; it is eliminated. Upon this "water" God commands us to step out and walk upon it, for we are now in him.

- f. <u>Romans 6:13</u> Or "For the members of your body will be used as weapons for the righteousness of God."

He Who comes from heaven is [far] above all others [far superior to all others in prominence and in excellence].

³² It is to what He has [actually] seen and heard that He bears testimony, and yet no one accepts His testimony [no one receives His evidence as true].

³³Whoever receives His testimony has set his seal of approval to this: God is true. [That man has definitely certified, acknowledged, declared once and for all, and is himself assured that it is divine truth that God cannot lie].

³⁴For since He Whom God has sent speaks the words of God [proclaims God's own message], God does not give Him His Spirit sparingly *or* by measure, *but* boundless is the gift God makes of His Spirit!

³⁵The Father loves the Son and has given (entrusted, committed) everything into His hand.

³⁶ And he who believes in (has faith in, clings to, relies on) the Son has (now possesses) eternal life. But whoever disobeys (is unbelieving toward, refuses to trust in, disregards, is not subject to) the Son will never see (experience) life, but [instead] the wrath of God abides on him. [God's displeasure remains on him; His indignation hangs over him continually.]

John 5:30 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

³⁰I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek *or* consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will *and* pleasure of the Father Who sent Me.

¹⁹*In short, the Spirit is upon Me* to proclaim that now is the time; this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One's grace.^[a]

²⁰ Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant. Then He sat down, *as a teacher would do,* and all in the synagogue focused their attention on Jesus, *waiting for Him to speak*. ²¹ He told them that these words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in their hearing.

a. Psalm 23:5 The word oil becomes a symbol of the Holy Spirit.

1 John 2:20 Amplified Bible (AMP)

²⁰ But you have an anointing from the Holy One [you have been set apart, specially gifted and prepared by the Holy Spirit], and all of you know [the truth because He teaches us, illuminates our minds, and guards us from error].

1 John 2:27 Complete Jewish Bible (CJB)

²⁷ As for you, the Messianic anointing you received from the Father remains in you, so that you have no need for anyone to teach you. On the contrary, as his Messianic anointing continues to teach you about all things, and is true, not a counterfeit, so, just as he taught you, remain united with him.

1 John 2:27 The Voice (VOICE)

²⁷You have an anointing. You received it from Him, and His anointing remains on you. You do not need any other teacher. But as His anointing instructs you in all *the essentials* (all the truth uncontaminated by darkness and lies), it teaches you this: "Remain connected to Him."

1 John 2:27 The Passion Translation (TPT)

²⁷ But the wonderful anointing you have received from God^[a] *is so much greater than their deception and* now lives in you. There's no need for anyone to keep teaching you.^[a] His anointing teaches you all that you need to know, for it will lead you into truth, not a counterfeit. So just as the anointing has taught you, remain in him.^[a]

Footnotes:

- a. <u>1 John 2:27</u> Although absent in the Greek, the words "from God" are found in the Aramaic manuscripts. It is clear from the context that the "anointing" is the Holy Spirit poured into us, bringing life, illumination, wisdom, fruit, and power from the indwelling life of Christ.
- b. <u>1 John 2:27</u> Or "There is no need for anyone to keep teaching you his opinions [deceptions]." John is not telling them not to continue to be taught the Word of God, for God has placed teachers in the church to instruct us and equip us and bring us into the fullness of Christ (<u>1 Cor. 12:28</u>; <u>Eph. 4:11</u>; <u>Heb. 13:7</u>, <u>17</u>). John's warning concerns those who lead us astray by the false doctrines of men. The bride of Christ will always need Holy Spirit-filled teachers who illuminate us in the ways of Christ.
- c. <u>1 John 2:27</u> The Greek can be translated "remain in it" (the anointing).
