If you give others something that is too big for them, instead of raising it up to its highest level, they will bring it down to their size. Enrichment declares what you have in Christ. Recognize you have been given an eternal inheritance as a joint-heir with Jesus Christ. Then you will not tolerate anything missing, lacking, or broken because you have room ample room to receive the abundant supply to be in demand.

Enforcement declares what you can do in Christ. Recognize you are more than a conqueror because Jesus Christ always causes you to triumph in everything. Then you will not live in defeat in anything but instead fight from the place of victory knowing that by grace, God bruised satan under your feet.

Arise to the occasion. Crowd out deception, errors, and lies. Let Holy Spirit cram the void.
