God desires you to be free to live free. Where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty. He supernaturally removes every root that causes the breach, even if it is breach upon breach upon breach. Holy Spirit ushers you into the abundant life so you will never trust in oppression anymore. Now refuse to be an obstruction against your own breakthrough.

Jesus hosted the Spirit of God without measure because He always hosted the Word of God, i.e., *logos* and *rhema*. God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and supernatural power; He went about during good and healing all those who were oppressed by satan. As a member of the Body of Christ, the Bride of Christ, the War Bride, you have already inherited the ministry of Jesus Christ. When you believe that, you share the life Jesus came to give you. Anointed with Holy Ghost and supernatural power, you are the breakthrough empowered to use the weapons of mass deliverance.

A serpent can only bite when there is a breach in you or your bloodline even all the way back to Adam. That transgression or iniquity derives from the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and/or the pride of life. Nevertheless, Jesus, the Lord of the Breakthrough healed every breach, hedged every breach, and hushed every breach so nothing could exercise dominion against you. Since "The Breaker" destroyed satan who had the power of death as well as delivered you from the fear of living in dread, there is not a breach left. No irreconcilable differences!

4.break every yoke - eradicate the weapons of mass destruction

Yoke H4133 *môwtâh* a pole – bands, heavy staves, yoke [captivated or subjugated that's causing you to pull the heavy weight]

From H4132 a wavering, i.e., fall; (as essentially a bent pole) –bar; be moved; staff; yoke

From H4131 to waver; by impl. To slip, shake, fall; be carried, cast, be out of course, be fallen to decay.
