

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 101 Scriptures

It was impossible for Abba Father to live without you. For that reason, He graciously gave His only be-gotten Son. The supernatural blood transfusion through Jesus Christ caused you to be born again as His offspring. Since God already gave you His best gift, why would He ever withhold anything else from you? God bestowed upon you His inheritance i.e., all that He is and all that He has.

Now it is your turn to move toward Abba Father knowing He is always approachable, never reproachable. Covered by the blood of the Lamb and accepted in the Beloved, confidently come boldly to the throne of grace where you always have undeniable access to live in God's presence. It is a rejection free zone.

Without a shadow of doubt, you have an everlasting Father whose love casts out even a hint of fear in order to seal your timeless relationship with Him. Even if you are still unsure of your standing, Holy Spirit works in you to develop an intimate relationship knitting your hearts together with God's love as one. In that way, you will realize God loves you just as much as He loves Jesus. Even if you begin with only radioactive mistrust, the Spirit of God and the Word of God builds you up until you experience proactive trust in God.

1. Abba Father carved out your way into His family through Jesus.

YOUR FORMAL INTRODUCTION TO ABBA FATHER

Whether your status is a present son or daughter of God, a potential child, or a prodigal offspring, God always remains approachable no matter the situation. His constant affection extends in both directions. You are always welcome to come to Him as your loving Father just as you are, no matter the relational distance. Also, He is sensitively working behind the scenes for you to hear Him beckoning you. In the moment you begin to move toward Him He runs to embrace you warmly. You can expect Abba to always respond to you as a merciful Parent. In that way, you will discover His compassion, i.e., His desire to help you even more than your desire to receive His help.

Fatherhood as experienced on earth leaves an indelible impression on each child. Either they become just like their father or totally opposite from him. Often that imprint causes that child to believe the Heavenly Father is a replica of that experience, whether that is good, bad, ugly, and really ugly.

If the father was approachable like our Heavenly Father, they had a healthy lifestyle growing up: there was order; balance; wholeness; fullness; and overflow that sprang out of his love for his offspring.

On the other hand, if the father was abusive, the child will probably anticipate cruel treatment from the Heavenly Father. God is not an abusive Father toward you as His child. In fact, the Lord reserves His assaults for your enemies alone, satan.

If the father was absentee, the child probably has a fear of being abandoned some day, all of the time, or even seasonal. God is not an absentee Father because He never leaves you or forsakes you.

If their father was admissable, the child may attempt to manipulate the relationship to the extreme; they have been allowed to do whatever they wanted to do and never received any correction at all. God is not an admissable Father either. His comprehensive training covers what is acceptable as well as what is unacceptable to Him. Because our Heavenly Father always has blessing on His mind, He desires to teach you how to avoid the curse at all cost.

2.Holy Spirit authentically confirms your adoption in the family of God.

Holy Spirit ushers you into your formal introduction to Abba Father Galatians 4:1-7 King James Version (KJV)

¹ Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

² But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.

³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world:

⁴ But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

⁵ To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

⁶ And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

⁷ Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Holy Spirit ushers you into intimacy with Abba Father

Romans 8:14-17 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁴ For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

¹⁵ For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

¹⁷ And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Holy Spirit ushers you into making your invocation before Abba Father. Jesus' instructions in Matthew 7:7-12 ensures us that when you pray for good that God will never respond to you with anything evil. God knows the difference between good and evil and He is disposed to be always be good to you.

3. Your inheritance rights as an heir of God and a joint heir with Jesus are at the same level as the riches of His glory.

Here's my story. I was born third out of four siblings. At one time or another was I repositioned as the oldest, the youngest, and even the only. I even thought I had an adopted until I was eighteen years old. I felt that I never belonged in that particular family. What was strange, I knew for sure that my Mom's mother, Big-Ma was my grandmother. I even dreaded the day my parents would tell me they were not my birth parents. Unfortunately, that stronghold of abandonment did not help my relationship with God who was desirous of being my Abba Father. 4.The Holy Spirit is God's first down payment who seals your receipt for the rest of your inheritance.

¹⁴Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

5.The testimony of Jesus covers the shame of the worst offender and changes him/her into one of His best defender of the gospel.
