## **God honored Jesus Christ yesterday, today, and forever**

Hebrews 1 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

In many separate revelations [<sup>[a]</sup>each of which set forth a portion of the Truth] and in different ways God spoke of old to [our] forefathers in *and* by the prophets,

<sup>2</sup>[But] in <sup>[b]</sup>the last of these days He has spoken to us in [the person of a] Son, Whom He appointed Heir *and* lawful Owner of all things, also by *and* through Whom He created the worlds *and* the reaches of space *and* the ages of time [He made, produced, built, operated, and arranged them in order].

<sup>3</sup>He is the sole expression of the glory of God [the Light-being, the <sup>[c]</sup>out-raying or radiance of the divine], and He is the perfect imprint *and* very image of [God's] nature, upholding *and* maintaining *and* guiding *and* propelling the universe by His mighty word [*rhema*] of power [*dunamis*]. When He had *by offering Himself* accomplished *our* cleansing of sins *and* riddance of guilt, He sat down at the right hand of the divine Majesty on high,

<sup>4</sup>[Taking a place and rank by which] He Himself became as much superior to angels as the glorious Name (title) which He has inherited is different from *and* more excellent than theirs.

<sup>5</sup>For to which of the angels did [God] ever say, You are My Son, today I have begotten You [established You in an official Sonship relation, with kingly dignity]? And again, I will be to Him a Father, and He will be to Me a Son?

<sup>6</sup>Moreover, when He brings the firstborn Son <sup>[d]</sup>again into the habitable world, He says, Let all the angels of God worship Him.

<sup>7</sup>Referring to the angels He says, [God] Who makes His angels winds and His ministering servants flames of fire;

<sup>8</sup>But as to the Son, He says to Him, Your throne, O God, is forever and ever (to the ages of the ages), and the scepter of Your kingdom is a scepter of absolute righteousness (of justice and straightforwardness).

<sup>9</sup>You have loved righteousness [You have delighted in integrity, virtue, and uprightness in purpose, thought, and action] and You have hated lawlessness (injustice and iniquity). Therefore God, [even] Your God (<sup>[e]</sup>Godhead), has anointed You with the oil of exultant joy *and* gladness above *and* beyond Your companions.

<sup>10</sup>And [further], You, Lord, did lay the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the works of Your hands.

<sup>11</sup>They will perish, but You remain *and* continue permanently; they will all grow old *and* wear out like a garment.

<sup>12</sup>Like a mantle [thrown about one's self] You will roll them up, and they will be changed *and* replaced by others. But You remain the same, and Your years will never end *nor* come to failure.

<sup>13</sup>Besides, to which of the angels has He ever said, Sit at My right hand [associated with Me in My royal dignity] till I make your enemies a stool for your feet?

<sup>14</sup>Are not the angels all ministering spirits (servants) sent out in the service [of God for the assistance] of those who are to inherit salvation?

## **Testimony of Jesus Healing Chronic Bleeding in 2017**

**You may ask yourself or others, "What is really known?" God desires you to know where the enemy is "set;" that is the position satan lusted after in an attempt to rule. Here is an example of moving forward in fighting the good fight of faith. Heeding to Holy Spirit's prompts, I felt led to send additional time in prayer.**

**In my pursuit to hear the word of the Lord, He whispered just one word, "Rumpelstiltskin." Being quite puzzled, I read an online version of the fairy tale and several commentaries. Bringing closure to this mystery, I believe the Spirit of God was saying in just one moment in time, "you can always defeat the enemy if you just know the right word."**

**Approximately nine months later, Holy Spirit gave me the Hebrew word, *tâmam* as the word of the Lord for the prevailing issue. The Strong's Concordance defines the word "clean" from Joshua 3:17 as "complete; accomplish; cease; be clean." The short definition for this expression is simply "finished." Breaking that down farther: something has exited, like a chronic condition and something else entered to take dominion, like the divine cure.**

**The following account is the breachproof breakthrough my Mom received when the word *tâmam* was voice activated. She received complete freedom from chronic bleeding that first appeared to be**

**never-ending. But Jesus healed Mom and she never bled from the bladder area again.**

**When Mom began to bleed, one hospitable system irrigated her while the other gave her blood transfusions. I mentioned to my youngest sister that the doctors kept trying to show me an image of Mom's bladder and that I did not have any desire to see it in a dysfunctional state. Out of courtesy, I would always act as if I was looking at the image, but I never captured it in my mind. She told me to look on the internet for a picture of a healthy bladder so I would know what one looked like.**

**After that, I was impressed to look up healing bladder cancer on the internet. I came across a YouTube video that showed bladder cancer healing within three minutes. Although an ultrasound showed a scalable difference, not having any working knowledge of medicine or medical equipment, I was unable to understand what was really occurred. They were also chanting one phrase in a foreign language, which sounded much like a Chinese dialect.**

**Afterward, I entreated God to give me the right word that would heal my Mom. It was *tâmam*. As my Mom sat at the dining room table quietly praying, I sang one of my originals *Shalom*. I would also interject the decree *tâmam* instead of the song lyrics. We remained in that posture for approximately an hour offering worship and praise to the Lord.**

**That glorious time culminated with a vision of Jesus coming toward me carrying a new red bladder in both hands. Initially, it appeared as an entourage of angels followed Him since I saw a collection of moving white wings that formed an upside down triangle around His feet.**

**I now believe those wings represent Malachi 4:1-3 which indicates that even the fringe of Jesus' tallit had healing in it. Not just this Old Testament reverence for divine healing, but also Luke 8:43-48 and Matthew 9:20-22 in the New Testament. This is when the woman with an issue of blood for twelve years was immediately healed. The flow of blood from a wound stopped when she drew the *dunamis* power out of Jesus. In the end, she was supernaturally cured because of her faith in Jesus, the Healer.**

**Although we never checked until a couple hours later, I believe Mom was healed instantly. The blood stopped flowing. From that day**

**forward until Mom went to heaven, she never bled again. Thank you Jesus! Because of my role in her care, my testimony is absolutely unquestionable. I solemnly confirm that from the afternoon of August 24, 2017 to the morning of December 5, 2017 my Mom never bled anymore from the bladder area.**
