

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 122 Scriptures

The Word of God has degrees of cleansing you can experience. Each validates the quality of intimacy with Jesus Christ. The *logos* Word brings you into a mutual covenant friendship because it bathes you. "Now you are clean through My *logos* Word which I have spoken unto you," John 15:3. On the other hand, the *rhema* Word ushers you into an enhanced communion with Jesus as the Church, the Bride of Christ because it baptizes you. "That He might sanctify and cleanse the Church with the washing of water by the *rhema* Word," Ephesians 5:26.

The Spirit of God also has degrees of His presence and His power you can experience. Holy Spirit, the Comforter is our Teacher in all areas of life. He graciously and gently reminds you of what Jesus has said, ushers you into all truth, and shows you things to come. He is the source and supply of the new birth experience. When you are baptized with Holy Spirit, you receive His surplus that saturates you. Allow Holy Spirit to impress you so He can express the Lord through you in your sphere(s) of influence. Then you will not just be a courier with the Godhead onboard, but a carrier of His anointing.

Here is Jesus Christ's model for you to master. He always hosted the Word of God so the Spirit of God always rested upon Him and never lifted off Him. Jesus never vexed, grieved, or quenched Holy Spirit. Jesus perfectly illustrated the way to live heaven on earth. Now you have inherited the ministry of Jesus as a king-priest [non-gender specific]. He left us this proclamation, "Occupy until I come." Now Jesus awaits our committed cooperation corporately to reign and represent in His stead in this life, at this time. You have been recreated by God to be His masterpiece. When the Lord places you on display for His glory light to shine, then the world is drawn to the Jesus in you because they see the King of kings in all of His glory and the kingdom of God in their midst. And it is so real to them!

The gospel's beginning on earth

⁶⁻⁸A man called John was sent by God as a witness to the light, so that any man who heard his testimony might believe in the light. This man was not himself the light: he was sent simply as a personal witness to that light.

⁹⁻¹³That was the true light which shines upon every man as he comes into the world. He came into the world—the world he had created—and the world failed to recognise him. He came into his own creation, and his own people would not accept him. Yet wherever men did accept him he gave them the power to become sons of God. These were the men who truly believed in him, and their birth depended not on the course of nature nor on any impulse or plan of man, but on God.

¹⁴⁻¹⁸So the word of God became a human being and lived among us. We saw his splendour (the splendour as of a father's only son), full of grace and truth. And it was about him that John stood up and testified, exclaiming: "Here is the one I was speaking about when I said that although he would come after me he would always be in front of me; for he existed before I was born!" Indeed, every one of us has shared in his riches—there is a grace in our lives because of his grace. For while the Law was given by Moses, love and truth came through Jesus Christ. It is true that no one has ever seen God at any time. Yet the divine and only Son, who lives in the closest intimacy with the Father, has made him known.

³⁴Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

The year King Uzziah died I saw the Lord! He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the Temple was filled with his glory. ²Hovering about him were mighty, six-winged angels of fire. With two of their wings they covered their faces, with two others they covered their feet, and with two they flew. ³In a great antiphonal chorus they sang, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is filled with his glory." ⁴Such singing it was! It shook the

Temple to its foundations, and suddenly the entire sanctuary was filled with smoke.

⁵Then I said, "My doom is sealed, for I am a foul-mouthed sinner, a member of a sinful, foul-mouthed race; and I have looked upon the King, the Lord of heaven's armies."

⁶Then one of the mighty angels flew over to the altar and with a pair of tongs picked out a burning coal. ⁷He touched my lips with it and said, "Now you are pronounced 'not guilty' because this coal has touched your lips. Your sins are all forgiven."

⁸Then I heard the Lord asking, "Whom shall I send as a messenger to my people? Who will go?"

And I said, "Lord, I'll go! Send *me*."

⁹And he said, "Yes, go. But tell my people this: 'Though you hear my words repeatedly, you won't understand them. Though you watch and watch as I perform my miracles, still you won't know what they mean.' ¹⁰Dull their understanding, close their ears, and shut their eyes. I don't want them to see or to hear or to understand, or to turn to me to heal them."^[a]

¹¹Then I said, "Lord, how long will it be before they are ready to listen?"

And he replied, "Not until their cities are destroyed—without a person left—and the whole country is an utter wasteland, ¹²and they are all taken away as slaves to other countries far away, and all the land of Israel lies deserted! ¹³Yet a tenth—a remnant—will survive; and though Israel is invaded again and again and destroyed, yet Israel will be like a tree cut down, whose stump still lives to grow again."

⁷And seek the peace of the city whither I have caused you to be carried away captives, and pray unto the LORD for it: for in the peace thereof shall ye have peace.
