JESUS CHRIST THE PERFECT REPRESENTATION OF THE GLORY OF GOD

In John 17:1, 4-5 (KJV), Jesus appealed to Abba Father to reoccupy the glory He had in heaven as His only begotten Son. Born on earth as the Son of man, Jesus gave up His glory to be the Savior of the world; holding that advantage, Abba repopulated His family with all the sons and daughters He always desired. “These words spake Jesus, and lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify Thee: I have glorified Thee on the earth: I have finished the work which Thou gavest Me to do. And now, O Father, glorify Thou Me with Thine own self with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was.” Hebrews 1:1-4 (AMPC) views Jesus in receipt of God’s glory, the fullness of being resident. “In many separate revelations [each of which set forth a portion of the Truth] and in different ways God spoke of old to [our] forefathers in *and* by the prophets, [But] in the last of these days He has spoken to us in [the person of a] Son, Whom He appointed Heir *and* lawful Owner of all things, also by *and* through Whom He created the worlds *and* the reaches of space *and* the ages of time [He made, produced, built, operated, and arranged them in order]. He is the sole expression of the glory of God [the Light-being, the out-raying or radiance of the divine], and He is the perfect imprint *and* very image of [God’s] nature, upholding *and* maintaining *and* guiding *and* propelling the universe by His mighty word of power. When He had *by offering Himself* accomplished *our* cleansing of sins *and* riddance of guilt, He sat down at the right hand of the divine Majesty on high, [Taking a place and rank by which] He Himself became as much superior to angels as the glorious Name (title) which He has inherited is different from *and* more excellent than theirs.” Phil. 2:5-11 (KJV) is our pattern to do the works of God, even greater works through Jesus’ finished works. “Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”

GOD’S CROWN OF GLORY MODELED FOR US, TO BE MIRRORED BY US

Isaiah 28:5; 62:3 (KJV) confirm God’s crown of glory made us His crown of glory: “In that day shall the Lord of hosts be for a crown of glory, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of His people;” “Thou shalt also be a crown of glory in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God. John 17:20-23 (KJV) shows Jesus gave us God’s glory: “Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on Me through their word; That they all may be one; as Thou, Father, art in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be one in Us: that the world may believe that Thou hast sent Me. And the glory which Thou gavest Me I have given them; that they may be one, even as We are one: I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that Thou hast sent Me, and hast loved them, as Thou hast loved Me.” 2 Cor. 3:17-18 (AMPC) is God’s plan to enlarge us to receive even more deposits of His glory: “Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom). And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His *very own* image in ever increasing splendor *and* from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit.”

PERFECTED SUPPLICATION FOR THE PERFECTED SUCCESSION OF GLORY

In Ps. 21:5 (KJV), David entreated the Lord not just for himself, Solomon, and Jesus but for every earthly king-priest, including you. “His glory is great in Thy salvation: honour and majesty hast Thou laid upon him.” Now it is your turn and your time to do likewise. “Bless the Lord, O my soul. O Lord My God, Thou art very great; Thou art clothed with honour and majesty,” Ps. 104:1 (KJV). “Blessed are they that keep judgment, and he that doeth righteousness at all times. Remember me, O Lord, with the favour that Thou bearest unto Thy people: O visit me with Thy salvation; That I may see the good of Thy chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of Thy nation, that I may glory with Thine inheritance,” Ps. 106:3-5 (KJV). Affirm the glory aloud!

Thought for Transformation

Give glory to God daily until the planet resounds, “And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of His glory,” Is. 6:3.

Always Give the Glory to God

You are God’s purpose for His glory. “Even everyone who is called by My name, whom I have created for My glory, whom I have formed, whom I have made.”

“The people I formed for Myself, that they may set forth My praise [and they shall do it],” Isaiah 43:7, 21 (AMPC). God vowed to never give His glory to anyone else, but you. “I am the Lord; that is My name! And My glory I will not give to another, nor My praise to graven images,” Is. 42:8 (AMPC). As God’s covenant partner, He desires your vow to seal that you will never give your glory to another, excluding Him. “You shall not

make [gods to share] with Me [My glory and your worship]; gods of silver or gods of gold you shall not make for yourselves,” Ex. 20:23 (AMPC). The fruit of glory or shame ultimately authenticates its root; it bears the resemblance of the one worshipped.

“They made a calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image. Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of an ox that eateth grass.

They forgot God their Saviour, which had done great things in Egypt;” Ps. 106:19-21 (KJV).

Awaken to God and to His glory light. “As for me, I will behold Thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with Thy likeness,” Ps. 17:15 (KJV).
