### **The Word of God authenticates our Covenant**

Isaiah 34:16-17 The Passion Translation (TPT)

<sup>16</sup>Seek for Yahweh's book and read it carefully.

You will learn that none of these *prophecies* will fail;  
none will lack a *fulfillment as its* companion.

For the Lord has issued his decree.

It is his Spirit that has gathered them.

<sup>17</sup>He is the one who apportioned it to them by lot,  
whose hand measured the share of each.<sup>[a]</sup>

They will possess it for all time  
and dwell there throughout the ages.

### Isaiah 55 King James Version (KJV)

Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

<sup>2</sup>Wherefore do ye spend money for that which is not bread? and your labour for that which satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.

<sup>3</sup>Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

<sup>4</sup>Behold, I have given him for a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people.

<sup>5</sup>Behold, thou shalt call a nation that thou knowest not, and nations that knew not thee shall run unto thee because of the LORD thy God, and for the Holy One of Israel; for he hath glorified thee.

<sup>6</sup>Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

<sup>7</sup>Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

<sup>8</sup>For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

<sup>9</sup>For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

<sup>10</sup>For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

<sup>11</sup>So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

<sup>12</sup>For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

<sup>13</sup>Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree: and it shall be to the LORD for a name, for an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off.

#### Hebrews 6:14-20 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>14</sup>Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

<sup>15</sup>And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

<sup>16</sup>For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.

<sup>17</sup>Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

Isaiah 9:6-9 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>6</sup>For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

<sup>7</sup>Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

<sup>8</sup>The Lord sent a word into Jacob, and it hath lighted upon Israel.

<sup>9</sup>And all the people shall know, even Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria, that say in the pride and stoutness of heart,

Isaiah 7:13-14 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>13</sup>And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also?

<sup>14</sup>Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Isaiah 52:13-15 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>13</sup>Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high.

<sup>14</sup>As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:

<sup>15</sup>So shall he sprinkle many nations; the kings shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider.

Isaiah 53 King James Version (KJV)

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

<sup>2</sup>For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

<sup>3</sup>He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

<sup>4</sup>Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

<sup>5</sup>But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

<sup>6</sup>All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

<sup>7</sup>He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

<sup>8</sup>He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

<sup>9</sup>And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

<sup>10</sup>Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

<sup>11</sup>He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

<sup>12</sup>Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

### **The Word of God authenticates our Crowning**

Isaiah 61 King James Version (KJV)

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

<sup>2</sup>To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

<sup>3</sup>To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

<sup>4</sup>And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.

<sup>5</sup>And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.

<sup>6</sup>But ye shall be named the Priests of the LORD: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.

<sup>7</sup>For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.

<sup>8</sup>For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

<sup>9</sup>And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the LORD hath blessed.

<sup>10</sup>I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.

<sup>11</sup>For as the earth bringeth forth her bud, and as the garden causeth the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.

## **The Word of God authenticates our Conquest**

Luke 4:1-15 King James Version (KJV)

And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

<sup>2</sup>Being forty days tempted of the devil. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered.

<sup>3</sup>And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.

<sup>4</sup>And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.

<sup>5</sup>And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

<sup>6</sup>And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

<sup>7</sup>If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.

<sup>8</sup>And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

<sup>9</sup>And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence:

<sup>10</sup>For it is written, He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee:

<sup>11</sup>And in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.

<sup>12</sup>And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

<sup>13</sup>And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

<sup>14</sup>And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

<sup>15</sup>And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.

#### Mark 4:14-20 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>14</sup>The sower soweth the word.

<sup>15</sup>And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

<sup>16</sup>And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

<sup>17</sup>And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

<sup>18</sup>And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word,

<sup>19</sup>And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

<sup>20</sup>And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.

### **The Word of God authenticates our Collaboration**

John 1:1-14 King James Version (KJV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

<sup>2</sup>The same was in the beginning with God.

<sup>3</sup>All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

<sup>4</sup>In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

<sup>5</sup>And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

<sup>6</sup>There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

<sup>7</sup>The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.

<sup>8</sup>He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.

<sup>9</sup>That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

<sup>10</sup>He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

<sup>11</sup>He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

<sup>12</sup>But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

<sup>13</sup>Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

<sup>14</sup>And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

1 John 4:1-9 King James Version (KJV)

Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

<sup>2</sup>Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

<sup>3</sup>And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

<sup>4</sup>Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

<sup>5</sup>They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them.

<sup>6</sup>We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

<sup>7</sup>Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.

<sup>8</sup>He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.

<sup>9</sup>In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

1 John 3:2 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>2</sup>Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

**1 John 4:15-18** King James Version (KJV)

<sup>15</sup>Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.

<sup>16</sup>And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.

<sup>17</sup>Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

<sup>18</sup>There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

**1 John 2:15-16** King James Version (KJV)

<sup>15</sup>Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

<sup>16</sup>For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

**James 4:4** King James Version (KJV)

<sup>4</sup>Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

**Romans 8:1-8** King James Version (KJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

<sup>2</sup>For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

<sup>3</sup>For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

<sup>4</sup>That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

<sup>5</sup>For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

<sup>6</sup>For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

<sup>7</sup>Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

<sup>8</sup>So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

### **The Word of God authenticates Creation**

Genesis 1:1-3 King James Version (KJV)

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

<sup>2</sup>And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

<sup>3</sup>And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Genesis 1:26-28 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

<sup>26</sup>God said, Let Us [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth.

<sup>27</sup>So God created man in His own image, in the image *and* likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them.

<sup>28</sup>And God blessed them and said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [using all its vast resources in the service of God and man]; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living creature that moves upon the earth.

Luke 1:35-38 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

<sup>35</sup>Then the angel said to her, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a shining cloud]; and so the holy (pure, sinless) Thing (Offspring) which shall be born *of you* will be called the Son of God.

<sup>36</sup>And listen! Your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is now the sixth month with her who was called barren.

<sup>37</sup>For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* no word from God shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment.

<sup>38</sup>Then Mary said, Behold, I am the handmaiden of the Lord; let it be done to me according to what you have said. And the angel left her.

Luke 2:41-52 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>41</sup>Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

<sup>42</sup>And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast.

<sup>43</sup>And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not of it.

<sup>44</sup>But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintance.

<sup>45</sup>And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.

<sup>46</sup>And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

<sup>47</sup>And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.

<sup>48</sup>And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

<sup>49</sup>And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?

<sup>50</sup>And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

<sup>51</sup>And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

<sup>52</sup>And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.

**John 1:30-34** King James Version (KJV)

<sup>30</sup>This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me.

<sup>31</sup>And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water.

<sup>32</sup>And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

<sup>33</sup>And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

<sup>34</sup>And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.

**John 3:30-34** King James Version (KJV)

<sup>30</sup>He must increase, but I must decrease.

<sup>31</sup>He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all.

<sup>32</sup>And what he hath seen and heard, that he testifieth; and no man receiveth his testimony.

<sup>33</sup>He that hath received his testimony hath set to his seal that God is true.

<sup>34</sup>For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.

John 6:63 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

<sup>63</sup>It is the Spirit Who gives life [He is the Life-giver]; the flesh conveys no benefit whatever [there is no profit in it]. The words (truths) that I have been speaking to you are spirit and life.
