

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 141 Scriptures

There is undeniable evidence the violence of God's faith has power over fire. His zeal consumed it. Therefore, you never have to accept the enemy's death threat to bow to him. The three Hebrew Children only issued an option to the king after he challenged Almighty God to a duel. Moreover, their profession of faith before God invited Him alone to deliver them from the king's plan to extinguish them. All praise belongs to the Lord and He did! The command of your invocation always ushers Jesus to rescue you too. Your unwavering confession is praise where God reigns. Refuse to be an obstruction against your breakthrough.

To stop a wildfire from spreading, you must start another one. Jesus Christ, the King of kings, and the Lord of lords is higher than any raging fire. He is a rapid-fire first responder. Jesus' burnished feet testify that He is in the fire with you. The presence and power of God douses the flames in an instant suddenly. Brand Jesus—as Deliverer—the one who redeemed your life from destruction. He already extracted the chains of violence, enforced the troop to surrender, emancipated the oppressed from captivity, and eradicated the weapons of mass destruction. You are free indeed!

The baptism of fire removes all the unproductive things inside and out. That creates a momentum for your reinvention. The only way you can go through fire and never burn is if you are on fire too. In the end, you will not have any resemblance of what you went through: an unburned body, unsinged hair; unchanged coat; and unnoticed scent. God's vowed promise to you is "When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee," Isaiah 43:2 (KJV). Supernaturally you are fireproof!

Clear Evidence Jesus Christ is in the fire with you

Revelation 1:1-18 King James Version (KJV)

⁸I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

⁹I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

¹⁰I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

¹¹Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

¹²And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

¹³And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

¹⁴His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

¹⁵And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

¹⁶And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

¹⁷And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

¹⁸I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Clear Evidence of your freedom even when you are under fire

Zechariah 3 The Voice (VOICE)

Then the heavenly messenger showed me *a fourth vision*: Joshua, the high priest, was standing in front of the Eternal's Special Messenger *who was presiding over a heavenly council meeting*. Standing to Joshua's right was the one called the accuser.^[a] He was ready to argue that Joshua *was unworthy to serve as high priest*.

In this vision Zechariah sees a heavenly court. Joshua the high priest is on trial, charged with impurity and accused of being unfit to serve as high priest. The accuser appears in the role of a prosecuting attorney, bringing charges and attempting to undermine the credibility of the one person God wants to lead His people. But the Judge will have none of it.

Eternal One (to the accuser): ²I am reprimanding you, accuser. I, the Eternal One, have chosen Jerusalem *as My own, saved her from My fiery wrath* as if she were a wooden poker just pulled from *destruction in a fire*.

³Joshua stood *motionless* before the Eternal's messenger, still dressed in filth-covered clothes, *as if recently returned from captivity*.

Special Messenger of the Eternal (to the other heavenly council members): ⁴Remove the filth-covered clothes from this man.

(to Joshua) *Just as I have taken away your dirty clothes, I have taken away your guilt from you. In place of those clothes, I will dress you in pure, expensive garments. Then you will be ready to serve God and lead the festival.*

Zechariah (to the Eternal's Special Messenger): ⁵Your fellow council members should put a pure turban *befitting of the high priest* on his head. *It will indicate his dignity.*

So they placed a pure turban on his head and *finished* dressing him in *his new clothes* while the Eternal's Special Messenger stood by, *supervising the cleansing. Joshua could now safely approach God.*

⁶The Eternal's Special Messenger *then stood before* Joshua and cautioned him.

Special Messenger of the Eternal: ⁷*Listen to* what the Eternal, Commander of *heavenly* armies, has to say: "If you *bind yourself to Me*, walk according to My teachings, and perform your priestly duties *without fail*; then you will be in charge of My house *in Jerusalem*, you will organize *the activities in* the courtyards *surrounding the most holy place*, and I will give you a place among all My heavenly council members gathered here. ⁸*Listen to Me*, Joshua the high priest—you and your colleagues *who maintain the temple* alongside you. These men are a *sign of wonders to come*. Watch, because I am going to bring My servant, who is the *Branch of David*, *to lead you.*" ⁹The Eternal, Commander of *heavenly* armies, has this to say: "You will see the stone I set before Joshua: on it are seven eyes, on it I will engrave a *special* word, and in a single day I will purge guilt from the land. ¹⁰And on that day I, the Eternal, Commander of *heavenly* armies, promise everyone will invite one another to sit under *the shade of his own vine and fig tree and be at peace.*"

Clear Evidence God's Glory brings you through the Baptism of Fire

Daniel 3 King James Version (KJV)

Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height was threescore cubits, and the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

²Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

³Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the

king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

⁴Then an herald cried aloud, To you it is commanded, O people, nations, and languages,

⁵That at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:

⁶And whoso falleth not down and worshipping shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.

⁷Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of musick, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down and worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

⁸Wherefore at that time certain Chaldeans came near, and accused the Jews.

⁹They spake and said to the king Nebuchadnezzar, O king, live for ever.

¹⁰Thou, O king, hast made a decree, that every man that shall hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, shall fall down and worship the golden image:

¹¹And whoso falleth not down and worshipping, that he should be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.

¹²There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

¹³Then Nebuchadnezzar in his rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king.

¹⁴Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up?

¹⁵Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down

and worship the image which I have made; well: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who is that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?

¹⁶Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter.

¹⁷If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king.

¹⁸But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

¹⁹Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: therefore he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

²⁰And he commanded the most mighty men that were in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast them into the burning fiery furnace.

²¹Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their other garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

²²Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flames of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

²³And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

²⁴Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

²⁵He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

²⁶Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, and spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come hither. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

²⁷And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.

²⁸Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

²⁹Therefore I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak any thing amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made a dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort.

³⁰Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon.

Clear Evidence Jesus Christ made you fireproof!

Luke 4:18-21 The Voice (VOICE)

¹⁸The Spirit of the Lord the Eternal One is on Me.

Why? Because the Eternal designated Me

to be His representative to the poor, to preach good news to them.

He sent Me to tell those who are held captive that they can now be set free, and to tell the blind that they can now see.

He sent Me to liberate those held down by oppression.

¹⁹*In short, the Spirit is upon Me* to proclaim that now is the time; this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One's grace.^[a]

²⁰Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant. Then He sat down, *as a teacher would do*, and all in the synagogue focused their attention on Jesus, *waiting for Him to speak*.²¹ He told them that these words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in their hearing.

³⁶If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

1.loose the bands of wickedness - extract the chains

²¹Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their other garments....

Daniel 3:21-22: Although the Hebrew children were thrown into the burning fiery furnace, Jesus was present "to undo the heavy burdens." The fire that was seven times hotter instantly consumed the king's best military troops. In the name of Jesus Christ, you too can enforce the troop to surrender.

2.undo the heavy burdens - enforce the troop to surrender

²¹...Then these men and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

²²Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flames of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. ²³And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

Daniel 3:24-27: Although the three Hebrew children should have died even before they were thrown into the burning fiery furnace, Jesus was present "to let the oppressed go free." God caused the king to get a glimpse of His freeing hand in operation.

Nebuchadnezzar saw his own authority not only subdued, but also conquered. The fiery furnace heated seven times hotter had no power over the three Hebrew children: unburned bodies; unsinged hair; unchanged coats; and unnoticed scent. There was not any evidence at all that signaled their terrible experience. In the name of Jesus Christ, you too can emancipate the oppressed from captivity.

3.let the oppressed go free - emancipate the oppressed from captivity

²⁴ Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

²⁵ He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God. ²⁶ Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, and spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come hither. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

²⁷ And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.

Daniel 3:28-30: Jesus was present "to break every yoke." Afterward, Nebuchadnezzar became an eyewitness of the Almighty God freeing His servants. The king was so convinced of what he saw firsthand that he immediately changed the laws in his kingdom to accommodate the true worship of God.

The king did not stop there, but he also made an edict that protected anyone under his sphere of influence from defaming the Almighty God in anyway. In the end, the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. In the name of Jesus Christ, you too can eradicate the weapons of mass destruction and bring that territory into the kingdom of God.

4.break every yoke - eradicate the weapons of mass destruction

²⁸ Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God. ²⁹ Therefore I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak any thing amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made a dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort. ³⁰ Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon.
