

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 142 Scriptures

To stand against your enemy, you must be set against him at all times. Refuse to give your Jesus-conferred authority and power away to satan. You invite the Lord of the Breakthrough into the battle to command victory for you when you are adorned with the whole armor of God. Then lodged in the secret place, i.e., His safe house, you watch the Lord go to war on those who withhold treasure from His purpose.

Always work from this premise: God already ended all strife. Then you know without a shadow of doubt that it is impossible to return home empty-handed. Get ready to receive all the spoils of war! God's vowed promise guarantees that you are more than a conqueror through Christ who loves you. He always causes you to triumph because He has already given you the victory. He will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. "From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has forcefully advanced, and the strong take it by force," Matthew 11:12 (MEV).

This means war! Armor up! Be strong in the Lord. You can never win in your strength alone. Be strong in the power of His might, i.e., the dominion of God's forcefulness. Always have on: 1) God's helmet of salvation resonating His victory, aid, welfare, help, deliverance, and prosperity; 2) His breastplate of righteousness so Jesus' blood speaks mercy on your behalf so no condemnation or accusation can separate you from God; 3) His truth surrounding you amid deception, error, and lies; 4) His peace so you advance and never retreat, concede, forfeit, or be exhausted; 5) His shield of faith contending and extinguishing the mass weapons of destruction; and 6) His sword of the Spirit, the *rhema* Word of God as the detonator so you hold the matching sword of the Lord on earth. Activate your angels to minister on your behalf; they respond to voice of the Lord abiding in you. How can you ever lose ground?

Jesus made you a more than a conqueror so you can live through Him instead of the world system.

John 1:32-34 Living Bible (TLB)

³²Then John told about seeing the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove descending from heaven and resting upon Jesus.

³³“I didn’t know he was the one,” John said again, “but at the time God sent me to baptize he told me, ‘When you see the Holy Spirit descending and resting upon someone—he is the one you are looking for. He is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.’ ³⁴I saw it happen to this man, and I therefore testify that he is the Son of God.”

³⁰I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek *or* consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will *and* pleasure of the Father Who sent Me.

³⁰I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [he has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.]

³¹But [^[a]satan is coming and] I do as the Father has commanded Me, so that the world may know (be convinced) that I love the Father and that I do only what the Father has instructed Me to do. [I act in full agreement with His orders.] Rise, let us go away from here.

²And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, ...”

¹⁰And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory]. Resting in the Lord allows them to have habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him because He became a resting place for Holy Spirit. Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."

In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance. Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is no space for Him to lose any opportunity to fully express Himself. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good. Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."

In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues. Walking softly before the Lord helps to discern the move of Holy Spirit to ensure what He has designed cannot be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."

Jesus won every battle every time so you cannot lose when He fights for you.

⁷But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the ^[a]Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthenener, Standby) will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you [to be in close fellowship with you]. ⁸And He, when He comes, will convict the world about [the guilt of] sin [and the need for a Savior], and about righteousness, and about judgment: ⁹about sin [and the true nature of it], because they do not believe in Me [and My message]; ¹⁰about righteousness [personal integrity and godly character], because I am going to My Father and you will no longer see Me; ¹¹about judgment [the certainty of it], because the ruler of this world (satan) has been judged *and* condemned. ¹²“I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear [to hear] them now. ¹³But when He, the Spirit of Truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth [full and complete truth]. For He will not speak on His own initiative, but He will speak whatever He hears [from the Father—the message regarding the Son], and He will disclose to you what is to come [in the future].
