

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 152 Scriptures

Since God has already given you His best gift—Jesus Christ—why would He ever withhold anything else from you? His good, acceptable, and perfect will is joined to the riches of His grace and to the riches of His glory. This week, you will better understand how the Lord honored you to host the irresistibility of Christ, the inheritance of Christ, and the illumination of Christ. Last week, the identity, the image, and the intimacy of Christ were highlighted.

No one was recreated to be a spectator, but a co-creator. God recreated you for His glory. The Creator of the universe formed you for Himself to show forth His praise. Always look through the light, the liberty, and the love of the Spirit of the God and the Word of God for your point of view. Then you will see Jesus as He really is and be as He is in this world. Those who know their God will be strong and do exploits. Be strong in the Lord and in the forcefulness of His dominion. Bind together with Jesus; for Communion with His Body and Communion with His Blood gives you His part.

Since you are created to have dominion over all the works of God's hands, you are irresistible. Nothing can successfully oppose your command when you exercise it in the omnipotent name of Jesus Christ. As a child of the Most High, Christ freed you from all bondage. Now, you are no longer a slave, but are an heir of God and a joint heir with Jesus. That means you are God's elect; in Greek, that means His "favorite." You are not only God's inheritance, but you also have His inheritance that you can access not only in heaven but also on earth. Jesus is the Source of light when He is in the world. He passed on His legacy to the Body of Christ. It is our turn to bring the illumination of heaven to earth so the glory of God is in full manifestation. We are the source of light that highlights Jesus, the King of Glory, now, perpetually, and forever.

Hosting the Irresistibility of Christ

IRRESISTIBIL'ITY

IRRESIST'IBLE, *adjective* That cannot be successfully resisted or opposed; superior to opposition.

An irresistible law of our nature impels us to seek happiness.

Hosting the Inheritance of Christ

INHER'ITANCE, *noun* An estate derived from an ancestor to an heir by succession or in course of law; or an estate which the law casts on a child or other person, as the representative of the deceased ancestor.

1. The reception of an estate by hereditary right, or the descent by which an estate or title is cast on the heir; as, the heir received the estate by *inheritance*
2. The estate or possession which may descend to an heir, though it has not descended.

And Rachel and Leah answered and said, is there yet any portion or *inheritance* for us in our father's house? [Genesis 31:14](#).

3. An estate given or possessed by donation or divine appropriation. [Numbers 26:53](#).
4. That which is possessed or enjoyed.

Ask of me, and I will give thee the heathen for thine *inheritance* [Psalms 2:8](#).

²To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord [the year of His favor] ^[a]and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn,

³To grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion—to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, *and* failing spirit—that they may be called oaks of righteousness [lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.

⁴And they shall rebuild the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former desolations and renew the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.

⁵Aliens shall stand [ready] and feed your flocks, and foreigners shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.

⁶But you shall be called the priests of the Lord; people will speak of you as the ministers of our God. You shall eat the wealth of the nations, and the glory [once that of your captors] shall be yours.

⁷Instead of your [former] shame you shall have a twofold recompense; instead of dishonor *and* reproach [your people] shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double [what they had forfeited]; everlasting joy shall be theirs.

⁸For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery *and* wrong with violence *or* a burnt offering. And I will faithfully give them their recompense in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant *or* league with them.

⁹And their offspring shall be known among the nations and their descendants among the peoples. All who see them [in their prosperity] will recognize *and* acknowledge that they are the people whom the Lord has blessed.

¹⁰I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul will exult in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

¹¹For as [surely as] the earth brings forth its shoots, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to spring forth, so [surely] the Lord God will cause rightness *and* justice and praise to spring forth before all the nations [through the self-fulfilling power of His word].

Hosting the Illumination of Christ

ILLUMINATION, *noun* The act of illuminating or rendering luminous; the act of supplying with light.

1. The act of rendering a house or a town light, by placing lights at the windows, or in elevated situations, as a manifestation of joy; or the state of being thus rendered light.

2. That which gives light.

The sun--is an *illumination* created.

3. Brightness; splendor.

4. Infusion of intellectual light; an enlightening of the understanding by knowledge, or the mind by spiritual light.

5. The act, art or practice of adorning manuscripts and books with pictures.

6. Inspiration; the special communication of knowledge to the mind by the Supreme Being.

Hymns and psalms--are framed by meditation beforehand, or by prophetic *illumination* are inspired.

²²The eye is the lamp of the body. *You draw light into your body through your eyes, and light shines out to the world through your eyes.* So if your eye is well *and shows you what is true*, then your whole body will be filled with light. ²³But if your eye is clouded *or evil*, then your body will be filled with *evil and* dark clouds. And the darkness that takes over the body *of a child of God who has gone astray*—that is the deepest, darkest darkness there is.

When Jesus speaks of eyes and light, He means all people should keep their eyes on God because the eyes are the windows to the soul. Eyes should not focus on trash—pornography, filth, or expensive things. And this is what He means when He says, “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”

Jesus: ²⁴No one can serve two masters. *If you try*, you will wind up loving the first master and hating the second, or vice versa. People try to serve both God and money—but you can’t. *You must choose one or the other.*

²²A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the LORD will hasten it in his time.

¹⁷[For I always pray to] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him,

¹⁸By having the eyes of your heart flooded with light, so that you can know *and* understand the hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints (His set-apart ones),

¹⁹And [so that you can know and understand] what is the immeasurable *and* unlimited *and* surpassing greatness of His power in *and* for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength,

²⁰Which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His [own] right hand in the heavenly [places],

²¹Far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named [above every title that can be conferred], not only in this age *and* in this world, but also in the age *and* the world which are to come.

²²And He has put all things under His feet and has appointed Him the universal and supreme Head of the church [a headship exercised throughout the church],

²³Which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him Who makes everything complete, and Who fills everything everywhere with Himself].
