GOD HAS PERFECT RHYTHM, STAY IN STEP WITH HIS TIME AND TIMING

Because God looks out of eternity into time as we know it, everything is already beautiful from His perspective and His prospective. “He hath made everything beautiful in His time: also He hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end,” Eccl. 3:11 (KJV). It is impossible for God to ever be negligent. Hebrew defines “working” in Ps. 74:12 (KJV) as “systematically and habitually.” “For God is my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth,” That’s even in the dark. The following verse is a word picture of what our life looks like living through Jesus. “A land which the Lord thy God careth for: the eyes of the Lord thy God are always upon it, from the beginning of the year even unto the end of the year. And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto My commandments which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul, That I will give you the rain of your land in His due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil. And I will send grass in thy fields for thy cattle, that thou mayest eat and be full,” Deut. 11:12-15 (KJV). Total alignment with God brings about God’s full recovery for us.

GOD’S WORD NEVER RETURNS TO HIM AS AN EMPTY PROMISE

Rejoice even in blight. “In that day,” says the Lord, “I will answer the pleading of the sky for clouds, to pour down water on the earth in answer to its cry for rain. Then the earth can answer the parched cry of the grain, the grapes, and the olive trees for moisture and for dew—and the whole grand chorus shall sing together that ‘God sows! He has given all!’” Hosea 2:21-22 (TLB). Blight has already been reversed. “For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands,” Is. 55:10-12 (KJV).

INDELIBLE WORD PICTURES FOR ACCUMULATION WITH ACCELERATION

God’s Accumulation Promise: “I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase and the trees of the field yield their fruit. And your threshing [time] shall reach to the vintage and the vintage [time] shall reach to the sowing time, and you shall eat your bread to the full and dwell in your land securely. I will give peace in the land; you shall lie down and none shall fill you with dread or make you afraid; and I will clear ferocious (wild) beasts out of the land, and no sword shall go through your land. And you shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword,” Leviticus 26:4-7 (AMPC). God’s Acceleration Promise: “In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old: That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, saith the LORD that doeth this. Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt,” Amos 9:11-13 (KJV). Your sudden—spontaneous and simultaneous—shift!

ABUNDANT HARVEST OR CROP FAILURE FOLLOW YOUR WORDS

God created you to be fruitful, multiply, replenish, subdue and have dominion. By faith, your command transforms your world to image heaven on earth. “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them,” Mk. 11:22-24 (KJV). To see God’s glory, keep God’s grace in your words “...This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts. Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it,” Zec. 4:6-7 (KJV).

Thought for Transformation

“...I am thy fellow-servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy,” Rev.19:10 (KJV). That is evidence by Jesus Christ, Holy Spirit hosts “the gift of communicating and enforcing revealed truth.” No matter how wrong or how long it has been, fulfillment is planned in your favor. Host a heart to receive indisputable promises so you always agree with what God says now and forever.

The Glory of God, never Gory

The glory realm has zero decay, delay, or dismay. Don’t adopt temporary over eternal. “The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose. It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the Lord, and the excellency of our God,” Is. 35:1-2 (KJV). Zero decay! “that it too would be set free from its bondage to decay and would enjoy the freedom accompanying the glory that God’s children will have,” Rom. 8:21 (CJB). Zero delay! “Hope delayed makes a heart sick, but a desire fulfilled is a tree of life,” Prov. 13:1(EHV). Zero dismay! “Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness,” Is. 41:10 (KJV).
