Let 2 Chronicles 24:13 (DRA) serve as your blueprint that you envision in your heart to receive maximum recovery. It images healing has come upon the house. "And the workmen were diligent, and the breach of the walls was closed up by their hands, and they set up the house of the Lord in its former state, and made it stand firm." God desires to introduce you to the best version of you, the masterpiece you have never known before this time. Now embrace Him as the Healer of your broken heart Who binds up every wound. As a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith, the Lord is your hiding place as well as your safe harbor, your place for repair.

Although soul wounds may be self-inflicted, sustained from your attempt to rescue someone else, a generational curse or caused by an onslaught from the enemy, you have a Great Physician who remains on-call. Jesus Christ, our Redeemer was dismembered and left unrecognizable in order to put your life back together again, whole and well. God's wrap-around love ensures you can live breachproof, even now. Reposition yourself to receive health, healing, and cure from the inside, out, so you will not become an obstruction against your breakthrough.

Someone can have a noticeable scar. However, no additional care is required, although it may be an eyesore. The cut has been resolved and the pain dissolved. However, soul wounds are quite different. Once torn, torment accompanies the trauma that can persist throughout someone's lifespan. It seems to be unnoticeable because it is covered up. But at times, its untimely expression is so noticeable that it refuses to be left without having access no matter where you are. In fact, it screams out to show off. Its sudden outburst triggers everyone's immediate attention. Please know God has already given you authority and power over every soul wound. You have the final say-so. What God has wonderfully and fearfully made, He has recreated in Christ Jesus! God prearranged for you to experience and enjoy supernatural emotional healing.

Dwell in the Habitation of the Lord all the days of your life

Your Soul Whole and Well from the Inside, Out

God's holy habitation is your secure safe house. It is absolutely free from diabolical cuts or tears. There is no other place on earth where you can even rest satisfied. Psalm 132:11-18 is the Lord's sworn statement that it is the desire of His heart for you as the offspring of David.

Psalm 132:11-18 King James Version (KJV)

- ¹¹The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.
- ¹²If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore.
- ¹³For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired it for his habitation.
- ¹⁴This is my rest for ever: here will I dwell; for I have desired it.
- ¹⁵I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with bread.
- ¹⁶I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.
- ¹⁷There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed.
- ¹⁸His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish.

Moses is cognizant of the holy habitation of God and knows no one can thrive without living in His presence and His power. In Exodus 15:2, Moses' heart was moved to prepare Israel in such a way that God would be pleased to dwell in their midst all the time, not just visit them. Then in Exodus 15:13, he realized the Lord graciously led them successfully into His habitation. This fulfilled the desire of God's heart as well as Moses and the children of Israel.

²The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Moses, the author of Psalm 90 and 91 carves out this electric memorial of dwelling in the secret place of the Almighty. It is a resting place that can never be penetrated by any wickedness that is demonstrated in Psalm 91:8-16.

Serve the Lord with joyfulness and gladness of heart for the abundance of all things

Having personal knowledge that God is your Defense, your Impenetrable Rock of Refuge, you cannot help but host a merry heart. Become familiar with the word "merry" as joyous, i.e., a glorious and triumphant state that never changes positions no matter what it may face, but it changes things in your favor. In Proverbs, there are at least three scriptures that influence obtaining and retaining a merry heart.

First in Proverbs 15:13, a merry heart resonates you are more than a conqueror from the inside out. That's "breachproof breakthrough." It can be seen on the countenance of your face and by your presence. Make smiling an integral part of your daily routine even if you are alone. Practice smiling until it is so contagious and it power transitions within every part of your being as well as into your world.

Proverbs 15:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

Secondly in Proverbs 15:15, a merry heart is resilient because it holds the capability of "back-to-back breakthrough" because it is relentless and resistless in battle. Although affliction may surround you, Holy Spirit ensures that it is not present within you because you image the Word of God in action.

¹⁵All the days of the afflicted are evil: but he that is of a merry heart hath a continual feast.

Thirdly in Proverbs 17:22, a merry heart recovers from any incurable disease or irritating dis-ease. It holds the prospective advantage of "bounce-back breakthrough." No matter the condition it faces and even if the case worsens, every knock against it is a boost that moves it forward.

For those reasons, Proverbs 21:1 encourages you to surrender your heart under the anointing and the power of the Lord's hand to revivify you from the inside, out. In the case of Holy Spirit, He cleanses your heart with the Word of God and removes all contaminants from its cavity.

No matter how long or how wrong trouble has tormented you, the Lord will resuscitate you

In pulling completely away from the Lord, loss stirred up catastrophe. In this scenario in Jeremiah 2:9-16, it reveals the undetected distress behind brokenness.

First, the people deserted the Lord. Although He desired to help them, they kept going in the wrong direction.

Secondly, in God's place, they chose idols as their devotion. It is what the Lord uncovered to them as changing their glory into shame.

Eventually, their pseudo gods received sustenance from them by feeding on their crown, i.e., consuming their dominion.

Their adultery resulted in them feeling sorry for themselves which left them literally stuck in the mud. They constructed broken wells that were already disempowered to spring up living waters. By employing that method, it was impossible to hold any contents at all, whether they were pure or toxic. Even if they had issued pure, clean water, the broken vessels still would have spewed out toxicity.

Jeremiah 2:9-16 King James Version (KJV)

⁹Wherefore I will yet plead with you, saith the LORD, and with your children's children will I plead.

¹⁰For pass over the isles of Chittim, and see; and send unto Kedar, and consider diligently, and see if there be such a thing.

¹¹Hath a nation changed their gods, which are yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for that which doth not profit.

¹²Be astonished, O ye heavens, at this, and be horribly afraid, be ye very desolate, saith the LORD.

¹³For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

¹⁴Is Israel a servant? is he a homeborn slave? why is he spoiled?

¹⁵The young lions roared upon him, and yelled, and they made his land waste: his cities are burned without inhabitant.

¹⁶Also the children of Noph and Tahapanes have broken the crown of thy head.

If that is a picture of your life, there is still hope of maximum recovery. God in all of His mercy and favor has disclosed what you may have not been able to see before this time. Just like Israel's distorted view of who God was to them, the Lord is giving you His truth in love so you have every opportunity to get a second wind.

Breathe Again is one of the beautiful worship songs Holy Spirit implanted in my heart at a time when my heart was desperately broken into what first seemed like irreconcilable pieces. He stirred within me that even if the heart feels like a corpse or even comatose, complete healing exists through His supernatural power and anointing.

Recognize and realize the Lord as your safe harbor, your place of repair

Comfort from the Scriptures provides everlasting hope from God to you. Isaiah 30:26 settles the matter of the Lord's intention to bind up the breach of His people as well as heal every one of their wounds.

Furthermore, He assures them that the presence and power of His glory light hedges, heals, and hushes every wound on the very same day. No doubt about it, He will do it for you too.

Isaiah 30:26 King James Version (KJV)

²⁶Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.

Isaiah 57:18-19 reiterates the truth that you can trust God's motives to heal you. These Scriptures instruct you how to voice activate supernatural healing power of God that is in you and for you flows through you. Jesus ensured His peace for you so you live complete in Him. Again, the word "peace" is *shalom*.

Begin by echoing the promise that He said to you. Each time you speak the promises of God aloud, you agree with Him. You are decreeing in His presence, what He first vowed to be the absolute truth under oath. It is impossible for any of His own words to return to the Lord without first producing the success He predetermined from the foundation of the world.

Isaiah 57:18-19 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners.

¹⁹I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the LORD; and I will heal him.

I recall my Mom saying, "Sometimes you have to work with yourself." Until now, I never really understood that was her challenge for personal accountability. In other words, when her want to did not want to, she made herself do it anyway. She understood she had the final choice. She had dominion.

Our Creator designed us to be influenced by our own voices above and beyond anyone else's. That status gives us the unfair advantage during every season of life. You can read the Scriptures verbatim and personalize them.

Voice activating the Word of God ushers in the Spirit of God. The Word of God commands the vowed promise while the Spirit of God gathers the vowed promise for manifestation.

Psalm 147:3 is another bible verse you can voice activate before God as well. Psalm 42:5 affirms your help comes from God's presence alone. This avows your praise of God as you declare the decree aloud. Then Psalm 42:11 repositions you by declaring the decree aloud to receive your restored health from God.

Never forget, you are influenced by what you say more than by anyone else. If you ever host a pity party all by yourself crash it with your confession. You cannot keep mourning if you expect to raise the dead. You can awaken the change you require through the Word of God and the Spirit of God. You receive hope from the comfort of the scriptures. Holy Spirit is the Comforter who turns your mourning into joy.

Every answer in this life rests in Jesus' finished work on Calvary. There is life in the blood.

Jeremiah 30:15-17 gives us scriptural hope for maximum recovery. It addresses God's retribution against the enemy as well as His restitution for us.

Jeremiah 30:15-17 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁵Why criest thou for thine affliction? thy sorrow is incurable for the multitude of thine iniquity: because thy sins were increased, I have done these things unto thee.

¹⁶Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.

¹⁷For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after.

Jesus was wounded for all your transgressions. Jesus was bruised for all your iniquities. The chastisement of your peace was upon Jesus. By Jesus' stripes you are healed. That is settled forever! What progressively moves you toward tangibly receiving every promise of God is your communion with Jesus that gives you His part.

1 John 1:9 removes any noticeable or unnoticeable breach in you and/or your bloodline that could hinder receiving restored health and healed wounds. It is simply because God is faithful and there is no breach in Him at all. He desires your breakthrough even more than you do.

First, acknowledge the strength of your everlasting covenant with God. It is empowered and enabled to cover your weaknesses all the time. Apply the blood of Jesus Christ so every transgression and iniquity is covered, past, present and future. You have all-inclusive coverage. It also includes any guilt and shame. Allow the blood of the Lamb to cleanse you from any lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and the pride of life that could cause you to potentially yield to temptation.

1 John 1:9 King James Version (KJV)

⁹If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Isaiah 1:5-7 was part of the vision the Prophet Isaiah saw about Judah and Jerusalem. Because the Lord desired to be their only way of escape, He first uncovered what they could not see for

themselves. It showed them their disparity that was polar opposite of God's perspective.

God's motive is always pure and perfect at all times. He never badgered them with hindsight, where they would be lodged in regret. The Lord gave them insight so they could move forward to obtain foresight for future good success.

Therefore, He tenderly unveiled their transgression and iniquity so they could receive maximum recovery from Him. They required their breaches to be healed, hedged, and hushed. Our God was the only One qualified to make them whole and well. That remains the truth for you too.

The Lord desired them as well as you to experience and to enjoy bounce-back breakthrough, breachproof breakthrough and back-to-back breakthrough. However, to complete in them His desire required their permission for God to grant it to them. That holds true for you too.

As their accountability partner, God unveiled the real image of their underlying condition. They did not have any soundness in them at all. Their breaches were not only unhealed, but were incurable. Their breaches were not only unhedged, but had gaping wounds. Their breaches were not only un-hushed, but had caused excruciating pain. Unfortunately, they experienced breach after breach after breach. Maybe your story is similar to theirs. If that is so, that was not the end of their story or yours.

Isaiah 1:5-7 Expanded Bible (EXB)

5 Why should you continue to be [or do you insist on being] punished [battered; struck down]?

Why do you continue to turn against him [rebel]?

Your whole head is hurt [bruised; wounded],
and your whole heart is sick [faint; weak].

6 There is no healthy spot [soundness]

from the bottom [sole] of your foot to the top of your head;

you are covered with wounds [bruises], hurts [sores; welts], and open sores [raw/infected wounds]

that are not cleaned [L pressed out] and covered [bandaged],

and no medicine takes away the pain [L not soothed/softened with oil].

7 Your land is ruined [desolate];

your cities have been burned with fire.

While you watch [Right in front of you],

·your enemies [L foreigners; strangers] ·are stealing everything from [destroy; devour] your ·land [fields; crops]; it is ruined like a country ·destroyed [overthrown] by ·enemies [L foreigners; strangers].

Isaiah 1:6 King James Version (KJV)

6 From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores [not healed]: they have not been closed, neither bound up [not hedged], neither mollified with ointment [not hushed].

Isaiah 32:18 highlights the promise of God to be whole and well from the inside, out. The Lord has already provided a healed habitation that carries His peace, *shalom*. He has provided a hedged dwelling that is sure. He also provided a hushed resting place that is quiet.

Your invitation to Christ permanently moves your residence from just being a site for visitation to be a perpetual habitation of God. As a habitation of God through Holy Spirit, Jesus dwells in your heart as Savior by faith. From that posture, continue to live yielded to Christ as Lord of all the rest of your life.

Isaiah 32:18 King James Version (KJV)

18 And my people shall dwell in a peaceable [healed] habitation, and in sure [hedged] dwellings, and in quiet [hushed] resting places;

Live with the expectation of just how far the Lord will go to ensure you are breachproof, i.e., safe and sound

You can voice activate the following three scripture references to heal, hedge, and hush any breach. Agree with God and receive His promises so the Spirit of God and the Word of God can reproduce His remedy in you. God's design closes every breach, until there is not one cut or tear left unresolved.

Healed Breaches: Psalm 60:2 acknowledges God as your Healer. You can even see the misalignment in your life. Your world may seem like it experienced an earthquake, even tipping the scales. Because nothing is impossible with God, you called out to Him for help because He always has maximum recovery on His mind for you.

Knowing God, Jesus, and Holy Spirit created the earth to perfectly revolve around the sun and never wiggle or wobble, you better understand what authentic balance really means. Since the nations are just a drop in the bucket to God, He can put you put together again as His reinvented masterpiece as well.

Similar to a dancer, equilibrium must be achieved simultaneously and spontaneously with her midpoint. That is realizing soundness from the inside, out. Everything transforms when you are whole and well. You too can discover the center of the life you may have never experienced and enjoyed. Even if you have somehow gotten lost along the way or wandered off the beaten path, God's Positioning System, GPS has never—not even once—lost sight of you.

Psalm 60:2 King James Version (KJV)

2 Thou hast made the earth to tremble; thou hast broken it: heal the breaches thereof; for it shaketh.

Hedged Breaches: Amos 9:11-15 acknowledges God as your Hedger. Most construction sites seal off access from potential problems. This preserves what is within the perimeter. What is on the inside stays in and what is outside stays out. The two areas are never confused.

Once the creation has been totally assembled, the owner may continue the protective covering for the aforementioned reasons. God is always your Defense even after construction and in His promises is full assurance that nothing and no one will ever cross your property line with any intentions to harm you.

Amos 9:11-15 King James Version (KJV)

11 In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up [hedge] the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, saith the LORD that doeth this.

13 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

14 And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

15 And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up

out of their land which I have given them, saith the LORD thy God.

Hushed Breaches: Proverbs 14:30 acknowledges God as your Husher. The heart in this verse is your inner being. Soundness is so vital because what you are on the inside will eventually be displayed on the outside. In Hebrews the term, "soundness" is defined as curative. Taken from another Hebrew word that means to cure, repair, or made whole.

For more clarity, another word it uses is placidity. That expression alone lets you know your breaches can be healed and hedged, but not hushed. It indicates you need something more to complete your maximum recovery. Here are a several examples that can make an impression on what you can expect from experiencing and enjoying hushed breaches. You are: gentle; quiet; undisturbed; serene; mild; unruffled; tranquil; without disturbance. You now have peace of mind and heart that can be seen by your sweetness of disposition. You are no longer stormy. That state requires supernaturally inner healing.

³⁰A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.

Sound H4832 Hebrew curative: medicine, cure, deliverance, remedy, wholesome, yielding

From H7495 to mend by stitching, to cure, repair, made whole; placidity

Placidity: gentle; quiet; undisturbed; serene; mild; unruffled; peace of mind; tranquil; not stormy; without disturbance or passion; sweetness of disposition; [to appease]

Supernatural emotional health
Good sense: transport with love

In the good sense, you are transported with love. Luke 15:3-7 gives you a word picture to imagine that magnitude of tranquility. While a shepherd is caring for his one hundred sheep, one wanders from the rest of the flock. He realizes that one sheep is lost.

He searches for it until he finds it. He places the little sheep around his shoulders and carries it all the way home rejoicing all the time. What he owned is both safe and sound. Jesus our Good Shepherd is

the personification of perfect love. He clearly understands that when He carries you as one of His sheep, you will always rest satisfied in God's wrap around love.

Luke 15:3-7 King James Version (KJV)

³And he spake this parable unto them, saying,

⁴What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?

⁵And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

⁶And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost.

⁷I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.

As you read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8, see Jesus wrapping you around His shoulders carrying you gently and graciously. Healed, hedged, and hushed breaches are a significant part what God desires you to experience and enjoy all of the time. That is why we must be open to remain whole and well.

⁴Love endures long *and* is patient and kind; love never is envious *nor* boils over with jealousy, is not boastful *or* vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily.

Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights *or* its own way, *for* it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy *or* fretful *or* resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong].

⁶It does not rejoice at injustice *and* unrighteousness, but rejoices when right *and* truth prevail.

7 Love bears up under anything *and* everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything [without weakening].⁸ Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end]. As for prophecy ([a]the gift of interpreting the divine will and purpose), it will be fulfilled *and* pass away; as for tongues, they will be destroyed *and* cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away [it will lose its value and be superseded by truth].
