

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 157 Scriptures

Jesus Christ has already given you His authority and power to rule as king as well as represent as priest in His stead. That honor and majesty perfectly aligns with the five-fold blessing God bestowed upon you, i.e., to be fruitful, multiply, replenish, subdue, and have dominion. What you do not have dominion over will eventually have dominion over you, even if it is you. Because dominion is deeply imbedded in your DNA, your first assignment is to exercise your command over your own 12-part being. This week, the first five members will be examined: your knower, transporter, chooser, thinker, and feeler. The remaining seven members will be discussed next week: your perceiver, believer, carver, reproducer, craver, enforcer, and arranger.

I encourage you to become more familiar with who God has already fearfully and wonderfully recreated you to be in Christ. Made in the express image and likeness of God, Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit, they graced you with 100%, i.e., all of who they are and all that they have. The challenge remains whether or not you will embrace to grant 100% of breathing room to them so you can thrive through Jesus Christ. Remember, you are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith.

Before transformation, there must be transparency. Engage God, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit who are equipped to be your covenant partners in reinvention. Yearn to yield as well as yield to yearn your whole spirit, your whole soul, and your whole body as the temple of Holy Spirit. Let the truth of the Word of God you can always trust flood your very being from the inside, out. Jesus has given you His glory. The weight of God's glory makes you "heavy." You are totally loaded, fully equipped to bring heaven to earth.

**You are a Spirit, the Knower with a soul in a body, the Transporter
With a soul, that houses 3 parts: Chooser; Thinker and Feeler**

Your Covenant Partners for your Knower

Knower - You are a precision-directing, life-giving spirit being, inner man - Conscience – is the Knower. Let your conscience be your guide. It bends in the direction it should go in order to follow the Light, just like a flower does on a sunny or cloudy day.

^{9-10a}But as it is written: 'Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love him'. But God has, through the Spirit, let us share his secret.

^{10b-12}For nothing is hidden from the Spirit, not even the deep wisdom of God. For who could really understand a man's inmost thoughts except the spirit of the man himself? How much less could anyone understand the thoughts of God except the very Spirit of God? And the marvellous thing is this, that we now receive not the spirit of the world but the Spirit of God himself, so that we can actually understand something of God's generosity towards us.

This wisdom is only understood by the spiritual

¹³It is these things that we talk about, not using the expressions of the human intellect but those which the Holy Spirit teaches us, explaining things to those who are spiritual.

¹⁴⁻¹⁶But the unspiritual man simply cannot accept the matters which the Spirit deals with—they just don't make sense to him, for, after all, you must be spiritual to see spiritual things. The spiritual man, on the other hand, has an insight into the meaning of everything, though his insight may baffle the man of the world. This is because the former is sharing in God's wisdom, and 'Who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct him?'

Incredible as it may sound, we who are spiritual have the very thoughts of Christ!

Your Covenant Partners for your Transporter

Transporter - In a physical body. To deliver service, develop infrastructure, not operate with props, oxygen; water supply; nutrition, supplements, detoxification, fitness, rest, energy, stamina, has the capacity to live up to 120 years

²⁶And whether one member suffer [ill treatment], all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

²⁷Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Your Covenant Partners for your Chooser

Chooser not just wishing, desiring, or even intentions, but your will - choices; may not choose what need or want, but it chooses what you have.

Motive: emotion operating on the will to act
