

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 159 Scriptures

Jesus' identity rests satisfied in His "soulscrip" so He could live like He had been designed. Before the foundation of the world, He was slain for the sins of the world. At the same time, God chose you to be in relationship with Him. Jesus co-partnered with God and Holy Spirit to create the world in Genesis. After the fall of man, God prophesied Jesus' expected, yet undetected arrival from eternity into time. That gave you the express opportunity to be recreated in Him. Every prophecy in the Old Testament was fulfilled in the New Testament that God pronounced ahead of time about Jesus' birth, life, ministry, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension. This week the first 10 of the 37 prophecies fulfilled will be addressed. God is still speaking prophetically today through the five-fold ministry as well as through every believer. Because you have inherited the ministry of Jesus Christ, God already pronounced that His dream will be fulfilled through you.

What do a lion and a lamb have in common? Neither run from trouble. The lion stays on the offense while the lamb on the defense. Yes, Jesus Christ is the Lion of the Tribe of Judah and the Lamb of God. While the two are polar opposite, Jesus never experienced any role confusion. Therefore, the Lion never consumed the Lamb that was on the inside of Him. God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and power. Jesus' loyal love for His Abba Father kept Him from falling because He never accepted His script from besetting contradictions. He was resolute about living sanctified to God as well as separated from the world, the flesh, and the devil. Jesus' perfection gave you a glorious and triumphant state that never changes, but changes everything. Jesus' 12-part being remained in perfect union with God and Holy Spirit. With Jesus living in your heart, you can live through Him and do the same.

Since God has already given you His best gift, Jesus Christ, why would He ever withhold anything else from you? "Saving health" highlights your total salvation benefits. The Strong's Concordance defines God's all-inclusive provision for you to receive by faith: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance. God's everlasting covenant with you covers every one of your weaknesses with His own strength. "God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face to shine upon us; Selah. That Thy way may be known upon earth, Thy saving health among all nations," Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV). Saving health is the fullness of God's blessing.

YESHUAH IS NOT MISPELLED, BUT CARRIES THE GREATEST INFLUENCE

Salvation benefits are complete, embracing everything all the time as Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV) proves. Our new birth makes the eternal covenant with God alive. He covers every weakness with His strength. "God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face to shine upon us; Selah. That Thy way may be known upon earth, Thy saving health among all nations."

Saving and health carry identical meanings. Strong's Concordance details God's all-inclusive provision: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance. Not only that, the Hebrew translation for saving health is *Yeshuah*, showing Jesus and our Heavenly Father joined together.

The letter "h" is never included at the end of "Yeshua." In this case, it authentically brands Jesus' identification. It also designates God's seal of endorsement rests upon Jesus, showing His own name at rest upon Jesus. The last "h" in Jesus' name is the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet *Heh* (Hei). It is often used to represent the name of God; it sounds like "h" and pronounced as "hey."

This psalm penned by King David picked up on God's covert operations even in the Old Testament. By that time, God had already put His name upon Israel in His blessing to them in Numbers 6:24-27 (KJV). Now God's name that's upon Jesus is also upon the Church. Therefore, the promise has been conferred upon us to inherit God's blessing. "The Lord bless thee, and keep thee: The Lord make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The Lord lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

1- Jesus Christ is the Seed of a woman

Prophecy

Genesis 3:15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁵And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her ^[a]Offspring; He will bruise *and* tread your head underfoot, and you will lie in wait *and* bruise His heel.

⁵To purchase the freedom of (to ransom, to redeem, to ^[a]atone for) those who were subject to the Law, that we might be adopted *and* have sonship conferred upon us [and be recognized as God's sons].

⁶And because you [really] are [His] sons, God has sent the ^[b]Holy Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, Abba (Father)! Father!

⁷Therefore, you are no longer a slave (bond servant) but a son; and if a son, then [it follows that you are] an heir ^[c]by the aid of God, *through Christ*.

2- Jesus Christ is the Seed of Abraham

Prophecy

Genesis 12:1-3 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

Now [in Haran] the Lord said to Abram, Go for yourself [for your own advantage] away from your country, from your relatives and your father's house, to the land that I will show you.

²And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you [with abundant increase of favors] and make your name famous *and* distinguished, and you will be a blessing [dispensing good to others].

³And I will bless those who bless you [who confer prosperity or happiness upon you] and ^[a]curse him who curses *or* uses insolent language toward you; in you will all the families *and* kindred of the earth be blessed [and by you they will bless themselves].

- a. [Genesis 12:3](#) To look with disfavor on the Jews was to invite God's displeasure; to treat the Jews offensively was to incur His wrath. But to befriend the Jews was to bring down upon one's head the rewards of a promise that could not be broken.

¹⁶Jacob the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, Who is called the Christ. (the Messiah, the Anointed)

¹⁷So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen, from David to the Babylonian exile (deportation) fourteen generations, from the Babylonian exile to the Christ fourteen generations.

¹⁸Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place under these circumstances: When His mother Mary had been promised in marriage to Joseph, before they came together, she was found to be pregnant [through the power] of the Holy Spirit.

¹⁹And her [promised] husband Joseph, being a just *and* upright man and not willing to expose her publicly *and* to shame *and* disgrace her, decided to repudiate *and* dismiss (divorce) her quietly *and* secretly.

²⁰But as he was thinking this over, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, Joseph, descendant of David, do not be afraid to take Mary [as] your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of (from, out of) the Holy Spirit.

²¹She will bear a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus [the Greek form of the Hebrew Joshua, which means Savior], for He will save His people from their sins [that is, prevent them from ^[a]failing and missing the true end and scope of life, which is God].

²²All this took place that it might be fulfilled which the Lord had spoken through the prophet,

²³Behold, the virgin shall become pregnant and give birth to a Son, and they shall call His name Emmanuel—which, when translated, means, God with us.

²⁴Then Joseph, being aroused from his sleep, did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him: he took [her to his side as] his wife.

²⁵But he had no union with her as her husband until she had borne *her firstborn* Son; and he called His name Jesus.

¹⁹But God said, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son indeed, and you shall call his name Isaac [laughter]; and I will establish My covenant *or* solemn pledge with him for an everlasting covenant and with his posterity after him.

4- Jesus Christ is the Seed of Jacob

Prophecy

Numbers 24:17 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁷I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but He is not near. A ^[a]star (Star) shall come forth out of Jacob, and a scepter (Scepter) shall rise out of Israel

and shall crush all the corners of Moab and break down all the sons of Sheth [Moab's sons of tumult].

- a. [Numbers 24:17](#) “This imagery in the hieroglyphic language of the East denotes some eminent ruler—primarily David, but secondarily and preeminently the Messiah” (Robert Jamieson, A.R. Faussett and David Brown, *A Commentary*). Notice that the principal time for these events is set in the prophecy for “the latter days” (Num. 24:14). “The prophecy [concerning Moab] was partially, or typically, fulfilled in the time of David (II Sam. 8:2). Moab and Edom represented symbolically the enemies of Christ and His church, and as such will eventually be subdued by the King of kings (see Ps. 60:8)” (Charles J. Ellicott, *A Bible Commentary*). “The star which the wise men from the East saw, and which led them in the way to the newborn ‘King of the Jews,’ refers clearly to the prophecy of Balaam (Matt. 2:1, 2)” (J.P. Lange, *A Commentary*).

⁸Judah, you are the one whom your brothers shall praise; your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; your father's sons shall bow down to you.

⁹Judah, a lion's cub! With the prey, my son, you have gone high up [the mountain]. He stooped down, he crouched like a lion, and like a lioness—who dares provoke *and* rouse him?

¹⁰The scepter *or* leadership shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh [the Messiah, the Peaceful One] comes to Whom it belongs, and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

¹¹Binding His foal to the vine and His donkey's colt to the choice vine, He washes His garments in wine and His clothes in the blood of grapes.

¹²His eyes are darker *and* more sparkling than wine, and His teeth whiter than milk.

⁶For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father [of Eternity], Prince of Peace.

⁷Of the increase of His government and of peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from the [latter] time forth, even forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

²⁵Know therefore and understand that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem until [the coming of] the Anointed One, a Prince, shall be seven weeks [of years] and sixty-two weeks

[of years]; it shall be built again with [city] square and moat, but in troublous times.

¹⁴Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign: Behold, the young woman who is unmarried *and* a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel [God with us].

²⁶Now in the sixth month [after that], the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee named Nazareth,

¹⁵Thus says the Lord: A (a)voice is heard in Ramah, lamentation and bitter weeping. Rachel is weeping for her children; she refuses to be comforted for her children, because they are no more.

- a. [Jeremiah 31:15](#) The mourning at Ramah is a forecast of that bitter wailing which would be raised by the mothers of the slaughtered babes of Bethlehem centuries later when Herod would attempt to kill the Christ Child (Matt. 2:17, 18). Rachel's name, used in the prophecy, is naturally associated with Bethlehem by the fact that her tomb was in that neighborhood (*The Cambridge Bible*).

¹⁷Then was fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Jeremiah:
