

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 160 Scriptures

Jesus' identity rests satisfied in His "soulsript" so He could live like He had been designed. Before the foundation of the world, He was slain for the sins of the world. At the same time, God chose you to be in relationship with Him. Jesus co-partnered with God and Holy Spirit to create the world in Genesis. After the fall of man, God prophesied Jesus' expected, yet undetected arrival from eternity into time. That gave you the express opportunity to be recreated in Him. Every prophecy in the Old Testament was fulfilled in the New Testament that God pronounced ahead of time about Jesus' birth, life, ministry, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension. This week the next 13 of the 37 prophecies fulfilled will be addressed. The first 10 were addressed last week. God is still speaking prophetically today through the five-fold ministry as well as through every believer. Because you have inherited the ministry of Jesus Christ, God already pronounced that His dream will be fulfilled through you.

What do a lion and a lamb have in common? Neither run from trouble. The lion stays on the offense while the lamb on the defense. Yes, Jesus Christ is the Lion of the Tribe of Judah and the Lamb of God. While the two are polar opposite, Jesus never experienced any role confusion. Therefore, the Lion never consumed the Lamb that was on the inside of Him. God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and power. Jesus' loyal love for His Abba Father kept Him from falling because He never accepted His script from besetting contradictions. He was resolute about living sanctified to God as well as separated from the world, the flesh, and the devil. Jesus' perfection gave you a glorious and triumphant state that never changes, but changes everything. Jesus' 12-part being remained in perfect union with God and Holy Spirit. With Jesus living in your heart, you can live through Him and do the same.

Since God has already given you His best gift, Jesus Christ, why would He ever withhold anything else from you? "Saving health" highlights your total salvation benefits. The Strong's Concordance defines God's all-inclusive provision for you to receive by faith: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance. God's everlasting covenant with you covers every one of your weaknesses with His own strength. "God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face to shine upon us; Selah. That Thy way may be known upon earth, Thy saving health among all nations," Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV). Saving health is the fullness of God's blessing.

Prophecies Fulfilled 11-24

YESHUAH IS NOT MISSPELLED, BUT CARRIES THE GREATEST INFLUENCE

Salvation benefits are complete, embracing everything all the time as Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV) proves. Our new birth makes the eternal covenant with God alive. He covers every weakness with His strength. "God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face to shine upon us; Selah. That Thy way may be known upon earth, Thy saving health among all nations."

Saving and health carry identical meanings. Strong's Concordance details God's all-inclusive provision: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance. Not only that, the Hebrew translation for saving health is *Yeshuah*, showing Jesus and our Heavenly Father joined together.

The letter "h" is never included at the end of "Yeshua." In this case, it authentically brands Jesus' identification. It also designates God's seal of endorsement rests upon Jesus, showing His own name at rest upon Jesus. The last "h" in Jesus' name is the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet *Heh* (Hei). It is often used to represent the name of God; it sounds like "h" and pronounced as "hey."

This psalm penned by King David picked up on God's covert operations even in the Old Testament. By that time, God had already put His name upon Israel in His blessing to them in Numbers 6:24-27 (KJV). Now God's name that's upon Jesus is also upon the Church. Therefore, the promise has been conferred upon us to inherit God's blessing. "The Lord bless thee, and keep thee: The Lord make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The Lord lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

11- Jesus Christ's Flight to Egypt

Prophecy

Hosea 11:1 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

When Israel was a child, then I loved him and called My son out of Egypt.

Fulfilled

Matthew 2:14-15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁴And having risen, he took the Child and His mother by night and withdrew to Egypt

¹⁵And remained there until Herod's death. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, Out of Egypt have I called My Son.

12- Jesus Christ Preceded by a Forerunner

Prophecy

Malachi 3:1 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

Behold, I send My ^[a]messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me. And the Lord [the Messiah], Whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; the ^[b]Messenger *or* Angel of the covenant, Whom you desire, behold, He shall come, says the Lord of hosts.

13- Jesus Christ Declared the Son of God

Prophecy

Psalm 2:7 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁷I will declare the decree of the Lord: He said to Me, You are My Son; this day [I declare] I have begotten You.

Fulfilled

Matthew 3:16-17 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁶And when Jesus was baptized, He went up at once out of the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he [John] saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him.

¹⁷And behold, a voice from heaven said, This is My Son, My Beloved, in Whom I delight!

14- Jesus Christ's Galilean Ministry

Prophecy

Isaiah 9:1-2 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

But [in the midst of judgment there is the promise and the certainty of the Lord's deliverance and] there shall be no gloom for her who was in anguish. In the former time [the Lord] brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time He will make it glorious, by the way of the Sea [of Galilee, the land] beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations.

²The people who walked in darkness have seen a great Light; those who dwelt in the land of intense darkness *and* the shadow of death, upon them has the Light shined.

Matthew 4:13-16 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹³And leaving Nazareth, He went *and* dwelt in Capernaum by the sea, in the country of Zebulun and Naphtali—

¹⁴That what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be brought to pass:

¹⁵The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, in the ^[a]way to the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles [of the ^[b]peoples who are not of Israel]—

¹⁶The people who sat ^[c](dwelt enveloped) in darkness have seen a great Light, and for those who sat in the land and shadow of death Light has dawned.

15- Jesus Christ is The Prophet

Prophecy

Deuteronomy 18:15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁵The Lord your God will raise up for you ^[a]a prophet (Prophet) from the midst of your brethren like me [Moses]; to him you shall listen.

[Deuteronomy 18:15](#) The insertion of this promise in connection with the preceding prohibition might warrant the application which some make of it to that order of true prophets whom God commissioned in unbroken succession to instruct, to direct, and warn His people; in this view the gist of it is, “there is no need to consult with diviners and soothsayers, for I shall afford you the benefit of divinely appointed prophets, for judging of whose identity a sure clue is given” (Deut. 18:20, 22). But the prophet here promised was preeminently the Messiah, for He alone was “like unto Moses in His mediatorial character; in the peculiar excellence of His ministry; in the number, variety, and magnitude of His miracles; in His close and familiar communion with God; and in His being the author of a new dispensation of religion.” This prediction was fulfilled 1,500 years afterwards, and was expressly applied to Christ by Peter (Acts 3:22, 23) and by Stephen (Acts 7:37) (Robert Jamieson, A.R. Fausset and David Brown, *A Commentary*).

¹⁹So repent (change your mind and purpose); turn around *and* return [to God], that your sins may be erased (blotted out, wiped clean), that times of refreshing (of recovering from the effects of heat, of ^[a]reviving with fresh air) may come from the presence of the Lord;

²⁰And that He may send [to you] the Christ (the Messiah), Who before was designated *and* appointed for you—even Jesus,

²¹Whom heaven must receive [and retain] until the time for the complete restoration of all that God spoke by the mouth of all His holy prophets for ages past [from the most ancient time in the memory of man].

²²Thus Moses said *to the forefathers*, The Lord God will raise up for you a Prophet from among your brethren as [He raised up] me; Him you shall listen to *and* understand by hearing *and* heed in all things whatever He tells you.

16- Jesus Christ's Saving Health Ministry

Prophecy

Isaiah 61:1-3 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed *and* qualified me to preach the Gospel *of* good tidings to the meek, the poor, *and* afflicted; He has sent me to bind up *and* heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives and the opening of the prison *and* of the eyes to those who are bound,

²To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord [the year of His favor] ^[a]and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn,

³To grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion—to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, *and* failing spirit—that they may be called oaks of righteousness

[lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.

Luke 4:18-19 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁸The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity],

¹⁹To proclaim the accepted *and* acceptable year of the Lord [the day ^[a]when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

17- Jesus Christ was Rejected by His own People

Prophecy

Isaiah 53:3 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

³He was despised and rejected *and* forsaken by men, a Man of sorrows *and* pains, and acquainted with grief *and* sickness; and like One from Whom men hide their faces He was despised, and we did not appreciate His worth *or* have any esteem for Him.

John 1:11 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹¹He came to that which belonged to Him [to His own—His domain, creation, things, world], and they who were His own did not receive Him *and* did not welcome Him.

18- Jesus Christ is the Priest after order of Melchizedek

Prophecy

Psalm 110:1-4 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

A Psalm of David.

¹The Lord (God) says to my Lord (the Messiah), Sit at My right hand, until I make Your adversaries Your footstool.

²The Lord will send forth from Zion the scepter of Your strength; rule, then, in the midst of Your foes.

³Your people will offer themselves willingly in the day of Your power, in the beauty of holiness *and* in holy array out of the womb of the morning; to You [will spring forth] Your young men, who are as the dew.

⁴The Lord has sworn and will not revoke *or* change it: You are a priest forever, after the manner *and* order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 5:5-6 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁵So too Christ (the Messiah) did not exalt Himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed *and* exalted by Him Who said to Him, You are My Son; today I have begotten You;

⁶As He says also in another place, You are a Priest [appointed] forever after the order (with ^[a]the rank) of Melchizedek.

19- Jesus Christ's Triumphal Entry

Prophecy

Zechariah 9:9 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁹Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O Daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King comes to you; He is [uncompromisingly] just and having

salvation [triumphant and victorious], patient, meek, lowly, and riding on a donkey, upon a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Fulfilled

Mark 11:7-11 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁷And they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their outer garments upon it, and He sat on it.

⁸And many [of the people] spread their garments on the road, and others [scattered a layer of] leafy branches which they had cut from the fields.

⁹And those who went before and those who followed cried out [^[a]with a cry of happiness], Hosanna! [Be graciously inclined and propitious to Him!] Praised *and* blessed is He Who comes in the name of the Lord!

¹⁰Praised *and* blessed *in the name of the Lord* is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna (O save us) in the highest [heaven]!

¹¹And Jesus went into Jerusalem and entered the temple [^[b]enclosure]; and when He had looked around, surveying *and* observing everything, as it was already late, He went out to Bethany together with the Twelve [apostles].

20- Jesus Christ Betrayed by a Friend

Prophecy

Psalms 41:9 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁹Even my own familiar friend, in whom I trusted (relied on and was confident), who ate of my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.

Fulfilled

Luke 22:47-48 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁴⁷And while He was still speaking, behold, there came a crowd, and the man called Judas, one of the Twelve [apostles], was going before [leading] them. He drew near to Jesus to kiss Him,

⁴⁸But Jesus said to him, Judas! Would you betray *and* deliver up the Son of Man with a kiss?

21- Jesus Christ Sold for thirty pieces of silver

Prophecy

Zechariah 11:12 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹²And I said to them, If it seems just *and* right to you, give me my wages; but if not, withhold them. So they weighed out for my price thirty pieces of silver.

Fulfilled

Matthew 26:15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹⁵And said, What are you willing to give me if I hand Him over to you? And they weighed out for *and* paid to him thirty pieces of silver [about twenty-one dollars and sixty cents].

22- Jesus Christ Accused by false witnesses

Prophecy

Psalms 35:11 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

¹¹Malicious *and* unrighteous witnesses rise up; they ask me of things that I know not.

Psalms 35:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹False witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge things that I knew not.

Fulfilled

Mark 14:57-58 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁵⁷And some stood up and were bearing false witness against Him, saying,

⁵⁸We heard Him say, I will destroy this temple (sanctuary) which is made with hands, and in three days I will build another, made without hands.

23- Jesus Christ Silent to accusation

Prophecy

Isaiah 53:7 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁷He was oppressed, [yet when] He was afflicted, He was submissive *and* opened not His mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He opened not His mouth.

Fulfilled

Mark 15:4-5 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁴And Pilate again asked Him, Have ^[a]You no answer to make? See how many charges they are bringing against You!

⁵But Jesus made no further answer at all, so that Pilate wondered *and* marveled.

Matthew 26:67 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁶⁷Then they spat in His face and struck Him with their fists; and some ^[a]slapped Him in the face,
