THE REALITY OF BEING WHO GOD RECREATED YOU TO BE IN CHRIST

God already prearranged for you to live, move, and have your total being in Him. “Thine eyes shall see the King in His beauty: they shall behold the land that is very far off,” Is. 33:17 (KJV). Pursue Jesus until all of His glory light manifests through you. “If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with Him in glory,” Col. 3:1-4 (KJV). Press pass gory and mirror the Word of God and watch Holy Spirit take you from one level of glory to the next level of glory. “For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal,” 2 Cor. 4:17-18 (KJV). Passionately see Jesus as He really is, the King of Glory. “Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is,” 1 John 3:2 (KJV). Passionately be as Jesus really is in this world. “Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world,” 1 John 4:17 (KJV).

CALLED OUT OF DARKNESS INTO HIS MARVELOUS LIGHT

Your vision will either draw in heaven’s provision or hell’s division. “The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!” Matthew 6:22-23 (KJV). Unbelief is the refusal to believe Jesus is trustful and truthful and it barricades your new life in Christ until you choose His Light, not your own. “Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the Light with you. Walk while ye have the Light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth. While ye have Light, believe in the Light, that ye may be the children of Light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide Himself from them. But though He had done so many miracles before them, yet they believed not on Him: That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, ‘Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed? Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, he hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.’ These things said Esaias, when he saw His glory, and spake of Him,” John 12:35-41 (KJV). God’s vision for you is allow Him to magnify His glory light so Jesus is clearly seen. “Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house,” Matthew 5:14-15 (KJV). Show His Light!

Until Paul’s conversion he could not see Jesus as He is since he could not see what he needed to correct. After the light of Jesus blinded Paul, he saw the truth of his call, “to open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me,” Acts 26:18. Paul unmask satan, the mind-blinder: “Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man’s conscience in the sight of God. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them,” 2 Cor. 4:1-4. Paul unmask satan, the heart-blinder: “This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness,” Eph. 4:17-19. Jesus sent you to open blind eyes and hearts today.

Thought for Transformation

The Word of God and the Spirit of God always give you clarity. You can see the end even at the beginning. That helps you bring closure to what should be disregarded or discarded. Clearance will surface when contradictions can no longer blindside your progress or process. Customize your daily course so you crystallize the God-sized dream that in His heart for you.

Authentic Mirroring

Hearer of the Word Always: “For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed,” James 1:23-25 (KJV) Doer of the Word Always: Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom). And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendor and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit,” 2 Corinthians 3:17-18 (AMPC). Be a credible witness that God’s Word and Spirit never use artificial mirrors.
