

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 171 Scriptures**

**Along with your New Birth, you inherit the mind of Christ. Translated from Greek, that is the very "intellect of Jesus Christ." As you live through Jesus, you not only own but also occupy spiritual mindedness in every sphere of influence through the Spirit of God and Word of God. On earth, Jesus Christ yearned and yielded His complete spirit, soul, and body to God, His Heavenly Father to live totally sanctified to Him. Jesus equally lived totally separated from satan, the flesh, and the world. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him. Jesus never—not even once—vexed, grieved, or quenched Holy Spirit. This is the same Spirit, Holy Spirit who makes you alive in Christ. Live totally surrendered to God!**

**The greater your defense shields you from offense. You become undetected therefore unexpected to enemy forces. So what is your stance in every battle? Irresistibility! Always live appealing to God as well as appalling to satan. You host an unfair advantage when you know God, know yourself, and know the enemy. What is heaven's treasure that satan is after? The knowledge of God! Since it was impossible to breach the line of communication in heaven, he lusts for you to never obtain, attain, contain, and retain the knowledge of God on earth. Through confusion, the devil mixes lies, errors, and deception to lace the truth. Since he believed the lie he told himself and the one-third fallen angels, he wants you to do the same. The enemy craves for you to be possessed by his mind alone, the carnal mind that leads to premature death. Therefore, stay adamant about the mind of Christ being your winning position. Then you will stand ready to resist and refuse to surrender it during any battle. God made you to be more than a conqueror that always fights from the place of triumph.**

**This is what happens when God puts all His omnipotence on your impotence. You can do all things through Christ who strengthens you because you have a supernatural disposition. You can see Jesus as He is and be as He is in this world. That is why God chooses the foolish things of the world to confound the wise and the weak things of the world to confound the mighty. That is how your humility before God grants Jesus all the honor He alone deserves. That is the sole purpose for being out of your mind into His, the mind of Christ.**

## **Holy Spirit grants you access to the mind of Christ**

**Holy Spirit saturates you with at least twenty-seven capabilities that are compartmentalized within the following three main categories: Wisdom; Love; and Power. 2 Timothy 1:6-7 names the three diverse groups for the purpose of you activating them completely through Holy Spirit alone. When each one is fully operational, you are flooded with God Himself. That gives God every opportunity to fully express Himself without any limitations when you surrender your all to Him.**

2 Timothy 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>6</sup> Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. <sup>7</sup> For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind [wisdom].

**In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory].**

**Resting in the Lord allows them to have habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him at all.**

**Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. It indicates someone keeps resisting until he completely pulls away from Him. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."**

Isaiah 11:2, 5, 10 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>2</sup> And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; <sup>5</sup> And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. <sup>10</sup> And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

**In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance.**

**Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is both protection and preservation. God's seal of endorsement that is upon Holy Spirit and Jesus Christ**

**protects and preserves His fruit in and through you. Therefore you are sealed as well. That is similar to coating fruit with natural wax to protect it from rotting. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good.**

**Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit, so He won't lose any opportunity through you. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."**

Galatians 5:22-23 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, <sup>23</sup> Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

**In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues.**

**Walking softly before the Lord helps you to discern Holy Spirit's moves to ensure what He has designed can never be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."**

1 Corinthians 12:4-11 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>4</sup> Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. <sup>5</sup> And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. <sup>6</sup> And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. <sup>7</sup> But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. <sup>8</sup> For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; <sup>9</sup> To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; <sup>10</sup> To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: <sup>11</sup> But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.

## **Holy Spirit awakens your acquaintance to the life of God preserving your undivided attention**

Romans 8:1-17 Living Bible (TLB)

So there is now no condemnation awaiting those who belong to Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup>For the power of the life-giving Spirit—and this power is mine through Christ Jesus—has freed me from the vicious circle of sin and death. <sup>3</sup>We aren't saved from sin's grasp by knowing the commandments of God because we can't and don't keep them, but God put into effect a different plan to save us. He sent his own Son in a human body like ours—except that ours are sinful—and destroyed sin's control over us by giving himself as a sacrifice for our sins. <sup>4</sup>So now we can obey God's laws if we follow after the Holy Spirit and no longer obey the old evil nature within us.

<sup>5</sup>Those who let themselves be controlled by their lower natures live only to please themselves, but those who follow after the Holy Spirit find themselves doing those things that please God. <sup>6</sup>Following after the Holy Spirit leads to life and peace, but following after the old nature [carnal mind] leads to death <sup>7</sup>because the old sinful nature [carnal mind] within us is against God. It never did obey God's laws and it never will. <sup>8</sup>That's why those who are still under the control of their old sinful selves, bent on following their old evil desires, can never please God.

<sup>9</sup>But you are not like that. You are controlled by your new nature if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (And remember that if anyone doesn't have the Spirit of Christ living in him, he is not a Christian at all.) <sup>10</sup>Yet, even though Christ lives within you, your body will die because of sin; but your spirit will live, for Christ has pardoned it.<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>11</sup>And if the Spirit of God, who raised up Jesus from the dead, lives in you, he will make your dying bodies live again after you die, by means of this same Holy Spirit living within you.

<sup>12</sup>So, dear brothers, you have no obligations whatever to your old sinful nature to do what it begs you to do. <sup>13</sup>For if you keep on following it you are lost and will perish, but if through the power of the Holy Spirit you crush it and its evil deeds, you shall live. <sup>14</sup>For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

<sup>15</sup>And so we should not be like cringing, fearful slaves, but we should behave like God's very own children, adopted into the bosom of his family, and calling to him, "Father, Father." <sup>16</sup>For his Holy Spirit speaks to us deep in our hearts and tells us that we really are God's children. <sup>17</sup>And since we are his children, we will share his treasures—for all God gives to his Son Jesus is now ours too. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.

## **Holy Spirit refreshes your senses to surrender to maturity**

1 Corinthians 3 Living Bible (TLB)

Dear brothers, I have been talking to you as though you were still just babies in the Christian life who are not following the Lord but your own desires; I cannot talk to you as I would to healthy Christians who are filled with the Spirit. <sup>2</sup>I have had to feed you with milk and not with solid food because you couldn't digest anything stronger. And even now you still have to be fed on milk. <sup>3</sup>For you are still only baby Christians, controlled by your own desires, not God's. When you are jealous of one another and divide up into quarreling groups, doesn't that prove you are still babies, wanting your own way? In fact, you are acting like people who don't belong to the Lord at all. <sup>4</sup>There you are, quarreling about whether I am greater than Apollos, and

dividing the church. Doesn't this show how little you have grown in the Lord?<sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>5</sup>Who am I, and who is Apollos, that we should be the cause of a quarrel? Why, we're just God's servants, each of us with certain special abilities, and with our help you believed. <sup>6</sup>My work was to plant the seed in your hearts, and Apollos' work was to water it, but it was God, not we, who made the garden grow in your hearts. <sup>7</sup>The person who does the planting or watering isn't very important, but God is important because he is the one who makes things grow. <sup>8</sup>Apollos and I are working as a team, with the same aim, though each of us will be rewarded for his own hard work. <sup>9</sup>We are only God's coworkers. You are *God's* garden, not ours; you are *God's* building, not ours.

<sup>10</sup>God, in his kindness, has taught me how to be an expert builder. I have laid the foundation and Apollos has built on it. But he who builds on the foundation must be very careful. <sup>11</sup>And no one can ever lay any other real foundation than that one we already have—Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup>But there are various kinds of materials that can be used to build on that foundation. Some use gold and silver and jewels; and some build with sticks and hay or even straw! <sup>13</sup>There is going to come a time of testing at Christ's Judgment Day to see what kind of material each builder has used. Everyone's work will be put through the fire so that all can see whether or not it keeps its value, and what was really accomplished. <sup>14</sup>Then every workman who has built on the foundation with the right materials, and whose work still stands, will get his pay. <sup>15</sup>But if the house he has built burns up, he will have a great loss. He himself will be saved, but like a man escaping through a wall of flames.

<sup>16</sup>Don't you realize that all of you together are the house of God, and that the Spirit of God lives among you in his house? <sup>17</sup>If anyone defiles and spoils God's home, God will destroy him. For God's home is holy and clean, and you are that home.

<sup>18</sup>Stop fooling yourselves. If you count yourself above average in intelligence, as judged by this world's standards, you had better put this all aside and be a fool rather than let it hold you back from the true wisdom from above. <sup>19</sup>For the wisdom of this world is foolishness to God. As it says in the book of Job, God uses man's own brilliance to trap him; he stumbles

over his own “wisdom” and falls. <sup>20</sup>And again, in the book of Psalms, we are told that the Lord knows full well how the human mind reasons and how foolish and futile it is.

<sup>21</sup>So don’t be proud of following the wise men of this world.<sup>[b]</sup> For God has already given you everything you need. <sup>22</sup>He has given you Paul and Apollos and Peter as your helpers. He has given you the whole world to use, and life and even death are your servants. He has given you all of the present and all of the future. All are yours, <sup>23</sup>and you belong to Christ, and Christ is God’s.

1 Corinthians 2:14-16 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>14</sup>But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

<sup>15</sup>But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

<sup>16</sup>For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? but we have the mind of Christ.

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

**Holy Spirit gives you confidence shielding you from confusion**

## **CONFUSION CONQUERED**

**There is a central place where confusion always begins. To whet your appetite, a fragment of truth usually exists among the deception, error, and lie. That is the reason why the presence of the truth makes the report to seem believable.**

**Consider this: what deception, error and lie made the devil believe he could overthrow God and be King in His place? Even created as lucifer, evidently there was still information that was impossible for him to access.**

**Now labeled as satan, he has been demoted to being only known as the father of lies. Jesus confirmed that there was no truth in him**

**even from his beginnings. If truth is combined with a lie, the statement is still false.**

**On the other hand, you have been pre-selected to not just know, but to have the mind of Christ. Wow! Since the enemy believed the deception, error, and lie he told himself and the one-third of the fallen angels, why listen to him at all?**

**Being mindful of compelling evidence that is scripturally based helps you to really see the enemy's main stratagem is against all humans, those saved and those about to be saved. That defeated foe targets the knowledge of God to try to establish a stronghold in your mind so you will not even discover the truth. It is steep in satan's diabolical nature for you to never have the capacity to distinguish his deception, error and lie. That is a breeding ground for confusion.**

**Better still, 2 Corinthians 10:4-6 documents your divine way of escape. You can reposition yourself to secure revelation knowledge from the Spirit of God and the Word of God. Because this fight is always categorized as a spiritual battle, it is impossible to keep satan defeated in the carnal realm at all.**

**To deactivate the deception, error, and lie, never strip off or slip out of the whole armor of God. To remain resistless in battle, be Holy Spirit-led so you can activate every spiritual weapon: the blood of the Lamb; the name of Jesus; and the Word of God.**

2 Corinthians 10:4-6 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>4</sup> (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) <sup>5</sup> Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; <sup>6</sup> And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

**Using the above scripture reference as an exercise, let's carefully break it down into usable compartments. With each step, you will recognize the sequence of demolishing what satan thinks is his greatest weapon against you.**

## 2 Corinthians 10:1-6 The Passion Translation (TPT)

### Paul's Defense of His Ministry

Now, please listen, for I need to address an issue. I'm making this personal appeal to you by the gentleness<sup>[a]</sup> and self-forgetfulness of Christ. I am the one who is "humble and timid" when face-to-face with you but "bold and outspoken" when a safe distance away.<sup>[b]</sup> <sup>2</sup> Now I plead with you that when I come, don't force me to take a hard line with you (which I'm willing to do) by daring to confront<sup>[c]</sup> those who mistakenly believe that we are living by the standards of the world, *not by the Spirit's wisdom and power.* <sup>3-4</sup> For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, *using manipulation to achieve our aims.* Instead, our *spiritual* weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses *behind which people hide.*<sup>[d]</sup> <sup>5</sup> We can demolish every deceptive fantasy<sup>[e]</sup> that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought<sup>[f]</sup> and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One. <sup>6</sup> *Since we are armed with such dynamic weaponry, we stand ready to punish<sup>[g]</sup> any trace of rebellion, as soon as you choose complete obedience.*<sup>[h]</sup>

#### Footnotes:

- a. [10:1](#) The Aramaic can be translated "peace" or, literally "by the oasis rest."
- b. [10:1](#) Paul is apparently quoting their own words that they used to describe him.
- c. [10:2](#) Literally "Don't force me to be severe with the confidence with which I reckon to dare." Paul pleads with them not to mistake his humility as weakness or an unwillingness to act with authority.
- d. [10:3-4](#) Or "strongholds." The Aramaic word for strongholds can also be translated "rebellious castles." Paul seems to be referring to demonic strongholds or centers of opposition to the light of the gospel.
- e. [10:5](#) Or "citadels of argumentations," which include fantasies.
- f. [10:5](#) Or "every scheme." Paul is using the concept of taking prisoners of war, but in this case the prisoners held captive are faulty patterns of thought that defy God's authority.
- g. [10:6](#) Or "court martial."
- h. [10:6](#) This completes one long, complicated Greek sentence that began in v. [3](#). In this passage Paul describes four arenas of our warfare: (1) We are empowered by grace and with the gospel to dismantle strongholds. (2) We demolish arguments, opinions, theories, and philosophies. (3) We take captive every thought to insist that it become obedient to the mind of Christ. (4) We stand ready and willing to wage war and defeat the enemy ([Eph. 6:10-18](#)).

**Holy Spirit keeps the life of God flowing in you detonating chaos**

**As we begin, preserve the following truths in the forefront of your mind. Keep the Spirit of God and the Word of God first place in your life daily. Then out of the abundance of your heart, your mouth will command the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God. That is how you recognize and realize your irresistibility. You remain appealing to the Most High God as well as appalling to satan.**

**You are more than a conqueror through God who loved you so much He gave you His very best gift, Jesus Christ. To make your calling and election sure, you are God's best gift in this world when you abide in your chosen sphere of influence. God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and *dunamis* power to carry out His assignment and agenda on earth. Now Jesus works with us to ensure His signs and wonders follow us. It manifests as the works Jesus performed during His earthly ministry as well as the greater works He promised.**

**Everything Jesus finished at Calvary for you was so you could never lose any ground. As your Conquering King, God guarantees that you cannot lose the battle unless you surrender your victory to satan. In Christ, you outclass every enemy force.**

**Not stopping there, but Jesus Christ gave you God's gift, Holy Spirit. His purpose is to establish perfect succession of the finished work of Christ in the earth. The Spirit of God is always your Comforter. He is a very present and active force in your life at all times. It does not matter if it is a time of war or a time of peace. You can activate Holy Spirit in any sphere of influence, i.e., eternity past, eternity present, and eternity prospective.**

**As you embrace the mind of Christ, Holy Spirit teaches you all things. He reminds you of what Jesus commanded, guides you into all truth, and shows you things to come. Yearning for Holy Spirit and yielding to being spirit-led, you will engage every battle until you seize all the spoils of war from satan successfully.**

<sup>4</sup> (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

**God has already approved His very own eternally-tested spiritual weapons for you to employ and to destroy every stronghold. Eternally, each piece of artillery stands lethal against the kingdom of**

**darkness keeping satan defeated. That is the reason you are always fighting from the place of victory, never trying to attain it. Therefore, above and beyond put on and keep on the whole armor of God. Likewise, daily activate: the blood of the Lamb; the name of Jesus; the Word of God, both *logos* and *rhema*; enthroning praise; prayer; and your guardian angels.**

**The enemy's defense is his attempt to build a stronghold to put you in a headlock. With his chain around your neck to bring your soul into iron, he attempts to besiege you. The scheme is either to take you captive all at once or little by little. Any assault is to paralyze you. The enemy lusts after you to bring in your into oppression, i.e., to exercise dominion against you.**

**Always resist satan, once you first submit yourself to God. That is how you secure the Lord as your Stronghold, your Defense in every battle. Never concede to what appears to be a never-ending battle. Never forfeit the triumph that Jesus already conquered for you as an heir of the world. He gave you the world as the spoils of war to keep it conquered. You hold the winning position because Jesus Christ already gave you the winning position.**

<sup>5</sup> Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

**Grant God all the room He requires so you become the habitation He always desired you to be to Him. Be adamant about repossessing every inch satan dispossessed in his attempt to devour you. The enemy is already convinced it is impossible to penetrate the knowledge of God, especially revelation knowledge. That is why his target is to render you powerless by incarcerating your soul so you cannot obtain, contain, and retain God's knowledge through His Spirit and His Word. That is satan's corruption stratagem against you so you will be sentenced to premature death or living a premature life. Stay relentless about nourishing and cherishing the truth you trust in your heart and mind. It is impossible for God to ever lie; His eternal covenant with you overflows with His vowed promises for you, which ends all strife that is against you, internally and externally.**

**On the other hand, it is impossible for satan to ever tell the truth. Jesus labeled the devil as the father of lies, even since the beginning of his existence. God did not make satan evil, the devil chose it. Stay**

**relentless by capturing every single diabolical missile he sends. Preserve your mind against being satan's launching pad or a landing place. Detect and detonate all satanic influence without delay. Usher each thought under the custody of the Spirit of God and the Word of God so you always agree with God. Stay determined to maintain the victory, instead of living victimized.**

**If you are saved, you already have the mind of Christ. What activates Holy Spirit in your daily routine is living in and by the Word of God until you are totally saturated. The Spirit of God and the Word of God renews your mind so you will embrace, enjoy, and experience the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God.**

**God preserved His truth for all eternity. God's truth sanctifies you to Him as well as separates you from satan. All truth from God already carved out your eternal emancipation. Therefore to walk at liberty, it is impossible to thrive without the Spirit of God and the Word of God fully operating in your life. Faithfully cover yourself by voice-activating Scriptures that pertain to your wellbeing and to every sphere of influence.**

**The perfect relationship with the Word of God is practice reading it aloud until you host a resting place for those promises within your heart. As the reality of truth surfaces, you will see the manifestation of the promises because you have received revelation knowledge. Holy Spirit inspires the *logos* Word in your heart which ignites the *rhema* Word out of your mouth. Your rehearsal of speaking the Word of God out of your mouth as you read it activates the measure of the faith of God that is already resident within you. Allow your confession to transform into God's command. That remains the process for the fulfillment of the abundant life Jesus promised you even on earth. If you attempt to replace that time with other things, you will always feel empty because of a Word deficiency.**

<sup>6</sup> And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

**At the onset of attack, stand ready to move into combat. That can only be accomplished if you never let your guard down at any time. In the time of war or in the time of peace, you will remain safeguarded from the enemy because of your steadfastness in the Word of God. Jesus protects and preserves you by His force of arms in order to protect and preserve you from any weapon of destruction.**

**As your Shield, *magan*, the Hebrew Honey confirms that Jesus, “our Prince has a limitless arsenal with which to guarantee perfect protection personally.” That is similar to employing a bodyguard who takes the hit for you that was originally intended for you. A guardian is professionally trained to defend you at any cost, which means he is employed to give his life for you at all times. How much more of the supernatural Defense is Jesus to you? Jesus has already given His life for you to win you back into the family of God.**

**Since Jesus is the Lord of the angel armies, you are supernaturally covered within the kingdom of God’s defense system. When you know you have something to fight for, you will refuse to leave your treasure out in the open at any time. To God, you are His most precious treasure He loved so much that He always desired for you to live in His presence. To Jesus Christ, you are worth so much He willingly sacrificed His life to restore to you everything that was lost. To Holy Spirit, He remains the Master of all intelligence so you will always possess the unfair advantage in any situation, the mind of Christ.**

**Follow this sequence. First and foremost, always obey God. Then oppose satan until he flees from you in failure, i.e., until he vanishes because of the presence and power of God. While you are authorized to enforce spiritual weapons, never use them against any person, including yourself. God’s artillery is clearly designed for any malicious obstruction satan ranged against your breakthrough.**

**Any twisted invention contrived by the devil that is operating in the world system God has already targeted His weapons for mass destruction. Never forget, Jesus rendered the world powerless of harming you in anyway. He gave it to you to rule within the kingdom of God realm. Living submitted to the Lord, you are His chosen weapon in the earth. Then you can successfully resist any evil intention so you are totally free inside and out. First and foremost, host the mind of Christ in everything, all the time. The mind of Christ is your valued treasure to fight to always preserve. Safeguarding God’s truth in your mind and heart makes you free indeed. The truth you recognize and realize is worth the fight indeed.**

**Philippians 4:6-7 are excellent choices to insert within the above scripture text for your counterattack. Attaining and retaining the peace of God in prayer provides both reclamation and preservation benefits within the kingdom of God. Once you deploy the peace of**

**God then direct all efforts toward sustaining that position perpetually.**

**Verse seven classifies the peace of God equivalent to a garrison around the heart and the mind. The definition for garrison is “a permanently established military posts that have troops assigned.” Why is that so vitally important? Specifically, both the heart and the mind have been identified as the two essential areas requiring maximum security 24/7/365 or in a leap year, 366 days. Strategically, those same two vital organs are targeted by an assassin, whether by corpse or character. Therefore, live in the guarded safe house that God built.**

**Now you have resolute confidence that the peace you host is fully loaded and totally equipped to supply *shalom* in every area of your life all the time. You employ the peace of God by voice-activating every piece of weaponry as you see, hear, and say aloud the Word of God. That destroys any and every weapon formed against you.**

<sup>6</sup> Do not be over-anxious about anything, but by prayer and earnest pleading, together with thanksgiving, let your request be unreservedly made known in the presence of God. <sup>7</sup> And then the peace of God, which transcends all our powers of thought, will be a garrison to guard your hearts and minds in union with Christ Jesus.

<sup>32</sup> Since he did not spare even his own Son for us but gave him up for us all, won't he also surely give us everything else?

Death can't, and life can't. The angels won't, and all the powers of hell itself cannot keep God's love away. Our fears for today, our worries about tomorrow, <sup>39</sup>or where we are—high above the sky, or in the deepest ocean—nothing will ever be able to separate us from the love of God demonstrated by our Lord Jesus Christ when he died for us.
