

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 174 Scriptures**

They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues. You can see them on display from Genesis to Revelation. They are all energized to supernaturally affect every sphere of influence, i.e., the seven mountains: 1) religion; 2) government; 3) education; 4) business; 5) media; 6) arts & entertainment; and 7) family. You can learn how they fully operate, so you can serve as God's chosen vessel that brings heaven to earth. Always stay open to receive and release the electrifying promptings of Holy Spirit. He is destined to work in you as well as through you.**

**In the Old Testament, Elijah had a seamless connection with the Spirit of God. "Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it not to rain, and no rain fell on the earth for three years and six months. And [then] he prayed again and the heavens supplied rain and the land produced its crops [as usual]," James 5:17-18 (AMPC). Still, what Elijah showcased was a foreshadow of things to come, the works of Jesus and the greater works He promised would be performed through you, a member of the Body of Christ: "...The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working]," James 5:16 AMPC. Let Holy Spirit live big in you so you are the credible witness of the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out. That is what makes your calling and election undisputable.**

## **The synergy of the Triune God during creation and recreation**

Genesis 1:1-3;26-28 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

In the beginning God (prepared, formed, fashioned, and) created the heavens and the earth.

<sup>2</sup>The earth was without form and an empty waste, and darkness was upon the face of the very great deep. The Spirit of God was moving (hovering, brooding) over the face of the waters.

<sup>3</sup>And God said, Let there be light; and there was light.

<sup>26</sup>God said, Let Us [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth.

<sup>27</sup>So God created man in His own image, in the image *and* likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them.

<sup>4</sup>It is the same Holy Spirit who continues to distribute many different varieties of gifts.<sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>5</sup>The Lord Yahweh is one,<sup>[b]</sup> and he is the one who apportions to believers different varieties of ministries.<sup>[c]</sup>

<sup>6</sup>The same God distributes different kinds of miracles<sup>[d]</sup> that accomplish different results through each believer's gift and ministry as he energizes and activates them.

<sup>7</sup>Each believer is given continuous revelation<sup>[e]</sup> by the Holy Spirit to benefit not just himself but all.<sup>[f]</sup>

- f. [12:7](#) To summarize, God the Father, the Son, and the Spirit delights to give spiritual gifts to his people, the bride of Christ. These gifts are imparted by God to every believer upon conversion as the Holy Spirit chooses (v. [11](#)). They will confirm the Word of God and expand the kingdom of God. Spiritual gifts can be neglected and misused, but they remain the divine power source for Christ's body on the earth. Through teaching, evangelizing, prophesying, and demonstrating the miraculous, God uses his people to expand his kingdom and to establish righteousness on the earth through the proper use of the gifts he has given. There is no place in Scripture or church history where these gifts were taken away or removed from the body of Christ. The church moves forward through these divine gifts. Spiritual gifts do not replace the Word of God, but the Word of God will spread and flourish as the fully equipped body of Christ operates in the wise use of God's enabling power.

Isaiah 61:1-3 King James Version (KJV)

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

<sup>2</sup>To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

<sup>3</sup>To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

I just looked up the Greek for this word conscience and got a real surprise. I found this word quite different than what I had expected and actually very exciting. It literally means co-perception with lots of subtle nuances underlying that. The implications of this are stunning and enlightening.

First of all I discovered this means that *conscience* is a part of me that accesses another perception not of my own to join with mine to make it more complete. In fact, as I went deeper into the roots of this word I found that it is a combination of two things. First is coming to understand something with the assistance of the other consciousness that makes up the **co** part. Conscience is the uniting of my perception with God's perception. Then the word includes the idea of receiving clandestine information or to be privy to important missing information that makes my perceptions much more complete.

This act of uniting is also an important aspect of the meaning of this word. The union is a very close union that denotes companionship, resemblance, possession, becoming an instrumentality and all of this to create completeness. This apparently is primarily for the purpose of having a more perfect understanding or perception that would be impossible of myself.

Those who have the Holy Spirit now possess the perceptions of Christ's mind and can implement his purposes on the earth.

**The synergy of the Triune God that deposits all that They are and all that They have in you**

**Holy Spirit saturates you with at least twenty-seven capabilities that are compartmentalized within the following three main categories: Wisdom; Love; and Power. 2 Timothy 1:6-7 names the three diverse groups for the purpose of you activating them completely through Holy Spirit alone. When each one is fully operational, you are flooded with God Himself. That gives God every opportunity to fully express Himself without any limitations.**

2 Timothy 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>6</sup>Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. <sup>7</sup>For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind [wisdom].

**In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory].**

**Resting in the Lord allows them to have habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him at all.**

**Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. It indicates someone keeps pulling until he completely pulls away from Him. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."**

Isaiah 11:2, 5, 10 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>2</sup>And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; <sup>5</sup>And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. <sup>10</sup>And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

**In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance.**

**Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is both protection and preservation. God's seal of endorsement that is upon Holy Spirit and Jesus Christ protects and preserves His fruit in and through you. Therefore you are sealed as well. That is similar to coating fruit with natural wax to protect it from rotting. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good.**

**Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit, so He won't lose any opportunity through you. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."**

Galatians 5:22-23 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, <sup>23</sup> Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

**In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues.**

**Walking softly before the Lord helps you to discern the move of Holy Spirit to ensure what He has designed can never be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."**

1 Corinthians 12:4-11 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>4</sup> Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. <sup>5</sup> And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. <sup>6</sup> And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. <sup>7</sup> But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. <sup>8</sup> For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; <sup>9</sup> To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; <sup>10</sup> To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: <sup>11</sup> But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.
