

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 177 Scriptures

You are in Christ to live through Him in this world just as He would. Vacillating between the Spirit of God and the spirit of the world makes you double-minded, i.e., “wavering; two-spirited; of two souls; of two selves.” Learn how they fully operate for and against you, so you can serve as God’s chosen vessel that brings heaven to earth. Let the mind of Christ in you make a clean sweep from living carnally-minded. Refuse to be an obstruction against your own breakthrough. The logos Word lets you see it done, while the rhema Word sees you doing it. Always stay open to receive and release the electrifying promptings of Holy Spirit. He is destined to work in you as well as through you.

In the Old Testament, Elijah had a seamless connection with the Spirit of God. “Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it not to rain, and no rain fell on the earth for three years and six months. And [then] he prayed again and the heavens supplied rain and the land produced its crops [as usual],” James 5:17-18 (AMPC). The synergy of perceiver, believer, carver, reproducer, and craver that yields the right of way to Holy Spirit, never to the spirit of this world

Perceiver - With an attitude [thoughts and feelings jointly demonstrated] that senses whether your outlook is good or bad, right/wrong opinions, views, awareness, observation; may not be fact, just only an expressed opinion that needs to be onionized. Peel away the skin until you get to the core of things so that you carry the right perspective.

Craver - Appetite is the strong desires and drive passions; never satisfied; skinless flesh that craves to be covered; a failure to thrive creates a perpetual sucking to be satisfied i.e., a continuous drive for comfort; e.g. attention, recognition, celebrated, served, endorsed, validated, power left hungry or thirsty with no signs for becoming quenched, it will become desperate; it will long for fulfillment; eventually it will be intemperate; in that stage, deemed uncontrollable, it will manifest excessive behaviors.

Enforcer - Instincts that fight for survival and reproduction of its own kind – applies pressures if threatened; fight/flight, pet peeves, preserves what you consider order by taming what’s you think is out of alignment; imposes own rules to correct something you deem noncompliant; unadvertised rules that you impose on others; create an avenue for disciplining others, might even overpower them so others will play by your rules

¹²From the moment John stepped onto the scene until now, the realm of heaven’s kingdom is bursting forth, and passionate people have taken hold of its power.^[a]

Thermostat – readjusts the temperature in the room
Thermometer – reads the temperature

Follow Jesus Christ, the true Light who preserves your pathway to eternal life, resurrection life, and abundant life as well as protects you from the spirit of the world

The account of King Wenceslas illustrates the servant leadership of Jesus Christ, the King of kings. A long time ago, King Wenceslas was traveling in the dead of winter with his servant. The frigid weather made the snow seem much too unbearable. The servant almost succumbed to the unfavorable climate, but King Wenceslas instructed him to shadow him closely.

Taking the lead, the king walked on ahead of his servant without any regard for the adverse conditions. Following closely behind, the servant placed each foot inside the king’s footprint. The servant finished the journey because the king’s leadership paved the perfect way. The king gave his servant the advantage.

Follow Jesus Christ the True Light of life. Always allow Holy Spirit to take the lead in everything at all times. Whether it is a new course or the same destination, be open to His guidance on a sunny day or a cloudy day. Then you will accurately arrive at your place of destiny intact and on time.

The Lord’s desire is for you to receive the mysteries of the kingdom of God. He does not want you to only experience the shadow of

things to come, but to host the full-color images in the unseen spiritual realm, the kingdom of God. The more light you have makes the apparent shadow virtually nonexistent. No matter what you know or think you know to be true, always be determined to follow the light of God as John 1:9-14 highlights.

⁹The true Light, who shines upon *the heart of everyone*, was coming into the cosmos.

Jesus as the Light does not call out from a distant place but draws nearby coming into the world.

¹⁰He entered our world, a world He made; yet the world did not recognize Him. ¹¹Even though He came to His own people, they refused to *listen and* receive Him. ¹²But for all who did receive and trust in Him, He gave them the right to be *reborn as* children of God; ¹³He bestowed this birthright not by human power or initiative but by God's will.

¹⁴The Voice took on flesh *and became human* and chose to live alongside us. We have seen Him, enveloped in undeniable splendor—the one *true* Son of the Father—*evidenced in* the perfect balance of grace and truth.

During the creation of "Thriller" Michael Jackson's music video, it has been said the producers changed what steered the recording. It was the light pad. Michael's masterful dance moves outclassed even expert lighting technicians and their equipment so much the producers asked him to follow the light instead to benefit the entire production's synergy. Wherever the light pad shined, Michael stepped rhythmically inside the light. Finally, the music video was released picture-perfect.

I recall my Mom always saying the daylight that shone inside our home was much better than the lights we turned on. At first, I thought that cannot be true until I experienced it for myself. Not only is it the truth but also God's supernatural brilliance is superior to any manmade lighting. I encourage you to move from relying on just artificial lighting to God's eternal light, His glory light.

Your upgrade is prescheduled in Isaiah 60:1, 19-20. God's perfect illumination overthrows darkness so you can realize the line of sight that is beyond the veil. Having revelation from Holy Spirit unveils the

glory of God you are to both own and occupy within the kingdom of God on earth. That gives you the tangibility of God's promises ahead because your faith seizes the manifestation that was once invisible.

Whatever room you may enter, always turn on the divine lights. The Spirit of God and the Word of God awaken you to the light of the Lord even during the darkest part of the night as Ephesians 5:13-14 promises you. Then just like God, you will see in the dark as well as you can see in the light. Be resolved that God's course of life prevents you from stumbling around in the dark anymore.

Without a shadow of a doubt, there are innumerable heaven's mysteries that will not be revealed yet. However, there are so many discoveries God has already planned to unveil to you right here and right now. Refuse to talk yourself out of receiving His secrets. Do not lend a listening ear to those who believe God is withholding information from you.

The Lord is very purposeful about hiding secrets for you, not intentionally concealing mysteries from you. From God's perspective, camouflage is mandatory to preserve the kingdom of God's vault. As

He reveals the treasures of His heart to your heart.
