

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 180 Scriptures**

Although you have been a credible witness of the miracle working power of the Almighty God, it leaves you living without the plan, purpose, and pursuit of the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God. That is what happened after Elijah received a death threat from Jezebel. The fear of death engaged the power of death to the point Elijah could no longer even see him alive, but dead. He entertained the spirit of witchcraft, which the 1828 Webster's Dictionary defines as "intercourse with the devil." If you are standing at the gates of death, Jesus Christ is alive and has the keys of death and hell to prove it. You can live free to thrive in Christ, not just survive.**

**In the Old Testament, Elijah had a seamless connection with the Spirit of God. "Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it not to rain, and no rain fell on the earth for three years and six months. And [then] he prayed again and the heavens supplied rain and the land produced its crops [as usual]," James 5:17-18 (AMPC). Still, what Elijah showcased was a foreshadow of things to come, the works of Jesus and the greater works He promised would be performed through you, a member of the Body of Christ: "...The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working]," James 5:16 AMPC. Let Holy Spirit live big in you so you are the credible witness of the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out. That is what makes your calling and election undisputable.**

#### **Absence**

**In the Holy Bible, you can read about all the extraordinary miracles throughout Elijah's ministry. He remained a present and active force in the hand of God to represent His voice in the earth, as His prophet. The Lord was totally honored through each assignment Elijah had undertaken. However, the day Elijah went AWOL, i.e., absence without leave, interfered with God holding that same advantage.**

**Unfortunately, the presence of the mind of Christ he once relished diminished to absent-mindedness. Elijah felt so hopeless he only received angelic assistance for his partial rescue. He thought it was impossible to realign himself with the totally recovery efforts the Lord set before him.**

**Elijah was only open to receive two half meals from the angel that supplied supernatural energy to travel for forty days without feeling famished. Unfortunately, Elijah completely shut-down his mind and his heart from receiving God's inner-strengthening message that was necessary for him to complete his destiny, the Word of God from the Lord Himself.**

**God was so intent on Elijah's resuscitation that He patiently gave him undisputable evidence. First, it was the wind so he could feel it. Secondly, it was the compelling voice of an earthquake so he could hear it. And thirdly, it was fire so you can see it.**

**Although God used the Visual, Auditory, Kinesthetic (VAK) learning style assessment, His purpose was for Elijah to reconnect with His small, still voice. Without the presence of God's preferred method of communicating His directions to him, all subsequent up-to-the-minute divine instructions would remain in danger of being left totally unnoticed.**

**Lying vanities from satan penetrated and overthrew the absolute truth and absolute trust the prophet Elijah was once convinced of about God. Elijah was led to believe he was the only prophet left. Steeped in unbelief, he would not accept God's redefining message that the Lord had seven thousand more prophets in reserve. By staying confounded shut the door to Elijah's mind and heart to be supernaturally revived. Therefore, Jezebel's death threat sent to Elijah became the stronghold against his expectation and his experiential knowledge of God's love, power, and wisdom that are eternally empowered to preserve his life. That made it impossible for him to complete his earthly assignment.**

**Elijah lost the intimacy he once enjoyed with God. He acted like he never had an intimate relationship with the Lord at all. He barred God from even making deposits that were empowered to dissolve all doubts. No matter how many signs and wonders God manifested, Elijah refused to be comforted by any of them in that season.**

**The Word of God is the incorruptible seed. Its DNA is empowered to function perfectly every time when we give it first place all the time. Refuse to barricade your heart and your heart from the Word of God at any time. Without choosing the Word of God as your "saving health" at all times, you will lose its power to influence your life and good success.**
