The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 183 Scriptures

This is Section A of a multi-part instruction. The heavens are the Lord's, but the earth He has conferred to all mankind. The one who rules is the same one who owns and occupies. - a. 1:17 Or "legacy."
- b. <u>1:17</u> The Aramaic word used here, *mshamlaita*, means "complete, wholesome, abundant, sufficient, enough, and perfect."
- c. 1:17 Jesus calls us the light of the world (Matt. 5:14–16) and Paul describes believers as "shining lights" (Phil. 2:15) in this world. God is our Father, he created angels but he brought us into new birth. The Greek word anōthen ("from above") is used by Jesus in describing to Nicodemus that we are born from above. We are lights born from above. See also John 3:7.
- d. $\underline{1:17}$ Or "shadow of turning." The implication is there is nothing that you will find wrong with God, nothing in him that could even remotely appear to be evil hiding. The more you get to know him the more you realize how beautiful and holy he is.

- e. $\underline{1:18}$ Or "God having decided gave us birth." The comparison in this passage is striking. Sin gives birth to death, God from his pure desires gives us birth to bring him glory.
- f. 1:18 The Aramaic can be translated "the word of the rainbow-sign." That is, the unbreakable new covenant promises we have as new creatures in Christ.
- g. 1:18 Or "a kind of firstfruits of his creations" or "the pledge [down-payment] of a still further creation [a more complete harvest]."

The Planting of the Lord is Reproduced by the God's Word and Spirit

- **61** The Spirit of the Lord *God is upon* me, because the Lord has anointed *and* qualified me to preach the Gospel *of* good tidings to the meek, the poor, *and* afflicted; He has sent me to bind up *and* heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives and the opening of the prison *and* of the eyes to those who are bound, ² To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord [the year of His favor] [a] and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn,
- ³ To grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion—to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, and failing spirit—that they may be called oaks of righteousness [lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.
- ⁴ And they shall rebuild the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former desolations and renew the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.
- ⁵ Aliens shall stand [ready] and feed your flocks, and foreigners shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.
- ⁶ But you shall be called the priests of the Lord; people will speak of you as the ministers of our God. You shall eat the wealth of the nations, and the glory [once that of your captors] shall be yours.
- Instead of your [former] shame you shall have a twofold recompense; instead of dishonor *and* reproach [your people] shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double [what they had forfeited]; everlasting joy shall be theirs.
- ⁸ For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery *and* wrong with violence *or* a burnt offering. And I will faithfully give them their recompense in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant *or* league with them.

2 Timothy 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory].

Resting in the Lord allows them to have habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him at all.

Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. It indicates someone keeps pulling until he completely pulls away from Him. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."

Isaiah 11:2, 5, 10 King James Version (KJV)

² And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; ⁵ And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. ¹⁰ And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance.

Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is both protection and preservation. God's seal of endorsement that is upon Holy Spirit and Jesus Christ protects and preserves His fruit in and through you. Therefore you are sealed as well. That is similar to coating fruit with natural wax to protect it from rotting. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good.

Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit, so He won't lose any opportunity through you. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."

Galatians 5:22-23 King James Version (KJV)

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, ²³ Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues.

Walking softly before the Lord helps you to discern the move of Holy Spirit to ensure what He has designed can never be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."

1 Corinthians 12:4-11 King James Version (KJV)

⁴ Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. ⁶ And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. ⁸ For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; ⁹ To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; ¹⁰ To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ¹¹ But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.

The Tree of Life in Genesis was a Gift by Choice

Genesis 2:8-10, 15 King James Version (KJV) ⁸ And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed. ⁹ And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the **tree of life** also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. ¹⁰ And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads. ¹⁵And the Lord God took the man, and put him into the garden of **Eden** to dress it and to keep it.

The Tree of Life in Revelation was a Reward for Conquerors

Revelation 2:7 King James Version (KJV He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the **tree of life**, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Revelation 22:1-3 King James Version (KJV) And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. ² In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the **tree of life**, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the
