

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 188 Scriptures

This is Section F of a multi-part instruction. The heavens are the Lord's, but the earth He has conferred to all mankind. The one who rules is the same one who owns and occupies. The larger your territory, the greater your options are. Open your heart to God and allow Him to enlarge it with His dreams. Training for Reigning

"That's mine!" That is the phrase I heard the Lord say enthusiastically as I opened the mail that had a check in it. I was quite puzzled. I planned to tithe as usual, but had no intentions to give it all. What I learned much later is God was training me for reigning. After GaaGaa, GooGoo, a little one takes ownership and say, "That's mine!" and mean it. What I realize now is He gave me an example of how to talk as Hebrews 5:12-14, AMPC embodies. "For even though by this time you ought to be teaching others, you actually need someone to teach you over again the very first principles of God's Word. You have come to need milk, not solid food. For everyone who continues to feed on milk is obviously inexperienced and unskilled in the doctrine of righteousness (of conformity to the divine will in purpose, thought, and action), for he is a mere infant [not able to talk yet]! But solid food is for full-grown men, for those whose senses and mental faculties are trained by practice to discriminate and distinguish between what is morally good and noble and what is evil and contrary either to divine or human law." Whatever you have given to God, you will never lose.

Faith Grants Entitlement

Every title deed you own, you are entitled to occupy it fully. Do a title search in the bible. Study your divine inheritance. Employ the faith of God within to work for you!

³⁴ Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

²⁵ Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

Be a credible witness of what God conferred to you to own and occupy

NAMED AS A JOINT HEIR WITH JESUS CHRIST GRANTS EQUAL ACCESS

When God selected Abram, he was in idolatry. He left what he had always known to worship God alone, the God who always existed but he had never owned. The Lord promised Abram that in him shall all the families of the earth be blessed, which includes you! "And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise," Gal. 3:29 KJV. The finished work of Christ reconciled us to God as members of His family, which includes you! "The Spirit Himself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together," Rom. 8:16-17. "And Abram very rich in cattle, and in silver and in gold," Gen. 13:12. That includes you! Rich defined by the 1828 Webster's dictionary is: "Wealthy; opulent; possessing a large portion of land, goods or money, or a larger portion than is common to other men or to men of like rank [joint heir]."

BE A CREDIBLE WITNESS OF JESUS' COMMAND TO OWN AND OCCUPY

Jesus' command in Luke 19:13, KJV is "...Occupy till I come." (TPT) reads, "The Parable of a Prince and His Servants At this time Jesus was getting close to entering Jerusalem. The crowds that followed Him were convinced that God's kingdom would fully manifest when Jesus established it in Jerusalem. So He told them this story to change their perspective: "Once a wealthy prince left his province to travel to a distant land, where he would be crowned king and then return. Before he departed he summoned his ten servants together and charged them, 'I am entrusting each of you with fifty thousand dollars to invest while I am away. Trade with it and put the money to work until I return.' Footnotes: "ten minas."

THE ROCK OF REVELATION: KINGDOM OF GOD EMINENT DOMAIN

Footnotes

- a. 2:11 These "wise men" were extremely wealthy. They presented gifts that totaled a great sum of money—not tiny presents wrapped with bows, but treasure chests full of financial wealth. Although we are not given the monetary value of each type of gift, we know that

frankincense and myrrh were extremely costly. These gifts would have financed Joseph and Mary and Jesus' exodus to Egypt and supplied their living expenses for a number of years, even after returning to Israel. Gold is an often-used symbol of the deity of Christ. Frankincense points to his perfect life of holiness, excellence, and devotion. Myrrh, an embalming spice, speaks to us of the suffering love that would lead him to the death on the cross.

- Peter J. Daniels, a Christian billionaire, commissioned a team of historians to research the magi and the gifts which they brought to Jesus when he was born. Their conclusion was that over 300 kings came bearing gifts for Jesus with a calculated wealth of over \$4 million by today's standards.

Break away from anything that could breach what God conferred to you to own and occupy

Genesis 13, (kjv)

COMPLAINING ON YOUR STREETS? THEN REIGN IN THE STEAD OF CHRIST

The family feud between Abram and Lot's servants in Gen. 13 (KJV) caused their permanent split. Collectively, they had much too much to live under one roof. As Abram's seed, he conferred to Lot first right to choose the portion of land he desired. Lot chose the best part and then left. Afterward, the Lord instructed Abram on how to own and occupy even more land. "And the LORD said unto Abram after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed forever. And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered. Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee. Then Abram removed his tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which is in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD." God always begins with His vision. Create God's vision statement for your life based on the Word.

Compose it in the present tense. Command it aloud daily. Cherish it in your mind, heart, and ears until it comes out of your mouth, capturing God's provision. The sub-conscious mind reproduces the image as if you are doing it right now and right there. Matt 5:5 (KJV) is Jesus' cue to you to live the blessed life, that is in Him alone. "Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth," Then you will "...delight yourself in the abundance of peace," Psalm 37:11.
