# Voice of Triumph

*“Jesus Who gave (yielded) Himself up [to atone] for our sins [and to save and sanctify us], in order to rescue and deliver us from this present wicked age and world order, in accordance with the will and purpose and plan of our God and Father—” Galatians 1:4 (AMPC)*

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## FREE INDEED! JESUS RELEASED YOU TO RELEASE OTHERS, EVEN NOW

Before Jesus left heaven, He was absolutely certain His Heavenly Father commissioned Him to be the Destined Deliverer, the Savior of the whole world. Once born into the earth, that changed everything He was once assured of, even from the foundations of the world. Jesus was not in His baby crib with His blanket wrapped around His shoulders shouting at the top of His lungs, “I am Jesus, the Son of God!” while the bars quaked. Nonetheless, by twelve years old, Jesus was extremely confident in knowing He is the Son of God by courageously announcing it to Mary and Joseph. Repositioned as “being about My Father’s business,” He became reacquainted with His Father on earth as well as His calling and election from heaven. The Word of God was Jesus’ divine curriculum and the Spirit of God was His divine Coach. Afterward, Jesus was reawakened for what He came to do. His destiny was enlarged during the waiting period. Jesus spent the next eighteen years in preparation for His assignment, “to finish the work God sent Him to do.” Just like you and I had to learn how to spell the word deliverance and know its meaning, so did Jesus. Now that we inherited Jesus’ ministry in the earth, the 1828 Webster’s dictionary defines deliverance as “release from captivity, slavery, oppression, or any restraint.”

## THE MYSTERY OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD REVEALED YOUR DELIVERANCE

God’s curse upon satan in Gen. 3:15 left him clueless who was to “bruise his heel.” God’s covert operation in the Old Testament is unveiled in Psalm 67:2. God’s name “H” is upon Jesus’ name “Yeshua” when the psalmist penned “Yeshuah, Yeshuah” for “saving health.” Strong’s defines that phrase as New Birth benefits: “deliverance; victory; aid; welfare; help; and prosperity.” Jesus’ physical attributes had to be strikingly distinct from His heavenly image and likeness; He resembled Mary’s visage to make Him unrecognizable to satan. Now Heb. 2:9, 14-15 are forever carved in satan’s defeat. “But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels [Elohim] for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man. Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.” Jesus crushed satan’s headship once and for all in order to deliver you forever.

## JESUS ALWAYS ANSWERS WHEN YOU CALL HIM BY HIS NAME

Jesus is recognized as “Immanuel” in Isaiah 7:13 so you know He is God with us. Then Jesus is also called “Wonderful, Counsellor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace” in Isaiah 9:6 showing His diversity of delivery. All His published names help you realize just what to expect from Him as your Deliverer. Embrace and exercise Jesus’ divine identity in your praise where He is always enthroned. Psalm 18:2 invokes God’s presence and His power. “The LORD is My Rock, and My Fortress, and My Deliverer; My God, My Strength, in whom I will trust; My Buckler, and the Horn of My Salvation, and My High Tower.”

## STRATEGIC MOVES: EVERYTHING TO DELIVER YOU WAS ON THE LINE

Jesus showed how He altered His approach, instead of changing His goal to fulfill His destiny. Jesus Christ, the Lion of Judah. “I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek *or* consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will *and* pleasure of the Father Who sent Me,” John 5:30, (AMPC). Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God. “I will not talk with you much more, for the prince of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [He has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.] But [satan is coming and] I do as the Father has commanded Me, so that the world may know (be convinced) that I love the Father and that I do only what the Father has instructed Me to do. [I act in full agreement with His orders]....” John 14:30-31, (AMPC). Others’ perception may be mistaken. They see a lamb, but may not see the lion inside. In Luke 10:3, (KJV), Jesus gives you God’s command when your assignment is among wolves. “Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.” Shifting to listen instead of talking gives you unfair advantages. That is Jesus’ secret. He never gave away His power to satan. Because Jesus’ destiny was flawless, you stand faultless before God forever.

## Thought for Transformation

*Psalm 91:14-15 are God’s vowed promises for your deliverance.*

*“Because he hath set [attached] his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver [bring into security] him: I will set [be inaccessibly high] him on high, because he hath known My name. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver [rescue, set free] him, and honour him.” Let nothing separate you from His love, His safe house for you.*

## Real-Time Deliverance

*“God sent His Word, [Jesus] and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions,” Ps. 107:20. Jesus’ ministry still shows that now is your time to receive deliverance in Luke 4:18-21 (VOICE). “The Spirit of the Lord the Eternal One is on Me. Why? Because the Eternal designated Me to be His representative to the poor, to preach good news to them. He sent Me to tell those who are held captive that they can now be set free, and to tell the blind that they can now see. He sent Me to liberate those held down by oppression. In short, the Spirit is upon Me to proclaim that now is the time; this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One’s grace. Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant. Then He sat down, as a teacher would do, and all in the synagogue focused their attention on Jesus, waiting for Him to speak. He told them that these words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in their hearing.”*

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
