REDEMPTIVE REINFORCEMENT: FORTIFIED BY THE KINGDOM OF GOD

1) God has already given you His best gift, Jesus Christ: “He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?” Rom. 8:32. 2) God has already given you richly all things to enjoy: “Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive 1) power [*dunamis* i.e., physical power, force, might, ability, efficacy, energy], and 2) riches [*ploutos* i.e., riches, wealth, abundance, materially or spiritually], and 3) wisdom [*sophia* i.e., wisdom, insight, skill (human or divine), intelligence], and 4) strength [*ischus* i.e., strength (absolutely), power, might, force, ability] and 5) honour [*timé* i.e., a price, honor], and 6) glory [*doxa* i.e., honor, renown; glory, an especially divine quality, the unspoken manifestation of God, splendor], and 7) blessing [*eulogia* i.e., adulation, praise, blessing, gift],” Rev. 5:12. “The LORD redeemeth the soul of His servants: and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate [Hebrew: uninhabited, barren],” Ps. 34:22. The blood of Jesus Christ redeemed your life from destruction. God has given you every advantage to access right now. Don’t leave your divine inheritance untapped. Live heaven on earth honorably and humbly before God!

OUR OMNIPOTENT GOD STAYS AT HIS SUPERNATURAL PEAK STRENGTH

When Paul experienced what he said was like satan violently striking him with his fist, he had not yet recognized he was stronger than he thought. Only after God answered Paul after his third request, did he realize the miraculous power of Christ he already possessed. “And He said unto me, ‘My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness.’ Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong,” 2 Cor. 12:9-10, KJV. It’s God strength.

THE POWER OF ONE ACCORD RENEWS AND REVIVES YOUR STRENGTH

“And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken,” Eccl. 4:12. The threefold cord is the power of one strength. It’s Abba Father, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit who never leave or forsake you who maintain the union. “Wait” in Is. 40:31 is bind together in Hebrew. “But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” Jesus, the Vine with you, the branch shows your strength renews and revives as you bind together with Him. “I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me,” Phil. 4:13.

THE POTENT POWER OF JESUS’ SACRIFICE RECOVERS YOUR STRENGTH

“And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death,” Rev. 12:10-11. “How art thou fallen from heaven, O lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken [disable] the nations!” Is. 14:12. “I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom,” Dan. 7:21-22. “And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time. But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end. And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him,” Dan. 7:25-27. Base your testimony on the written Word. Say aloud, “In the name of Jesus Christ, I resist you satan and your attempts to war against me, wear me out, or weaken me! I overcame you by the blood of the Lamb! Jesus’ testimony saw you conquered when God exiled you from heaven. Jesus’ sacrifice conquered you and the power of death and delivered me from the fear of death so I never dread about living the abundant life! Now, I am more than a conqueror! God has anointed me with Holy Spirit and *dunamis* power to keep you conquered! I am strong in the Lord! I am strong in the forcefulness of God’s dominion! God is my strength and my strong hold! Jesus already outclassed you so I shall outlast any onslaught against me! In the name of Jesus, satan withdraw now! Amen!

Thought for Transformation

God externally reinforces you: “Be to me a rock of refuge in which to dwell, and a sheltering Stronghold to which I may continually resort, which You have appointed to save me, for You are my Rock and my Fortress,” Ps. 71:3, AMPC. God internally reinforces you: “The Lord God is my Strength, my personal bravery, and my invincible army; He makes my feet like hinds’ feet and will make me to walk [not to stand still in terror, but to walk] and make [spiritual] progress upon my high places [of trouble, suffering, or responsibility]!” Hab. 3:19, AMPC.

From Weariness to Warring

“And said, O man greatly beloved, fear not: peace be unto thee, be strong, yea, be strong. And when he had spoken unto me, I was strengthened, and said, Let my lord speak; for thou hast strengthened me,” Dan. 10:19. First, the Lord strengthens you with a ready heart to hear Him. Secondly, after you hear His message, you are strengthened by what He declared and decreed to you. “...but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits,” Dan. 11:32. Thirdly, intimacy with the Lord supernaturally empowers you with His miraculous strength.

Strong to Strengthen Others

“The Lord is their [unyielding] Strength, and He is the Stronghold of salvation to [me] His anointed,” Ps. 28:8, AMPC. Your Stronghold around you makes you stable, sustainable, and scalable to give His strength to others when weak, weary, or worn.
