

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 200 Scriptures**

## **Jesus Christ is Your Stronghold and Strength of the New Covenant**

Hebrews 8, (KJV)

Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

<sup>2</sup> A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man.

<sup>3</sup> For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer.

<sup>4</sup> For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:

<sup>5</sup> Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.

<sup>6</sup> But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.

<sup>7</sup> For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

<sup>8</sup> For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

<sup>9</sup> Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

<sup>10</sup> For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

<sup>11</sup> And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

<sup>12</sup> For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

<sup>13</sup> In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.

Hebrews 12:23-24, (KJV)

<sup>23</sup> To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

<sup>24</sup> And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

## **Stronghold and Strength Expected as Defined**

**STRONG-HOLD**, *noun* [strong and hold.] A fastness; a fort; a fortified place; a place of security.

**STRENGTH**, *noun* [[See Strong.](#)]

**1.** That property or quality of an animal body by which it is enabled to move itself or other bodies. We say, a sick man has not *strength* to walk, or to raise his head or his arm. We say, a man has *strength* to lift a weight, or to draw it. This quality is called also power and force. But force is also used to denote the effect of *strength* exerted, or the quantity of motion. *strength* in this sense, is positive, or the power of producing positive motion or action, and is opposed to weakness.

**2.** Firmness; solidity or toughness; the quality of bodies by which they sustain the application of force without breaking or yielding.

**3.** Power or vigor of any kind.

This act shall crush the *strength* of satan.

**STRENGTH** there must be either of love or war.

**4.** Power of resisting attacks; fastness; as the *strength* of a castle or fort.

**5.** Support; that which supports; that which supplies strength; security.

God is our refuge and *strength* [Psalms 46:1](#).

**6.** Power of mind; intellectual force; the power of any faculty; as *strength* of memory; *strength* of reason; *strength* of judgment.

**7.** Spirit; animation.

Me thinks I feel new *strength* within me rise.

**8.** Force of writing; vigor; nervous diction. The *strength* of words, of style, of expression and the like, consists in the full and forcible exhibition of ideas, by which a sensible or deep impression is made on the mind of a hearer or reader. It is distinguished from softness or sweetness. *strength* of language enforces an argument, produces conviction, or excites wonder or other strong emotion; softness and sweetness give pleasure.

And praise the easy vigor of a line, where Denhams *strength* and Wellers sweetness join.

**12.** Legal or moral force; validity; the quality of binding, uniting or securing; as the *strength* of social or legal obligations; the *strength* of law; the *strength* of public opinion or custom.

**13.** Vigor; natural force; as the *strength* of natural affection.

**14.** That which supports; confidence.

The allies, after a successful summer, are too apt upon the *strength* of it to neglect preparation for the ensuing campaign.

**15.** Amount of force, military or naval; an army or navy; number of troops or ships well appointed. What is the *strength* of the enemy by land, or by sea?

**16.** Soundness; force; the quality that convinces, persuades or commands assent; as the *strength* of an argument or of reasoning; the *strength* of evidence.

**20.** Support; maintenance of power.

## **Your Stronghold and Strength within the Kingdom of God**

### **THE POWER OF ONE ACCORD RENEWS AND REVIVES YOUR STRENGTH**

“And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken,” Eccl. 4:12. The threefold cord is the power of one strength. It’s Abba Father, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit who never leave or forsake you who maintain the union. “Wait” in Is. 40:31 is bind together in Hebrew. “But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” Jesus, the Vine with you, the branch shows your strength renews and revives as you bind together with Him. “I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me,” Phil. 4:13.

### **OUR OMNIPOTENT GOD STAYS AT HIS SUPERNATURAL PEAK STRENGTH**

When Paul experienced what he said was like satan violently striking him with his fist, he had not yet recognized he was stronger than he thought. Only after God answered Paul after his third request, did he realize the miraculous power of Christ he already possessed. “And He said unto me, ‘My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness.’ Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong,” 2 Cor. 12:9-10, KJV. It’s God strength.

### **From Weariness to Warring**

First, the Lord strengthens you with a ready heart to hear Him. “And said, O man greatly beloved, fear not: peace be unto thee, be strong, yea, be strong. And when he had spoken unto me, I was strengthened,...”

Secondly, after you hear His message, you are strengthened by what He declared and decreed to you.

“...and said, Let my lord speak; for thou hast strengthened me,” Dan. 10:19.

Thirdly, intimacy with the Lord supernaturally empowers you with His miraculous strength.

"...but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits," Dan. 11:32.

*"Lift up your eyes on high and see! Who has created these? He Who brings out their host by number and calls them all by name; through the greatness of His might and because He is strong in power, not one is missing or lacks anything."* Isaiah 40:26 (AMPC)

Strong to Strengthen Others *"The Lord is their [unyielding] Strength, and He is the Stronghold of salvation to [me] His anointed," Ps. 28:8, AMPC. Your Stronghold around you makes you stable, sustainable, and scalable to give His strength to others when weak, weary, or worn.*

Strength to Stretch

"Be strong in the Lord" [not in your own strength] "and in the power of His might" [i.e., the forcefulness of His dominion, in Greek]. Supernatural reinforcement is stable, sustainable, and scalable through the Word of God and the Spirit of God. Refuse to be susceptible to satan; defeated, he is only your sparring partner. You are more than a conqueror through by Christ who loves you. Be resilient, relentless, and resistless in battle! The God who lives in you is greater than satan that is in the world. The enemy can only reduce you down to his size for he doesn't know how to deal with your greatness. Don't let satan bend you out of shape.

God externally reinforces you: "Be to me a rock of refuge in which to dwell, and a sheltering Stronghold to which I may continually resort, which You have appointed to save me, for You are my Rock and my Fortress," Ps. 71:3, AMPC.

God internally reinforces you: "The Lord God is my Strength, my personal bravery, and my invincible army; He makes my feet like hinds' feet and will make me to walk [not to stand still in terror, but to walk] and make [spiritual] progress upon my high places [of trouble, suffering, or responsibility]!" Hab. 3:19, AMPC.

## **Your Stronghold and Strength within the Kingdom of God**

### **REDEMPTIVE REINFORCEMENT: FORTIFIED BY THE KINGDOM OF GOD**

1) God has already given you His best gift, Jesus Christ: "He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" Rom. 8:32.

2) God has already given you richly all things to enjoy: "Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive 1) power [*dunamis* i.e., physical power, force, might, ability, efficacy, energy], and 2) riches [*ploutos* i.e., riches, wealth, abundance, materially or spiritually], and 3) wisdom [*sophia* i.e., wisdom, insight, skill (human or divine), intelligence], and 4) strength [*ischus* i.e., strength (absolutely), power, might, force, ability] and 5) honour [*timé* i.e., a price, honor], and 6) glory [*doxa* i.e., honor, renown; glory, an especially divine quality, the unspoken manifestation of God, splendor], and 7) blessing [*eulogia* i.e., adulation, praise, blessing, gift]," Rev. 5:12.

"The LORD redeemeth the soul of His servants: and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate [Hebrew: uninhabited, barren]," Ps. 34:22. The blood of Jesus Christ redeemed your life from destruction. God has given you every advantage to access right now. Don't leave your divine inheritance untapped. Live heaven on earth honorably and humbly before God!

### **THE POTENT POWER OF JESUS' SACRIFICE RECOVERS YOUR STRENGTH**

"And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death," Rev. 12:10-11. "How art thou fallen from heaven, O lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken [disable] the nations!" Is. 14:12. "I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom," Dan. 7:21-22. "And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and

think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time. But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end. And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him," Dan. 7:25-27. Base your testimony on the written Word. Say aloud, "In the name of Jesus Christ, I resist you satan and your attempts to war against me, wear me out, or weaken me! I overcame you by the blood of the Lamb! Jesus' testimony saw you conquered when God exiled you from heaven. Jesus' sacrifice conquered you and the power of death and delivered me from the fear of death so I never dread about living the abundant life! Now, I am more than a conqueror! God has anointed me with Holy Spirit and *dunamis* power to keep you conquered! I am strong in the Lord! I am strong in the forcefulness of God's dominion! God is my strength and my strong hold! Jesus already outclassed you so I shall outlast any onslaught against me! In the name of Jesus, satan withdraw now! Amen!

### **The Stronghold and Strength of the Whole Armor of God**

Ephesians 6:10-18, (KJV)

**10** Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

**11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

**12** For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

**13** Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

**14** Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

**15** And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

**16** Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

**17** And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

**18** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Hebrews 4:11-12, (AMPC)

**11** Let us therefore be zealous *and* exert ourselves *and* strive diligently to enter that rest [of God, to know and experience it for ourselves], that no one may fall *or* perish by the same kind of unbelief *and* disobedience [into which those in the wilderness fell].

**12** For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the <sup>[a]</sup>breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing *and* sifting *and* analyzing *and* judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.

Psalms 3:3, King James Version

**3** But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

Psalms 103:19-22, King James Version

**19** The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all.

**20** Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

<sup>21</sup> Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure.

<sup>22</sup> Bless the LORD, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the LORD, O my soul.

## **The Stronghold and Strength from the Word of God and Spirit of God**

Psalm 91, Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

<sup>1</sup> He who <sup>[a]</sup>dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall remain stable *and* fixed under the shadow of the Almighty [Whose power no foe can withstand].

<sup>2</sup> I will say of the Lord, He is my Refuge and my Fortress, my God; on Him I lean *and* rely, *and* in Him I [confidently] trust!

<sup>3</sup> For [then] He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.

<sup>4</sup> [Then] He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings shall you trust *and* find refuge; His truth *and* His faithfulness are a shield and a buckler.

<sup>5</sup> You shall not be afraid of the terror of the night, nor of the arrow (the evil plots and slanders of the wicked) that flies by day,

<sup>6</sup> Nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor of the destruction *and* sudden death that surprise *and* lay waste at noonday.

<sup>7</sup> A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, but it shall not come near you.

<sup>8</sup> Only a spectator shall you be [yourself inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High] as you witness the reward of the wicked.

<sup>9</sup> Because you have made the Lord your refuge, and the Most High your dwelling place,

<sup>10</sup> There shall no evil befall you, nor any plague *or* calamity come near your tent.

<sup>11</sup> For He will give His angels [especial] charge over you to accompany *and* defend *and* preserve you in all your ways [of obedience and service].

<sup>12</sup> They shall bear you up on their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone.

<sup>13</sup> You shall tread upon the lion and adder; the young lion and the serpent shall you trample underfoot.

<sup>14</sup> Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him; I will set him on high, because he knows *and* understands My name [has a personal knowledge of My mercy, love, and kindness—trusts and relies on Me, knowing I will never forsake him, no, never].

<sup>15</sup> He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

<sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him and show him My salvation.
